## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $43^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:
one 4-1/2" square
From Fabric B, cut:
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
From Fabric C, cut:
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
four 2-1/2" squares

## From Fabric D, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles
eight 2-1/2" squares
one $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Subcut:
four 4-1/2" squares

From Fabric E, cut:
two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
twelve 2-1/2" squares

## From Fabric F , cut:

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
sixteen 2-1/2" squares
From Fabric G, cut:
two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
twenty $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## From Fabric H , cut:

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles twenty 2-1/2" squares
one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
eight 4-1/2" squares

## From Fabric I, cut:

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-four 2-1/2" squares
one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: eight 4-1/2" squares

## From Fabric J, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles ten $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles twenty-four 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric K, cut:
four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles twenty $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles eight 2-1/2" squares
three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: four 4-1/2" squares eight 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric L, cut:
two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty 2-1/2" squares
three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

From Fabric $M$, cut:
three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles four 2-1/2" squares
two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twelve 4-1/2" squares

## From Fabric N , cut:

four 4-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips. Subcut: sixteen 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric O, cut:
one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: eight 4-1/2" squares

From Fabric P , cut:
one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 4-1/2" squares

From Fabric Q, cut:
four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
four 4-1/2" $\times 14-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
four 4-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangles
one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Subcut: eight 2-1/2" squares
five $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 1-1/2" $\times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom inner borders two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side inner borders

From Fabric R, cut:
six 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
four $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
four 3-1/2" x 24-1/2" rectangles
four $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Step 1: Sew a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangle to opposite edges of the $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A center square. Press away from the A square. Sew Fabric $C$ rectangles to the remaining long edges of the Fabric B rectangles, again pressing away from the A square. Continue sewing rectangles to this row, as shown, always pressing away from the center. End the row by sewing two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J rectangles together in a pair and then sewing the pair of rectangles to the end of the row. This is Row 9.


Step 2: Follow the diagram to sew Rows 8 and 10, as shown, referring to the diagram for fabric placement and ending the rows with Fabric $Q$ squares at each end. Press the seams toward the Fabric B rectangle at the center.

Step 3: Sew Rows 8-10 together, as shown, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side.


Step 4: Follow the diagram to sew Rows 7 and 11, as shown, referring to the diagram for fabric placement and ending the rows with Fabric K squares at each end. Press the seams away from the Fabric $C$ rectangle at the center.


Step 5: Follow the diagrams to sew Rows 1-6 and 12-17, as shown, referring to the diagram for fabric placement and pressing direction.



Step 6: Sew Rows 1-7 together, as shown, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side. Sew a 4-1/2" x 14-1/2" Fabric Q rectangle to the left and right edges of the section. Press. Repeat to make Rows 11-17.


Step 7: Sew the three sections (Rows 1-17) together, as shown, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side.


Step 8: Sew the upper and lower Fabric $Q$ borders together, as shown, then sew to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press.


Step 9: Sew the upper and lower Fabric $R$ borders together, as shown, then sew to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press.


Step 10: Sew the left and right Fabric $R$ borders together, as shown, then sew to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press.


## Assemble the Final Borders

Step 11: Sew the $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ $50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric Q top and bottom borders to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press. Sew the $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $Q$ side borders to the side edges of the quilt center. Press.


Step 12: Gather:
one 4-1/2" Fabric M square one 4-1/2" Fabric P square two 4-1/2" Fabric O squares

Arrange together, as shown. Sew together in two rows of two, pressing the block seams in opposite directions. Press the row seams open. Repeat to make four units like this. Set aside. Note: If the direction of Fabric P in the final quilt is important to you, refer to the final quilt as you sew each of the four units.

Step 13: Arrange the pieces for one side outer border, as shown. Sew together in two rows, pressing the seams in opposite directions before sewing the rows together. Press. Repeat to make a total of four pieced outer borders.


Step 14: Sew a completed Step 13 border to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press.

Step 15: Sew a completed Step 12 unit to opposite ends of a remaining Step 13 border, as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press. Repeat with the remaining border. Sew to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
