*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### From Fabric A, cut:

thirty-five 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew seventeen together, end-to-end, then trim:  
seven 3-1/2" x 60-1/2" row sashing strips  
two 3-1/2" x 69-1/2" side outer borders  
two 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" top/bottom outer borders  
From the remaining eighteen strips, subcut:  
forty-eight 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" block sashing strips  
one hundred twelve 3-1/2" squares for the heart block bottoms  
seven 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
two hundred twenty-four 1-1/4" squares

### From each of Fabrics B-O, cut:

one 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
eight 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

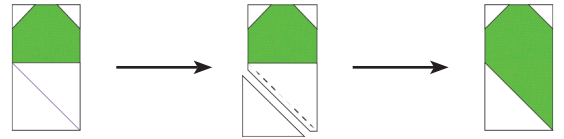
## Assemble the Heart Block

*Note: You may choose to mark the back of each 1-1/4" and 3-1/2" Fabric A square on the diagonal, or you may choose to eyeball these lines as you sew.*

**Step 1:** Place a 1-1/4" Fabric A square in the upper right corner of a 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric B rectangle, right sides together. Note the orientation of the marked diagonal line. Sew on the marked line, then trim away the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press. Repeat on the upper left corner with another 1-1/4" Fabric A square.



**Step 2:** Place a 3-1/2" Fabric A square at the lower edge of the unit, right sides together. Note the orientation of the marked diagonal line. Sew on the marked line, then trim away the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press.



Repeat Steps 1 and 2 with all Fabric B-H rectangles.

**Step 3:** Repeat Steps 1 and 2, this time using Fabric I-O rectangles and sewing along the diagonal in a mirror image from Step 2, to create the heart.



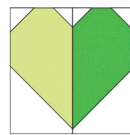
**Step 4:** Sew a completed Step 2/Fabric B and Step 3/Fabric I unit together to make a Heart Block. The Heart Block should measure 6-1/2" square.

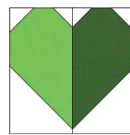
eight B/I Heart Blocks



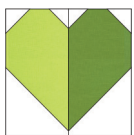
eight F/M Heart Blocks



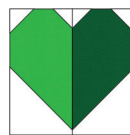
eight C/J Heart Blocks



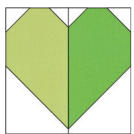
eight G/N Heart Blocks



eight D/K Heart Blocks

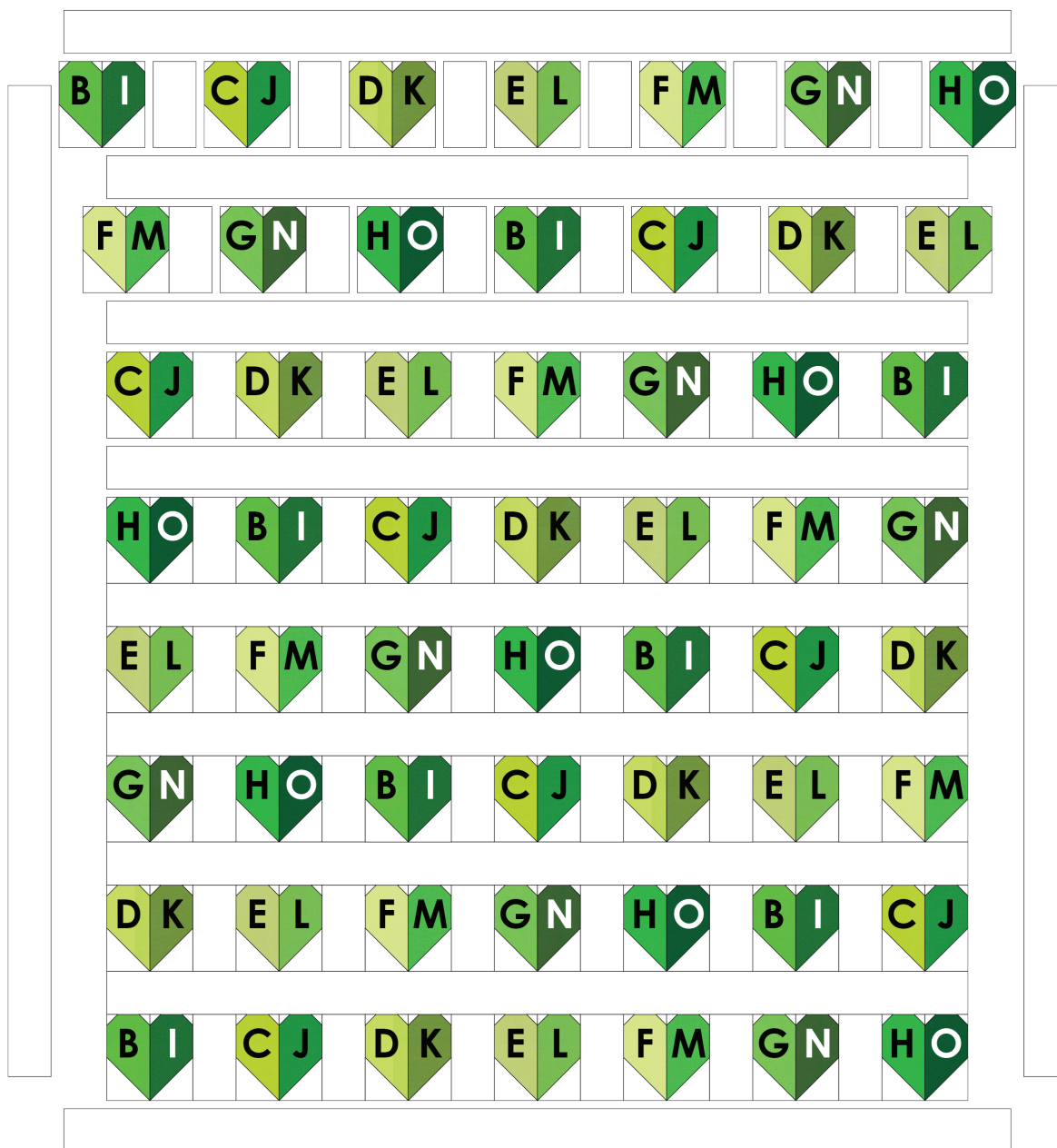


eight H/O Heart Blocks

## Assemble the Quilt



**Step 5:** Arrange one Heart Block of each fabric pairing together to form the rows, as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using block sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make eight block rows.

**Step 6:** Sew the Heart Block rows together, sewing a row sashing strip between each row. Press seams open or to the sashing.

**Step 7:** Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
