## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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\*Note: You must have enough fabric to fussy cut 6 faces and 2 flowers as shown on page 3.

### Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!



## Cutting Instructions

### From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 23-1/2" x 42-1/2" center panel

### From Fabric B, cut:

twelve 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew nine together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 44-1/2" side Border 2 strips

two 1-1/2" x 37-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 strips

two 1-1/2" x 56-1/2" side Border 3 strips

two 1-1/2" x 39-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 strips

From the three remaining strips, subcut:

sixteen 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" sashing strips

### From Fabric C, cut:

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 25-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 strips

two 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" side Border 1 strips

### From Fabric D, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 5-1/2" squares

### From Fabric E, fussy cut:

four 5-1/2" x 9-1/2" vertical rectangles, with the portrait centered

four 9-1/2" x 5-1/2" horizontal rectangles, two with the portrait centered and two centered on a motif of your choice

### From each of Fabrics F and H, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 5-1/2" squares

### From each of Fabrics G and I, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 5-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

### From Fabric J, cut:

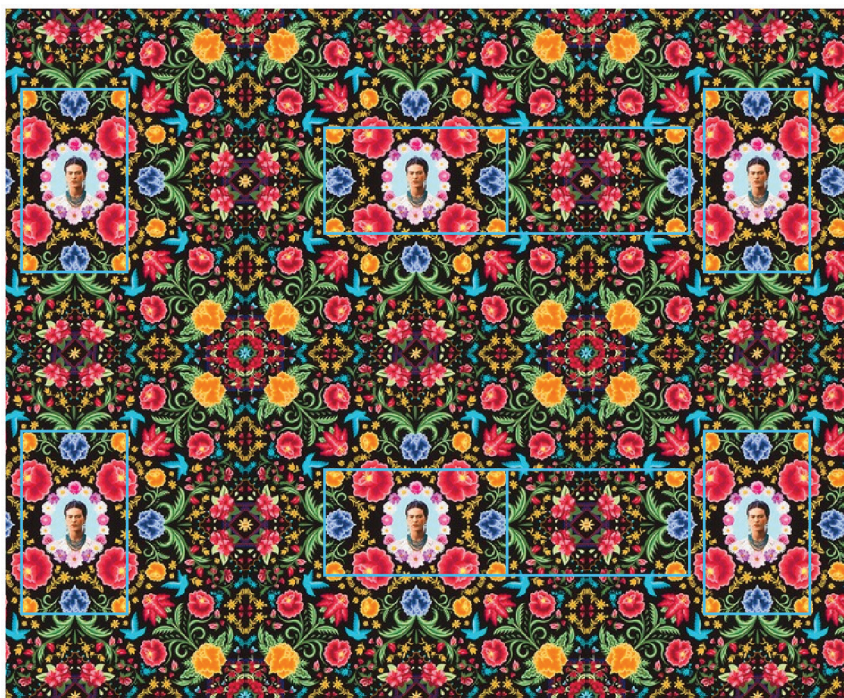
six 5" x WOF strips. Sew nine together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 5" x 58-1/2" side Border 4 strips

two 5" x 48-1/2" top/bottom Border 4 strips

### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips



## Assemble the Pieced Border

### Step 1: Gather:

two Fabric D squares  
one Fabric F square  
two horizontal Fabric E rectangles  
four Fabric B sashing strips

Arrange in a row as shown to form the top pieced border. Sew together, pressing the seams toward the Fabric B sashing strips. Repeat to make the bottom pieced border.



### Step 2: Gather:

one Fabric G rectangle  
one Fabric H square  
one Fabric I rectangle  
two vertical Fabric E rectangles  
four Fabric B sashing strips

Arrange in a column as shown to form the left pieced border. Sew together, pressing the seams toward the Fabric B sashing strips. Repeat to make the right pieced border, noting the difference in the placement of the Fabric G and Fabric I rectangles.





## Assemble the Quilt

**Step 3:** Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the Fabric A quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 4:** Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 5:** Sew the side pieced borders (from Step 2) to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the Fabric B borders.

**Step 6:** Sew the top/bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the Fabric B borders.

**Step 7:** Sew the top/bottom pieced borders (from Step 1) to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the Fabric B borders.



**Step 8:** Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 9:** Sew the side Border 4 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
