Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 44-1/2" wide.

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You will also need:
1-5/8 yards for backing

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 44-1/2" wide.
- WST indicates wrong sides together.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A-C, cut:
nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Subcut, following Figure 1. Leave the strips folded wrong sides together (WST), selvage to selvage. Lay the templates on the folded strip as shown. You can stack two strips on top of each other if you want to cut more at once, but they must be folded WST to get the mirrored pieces.

You need a total of sixty-seven pairs of A background triangles and sixty-seven pairs of B background triangles.

From each of Fabrics D-G, cut:

three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. These will be referred to as the Group 1 fabrics. Subcut the fabrics the same way you did the background fabrics, with the strips folded WST.

You need five pairs of each of the A triangles and five pairs of each of the B triangles.

From each of Fabrics H-K, cut:

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. These will be referred to as the Group 2 fabrics. Subcut the fabrics the same way you did the background fabrics, with the strips folded WST.

You need four pairs of each of the A triangles and four pairs of each of the B triangles.

From each of Fabrics L-O, cut:

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. These will be referred to as the Group 3 fabrics. Subcut the fabrics the same way you did the background fabrics, with the strips folded WST. You need three pairs of each of the A triangles and three pairs of each of the B triangles.

From the Binding Fabric, cut:
five 2-1/2" x WOF strips

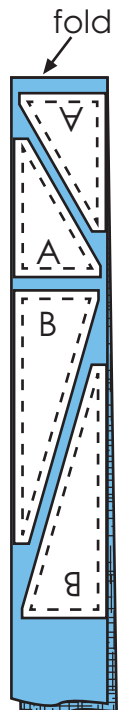

Assemble the Units

Step 1: On a design wall, arrange the triangles as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Note: Not all Group 1-3 triangles will be used.

Step 2: Picking up the first set of triangles, sew the A triangles together in pairs *Figure 2*. Press. Unfinished measurement of this unit is $2 \frac{3}{8}'' \times 3 \frac{5}{8}''$.

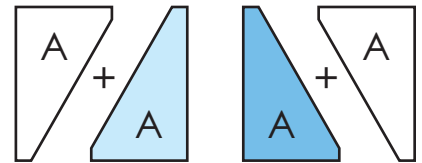

Sew the B triangles together in pairs.

Figure 3. Press. Unfinished measurement of this unit is $2 \frac{3}{8}'' \times 7''$.

Place the units back on your design wall as you finish them.

