


Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

four 11" squares
one 15-1/2" x 22-1/2" rectangle

From Fabric B, cut:

one 11" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 11" x 15-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

one 22-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 11" x 22-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric D, cut:

eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight 1-1/2" x 11" side block borders
eight 1-1/2" x 13" top/bottom block borders
two 1-1/2" x 17-1/2" top/bottom block borders*
two 1-1/2" x 22-1/2" side block borders*
*Tip: To maximize yardage, cut one of each length from one WOF strip.

From Fabric E, cut:

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
four 1-1/2" x 11" side block borders
four 1-1/2" x 17-1/2" top/bottom block borders*
four 1-1/2" x 22-1/2" side block borders*
four 1-1/2" x 13" top/bottom block borders
*Tip: To maximize yardage, cut one of each length from one WOF strip.

From Fabric F, cut:

ten 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
four 2-1/2" x 13" block sashing strips
two 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" block sashing strips
two 2-1/2" x 46-1/2" row sashing strips
two 2-1/2" x 53-1/2" side inner borders
two 2-1/2" x 50-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

From Fabric G, cut:

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 1-1/2" x 57-1/2" side middle borders
two 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" top/bottom middle borders

From Fabric H, cut:

two 4-1/2" x length of fabric strips. Subcut:
two 4-1/2" x 59-1/2" side outer borders
From the remaining width of fabric, cut:
four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 4-1/2" x 60-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks



Step 1: Gather:
one Fabric A square
two 11" Fabric D strips
two 13" Fabric D strips

Step 2: Sew the 11" strips to the left and right edges of the Fabric A square. Press toward the strips. Sew the 13" strips to the top and bottom edges of the Fabric A square. Press toward the strips.

The resulting Block should measure 13" square. Repeat with the remaining A squares for a total of four 13" A/D Blocks.



Step 3: Gather:
one Fabric B rectangle
two 11" Fabric E strips
two 17-1/2" Fabric E strips

Step 4: Sew the 11" strips to the left and right edges of the Fabric B rectangle. Press toward the strips. Sew the 17-1/2" strips to the top and bottom edges of the Fabric B rectangle. Press toward the strips.

The resulting Block should measure 13" x 17-1/2". Repeat with the remaining B rectangles for a total of two B/E Blocks.



Step 5: Gather:
one Fabric A rectangle
two 17-1/2" Fabric D strips
two 22-1/2" Fabric D strips

Step 6: Sew the 22-1/2" strips to the left and right edges of the Fabric A rectangle. Press toward the strips. Sew the 17-1/2" strips to the top and bottom edges of the Fabric A rectangle. Press toward the strips.

The resulting Block should measure 17-1/2" x 24-1/2".



Step 7: Gather:
 one Fabric C rectangle
 two 13" Fabric E strips
 two 22-1/2" Fabric E strips

Step 8: Sew the 22-1/2" strips to the left and right edges of the Fabric C rectangle. Press toward the strips. Sew the 13-1/2" strips to the top and bottom edges of the Fabric C rectangle. Press toward the strips.

The resulting Block should measure 13" x 24-1/2". Repeat with the remaining C rectangles for a total of two C/E Blocks.

Assemble the Quilt

Step 9: Arrange the Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make three block rows.

Step 10: Sew the row sashing and block rows together. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 11: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 12: Sew the side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 13: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
