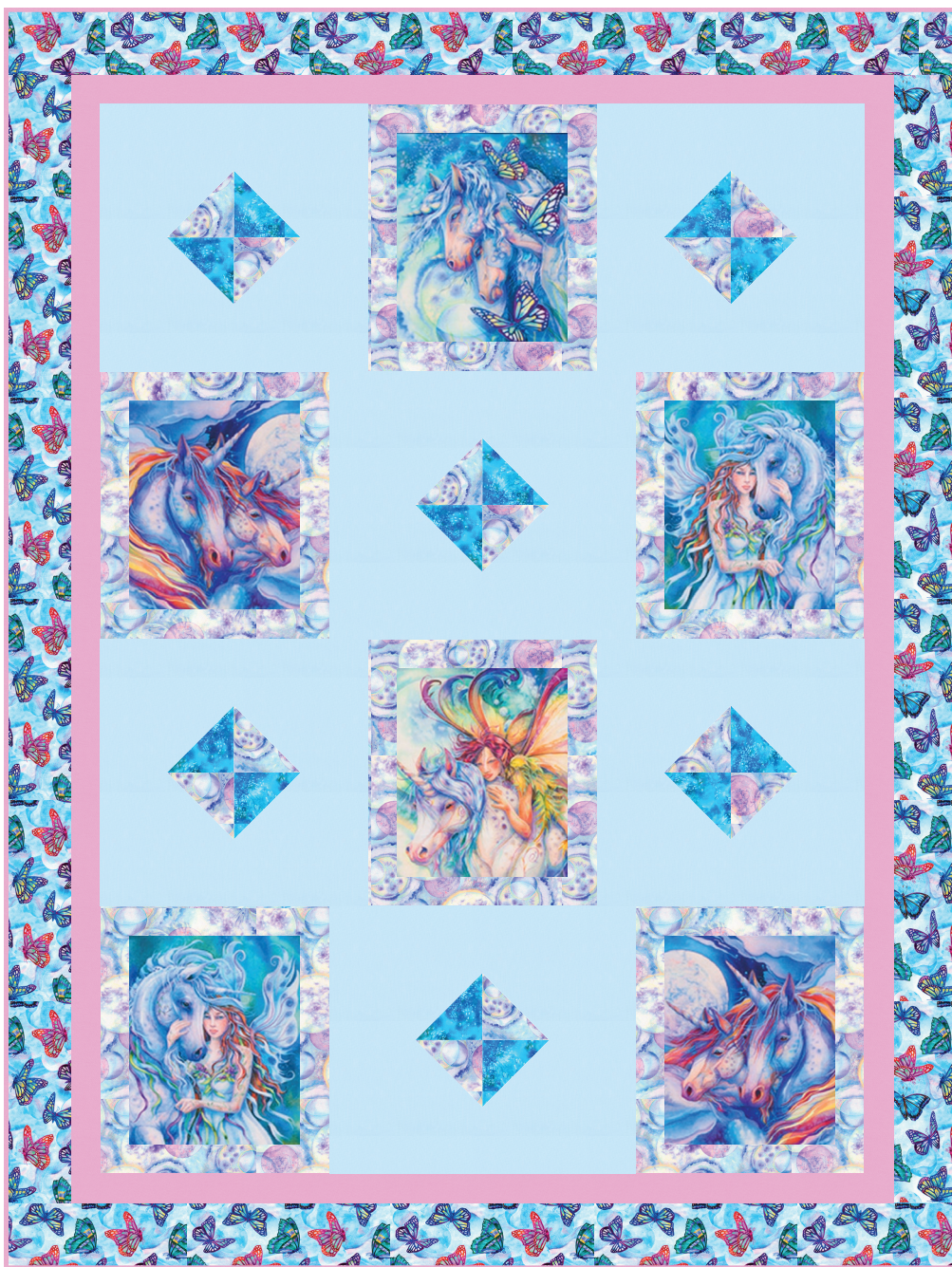

Finished quilt measures: 50" x 66"








Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

six 9-1/2" x 11-1/2" for the block centers

From Fabric B, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

six 4-1/2" squares for the HSTs

eight 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twelve 2" x 11-1/2" side block borders

twelve 2" x 12-1/2" top/bottom block borders

From Fabric C, cut:

one 5" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 5" x 7-1/2" rectangles

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twelve 4-1/2" squares for the HSTs

twelve 4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eight 4" x 7-1/2" rectangles

eight 4" x 16-1/2" rectangles

four 4" x 14-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric D, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

six 4-1/2" squares for the HSTs

From Fabric E, cut:

five 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2" x 43-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

two 2" x 56-1/2" side inner borders

From Fabric F, cut:

six 4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 4" x 50-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

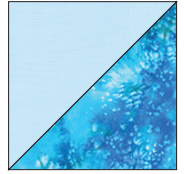
two 4" x 59-1/2" side outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

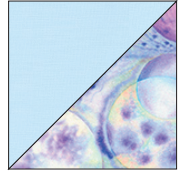
six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

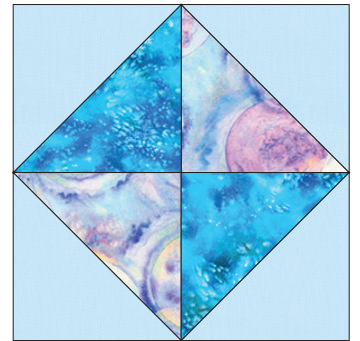
Step 1: Pair a 4-1/2" Fabric C square with a 4-1/2" Fabric D square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4" square. Repeat to make twelve C/D HSTs.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make twelve C/B HSTs.



