

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 44" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

two 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-six 2" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

four 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-six 2" x 5" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

six 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-six 2" x 8" rectangles

From Fabric D, cut:

seven 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-six 2" x 11" rectangles

From Fabric E, cut:

two 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-four 2" x 2" squares

From Fabric F, cut:

four 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-four 2" x 5" rectangles


From Fabric G, cut:

six 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-four 2" x 8" rectangles

From Fabric H, cut:

seven 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-four 2" x 11" rectangles

For Fabric I, refer to background cutting diagram to cut:



twenty-five 2" squares for the I1 pieces fifty 2" x 5" rectangles for the I2 pieces fifty 2" x 8" rectangles for the I3 pieces fifty 2" x 11" rectangles for the I4 pieces fifty 2" x 14" rectangles for the I5 pieces


From the Binding Fabric, cut:


seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Courthouse Step Assembly

The quilt is composed of 25 courthouse steps blocks - thirteen of Block A and twelve of Block B. The diagrams below indicate how to construct each block based on the color-way. Start at the center of the block and sew pieces together as in log cabin block, working toward the outermost pieces.

Reference the cutting chart on the previous page when sewing each block. Sew with a 1/4" seam allowance. Please remember to press the seams open.



Assemble the Quilt

The design of the quilt is composed of five rows of five blocks (Block A and Block B). The Quilt Assembly Diagram indicates which courthouse steps block to use for each row. Sew the blocks into rows, using a 1/4" seam allowance. Then sew the rows together to form the quilt top. Press the seams open.