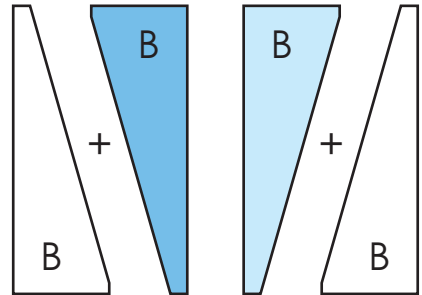
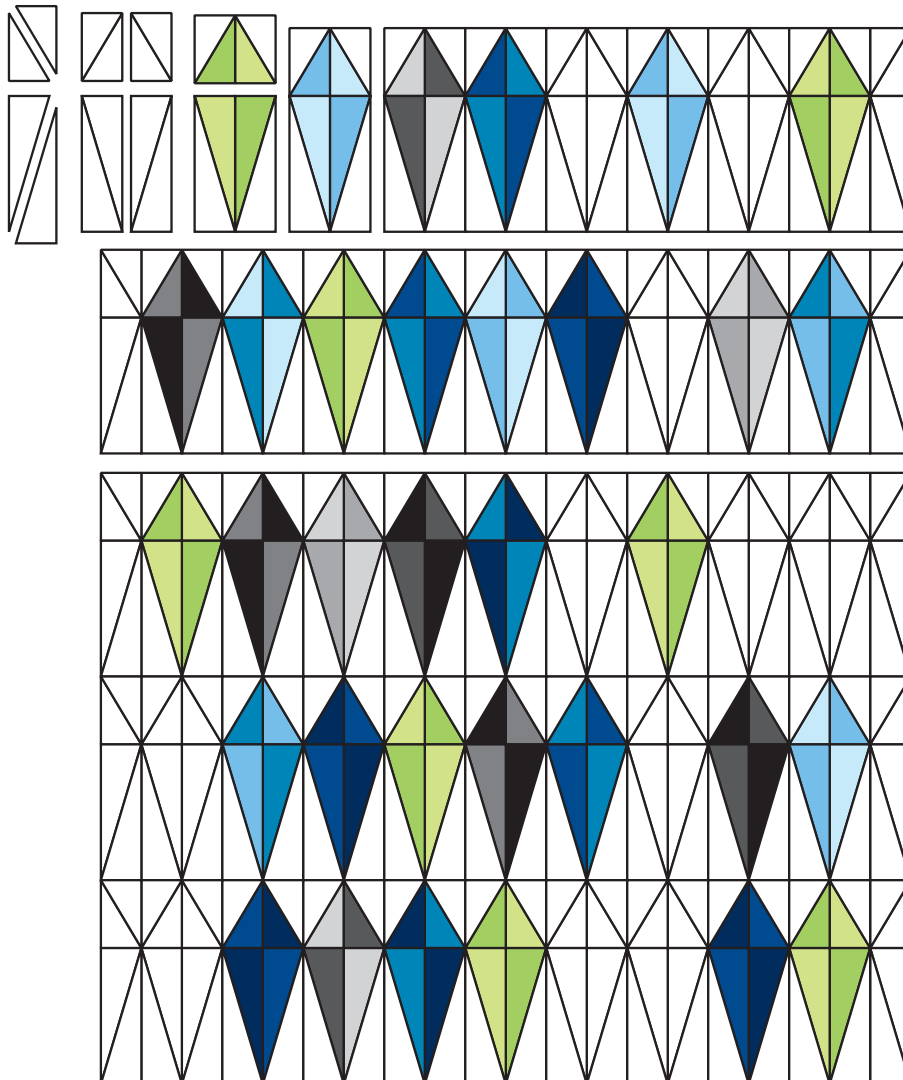

Assemble the Quilt Top



Quilt Assembly Diagram

Step 3: Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram, sew all of the A units in the first row together.
Figure 4. Press.

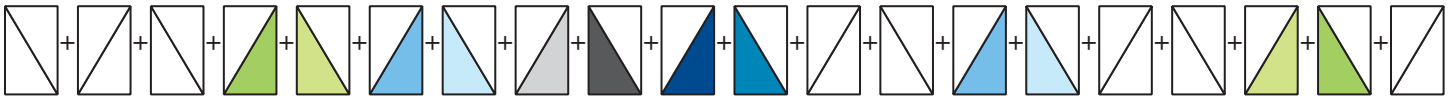

Then sew all of the B units in the second row together.
Figure 5. Press.

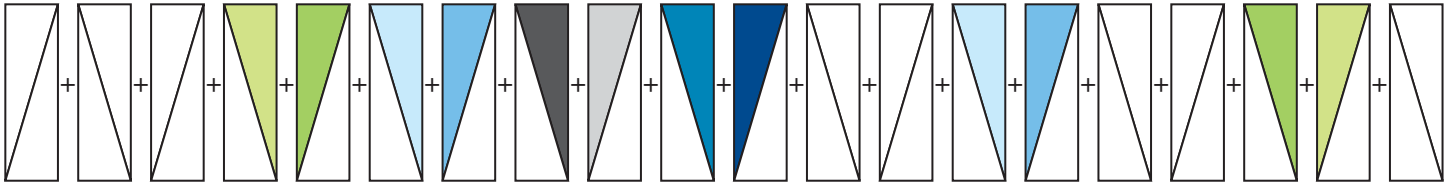

Continue sewing the units into rows.

Step 4: Sew the rows together. Press.

Step 5: Layer, quilt, and finish.

Templates

Print at 100%.

Check size printed correctly using 1" box for scale prior to cutting fabric.