Step 3: Arrange two C/D and two C/B HSTs in two rows of two to form a four-patch, noting the fabric placement and orientation of the HSTs. Sew together and press. Repeat to make six 7-1/2" square units.



Assemble the Panel Blocks

Step 4: Sew a 2" x 11-1/2" Fabric B strip to the left and right edges of a Fabric A block. Press. Sew a 2" x 12-1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom edges of a Fabric A block. Press.

Repeat Step 4 to make six 12-1/2" x 14-1/2" Panel Blocks.

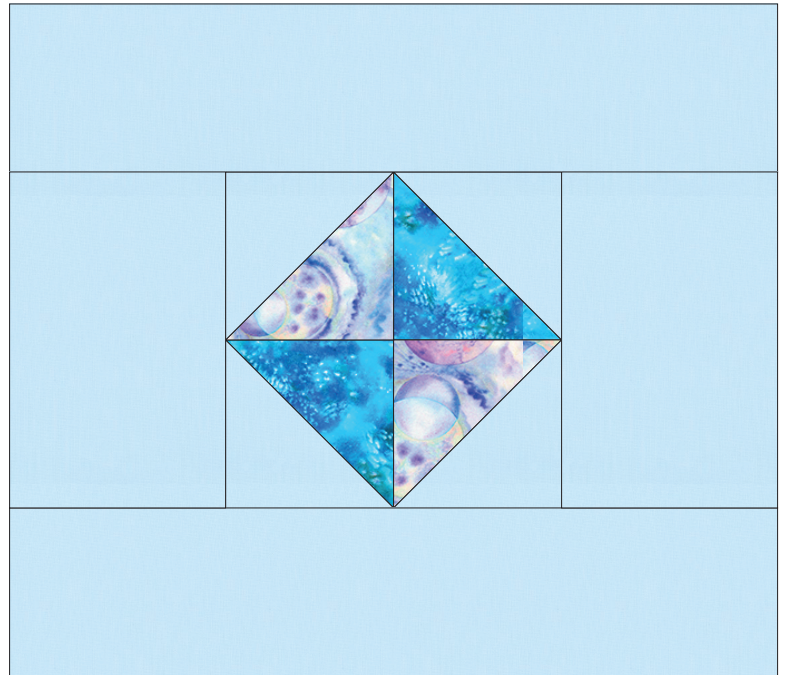


Assemble the HST Blocks

Step 5: Sew a 5" x 7-1/2" Fabric C rectangle to the left and right edges of an HST four-patch. Press. Sew a 4" x 16-1/2" Fabric C rectangle to the top and bottom edges of the block. Press.

Repeat Step 5 to make two 16-1/2" x 14-1/2" HST Blocks. These will be used in Rows 2 and 4.

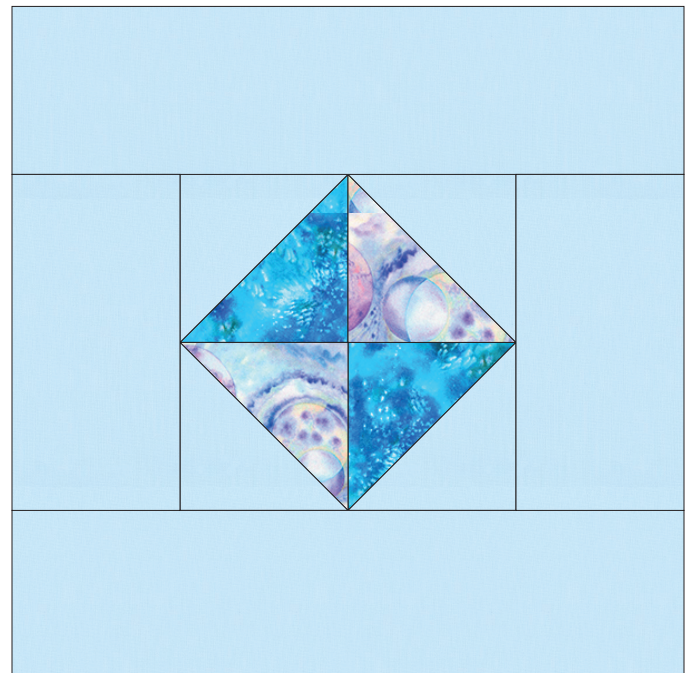
Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement in these blocks, as not all blocks will have the same fabric placement.



Step 6: Sew a 4" x 7-1/2" Fabric C rectangle to the left and right edges of an HST four-patch. Press. Sew a 4" x 14-1/2" Fabric C rectangle to the top and bottom edges of the block. Press.

Repeat Step 6 to make four 14-1/2" x 14-1/2" HST Blocks. These will be used in Rows 1 and 3.

Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement in these blocks, as not all blocks will have the same fabric placement.



Assemble the Quilt



Step 7: Arrange the blocks into four rows of three blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 8: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams toward the Panel Blocks.

Step 9: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 10: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 11: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
