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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A, F and O, cut:

four 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From each of Fabrics B-D, and M, cut:

two 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric E, cut:

four 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles three 2-1/2" squares twelve 1-7/8" squares for the small flying geese

From Fabric G, cut:

four 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles five 2-1/2" squares twenty 1-7/8" squares for the small flying geese

From Fabric H Ten Squares, cut:

two 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles three 2-1/2" squares twelve 1-7/8" squares for the small flying geese

From Fabric H yardage, cut:

seven 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 4-1/2" x 66-1/2" side outer borders two 4-1/2" x 60-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From each of Fabrics I, J and P, cut:

two 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles eight 2-1/2" squares thirty-two 1-7/8" squares for the small flying geese

From Fabric K, cut:

four 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles four 2-1/2" squares sixteen 1-7/8" squares for the small flying geese

From Fabric L, cut:

four 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles two 2-1/2" squares eight 1-7/8" squares for the small flying geese

From Fabric N, cut:

two 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles four 2-1/2" squares sixteen 1-7/8" squares for the small flying geese

From Fabric Q, cut:

four 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut: forty-five 3-1/4" squares for the small flying geese twelve 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: ninety-two 4-1/2" squares for the large flying geese twelve 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles twenty 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 1-1/2" x 64-1/2" side inner borders two 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" top/bottom inner borders twelve 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" sashing strips sixteen 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: seventy-eight 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" block sashing strips one hundred eighty 1-1/2" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Small Flying Geese

Step 1: Pin two 1-7/8" Fabric E squares in opposing corners of a 3-1/4" Fabric Q square, RST. The squares will overlap slightly in the center of the large square. Using a ruler, draw a diagonal line through the squares.

Step 2: Sew scant 1/4" seam on each side of the diagonal line. Set the seam by pressing it flat. Cut along the diagonal line, creating two identical units.

Step 3: Press the fabric toward smaller triangles. Repeat with the second unit.

Step 4: Place one 1-7/8" Fabric E square at the corner of sewn block unit. Draw diagonal line in pencil. Sew a scant 1/4" seam on each side of diagonal line. Set seam (press). Cut along diagonal line, creating two identical units.


Step 5: Press the seam toward smaller triangle. Trim off small dog ears left by the seam allowance. Trim to 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" if necessary. Repeat to make four flying geese blocks.


Step 6: Repeat with all remaining 3-1/4" Fabric Q squares and 1-7/8" squares to make a total of:



















twelve Fabric H

For the Neutral Colorstory, make:

two each in Fabrics C, E and H three from Fabric I four each in Fabrics D, G, J, K and L five from Fabric A six each in Fabrics B and F

sixteen Fabric N flying geese






Assemble the Large Flying Geese

Step 7: Place a 4-1/2" Fabric Q square RST at one end of a 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B rectangle. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the square, as shown. Sew on the marked line and trim away the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press toward the triangle.




Step 8: Repeat Step 7 at the remaining end of the rectangle. The resulting flying geese block should measure 4-1/2" x 8-1/2".



Step 9: Repeat with all remaining 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A-P rectangles, for a total of forty-six large flying geese units.

For the Neutral Colorstory, use this method with all 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" A-L rectangles to make a total of forty-six.

Assemble the Star Blocks



Step 10: Gather: four 1-1/2" Fabric Q squares four Fabric I small flying geese units one 2-1/2" Fabric I square

Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 11: Sew the units together to form the rows. Press the seams away from the flying geese.

Step 12: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.


The Star Block should measure 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of forty-six Star Blocks. Make:

three each from Fabrics E and H five from Fabric G eight each from Fabrics I, J and P four each from Fabrics L and N two from Fabric L

For the Neutral Colorstory, make:

four each from Fabrics F, I, J and K five from Fabric E eight each from Fabrics D, G and L





Assemble the Quilt



Step 13: Arrange the Star Blocks and Large Flying Geese together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block. Note the addition of the 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric Q rectangles at the ends of the even numbered rows. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make thirteen block rows.

Step 14: Sew the sashing and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 15: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 16: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

From Fabric A, cut: five 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric B, cut: six 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From each of Fabrics C and H, cut: two 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From each of Fabrics D, G and L, cut:

four 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles eight 2-1/2" squares thirty-two 1-7/8" squares for the small flying geese

From Fabric E, cut:

two 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles five 2-1/2" squares twenty 1-7/8" squares for the small flying geese

From Fabric F, cut:

six 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles four 2-1/2" squares sixteen 1-7/8" squares for the small flying geese

From Fabric I, cut:

three 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles four 2-1/2" squares sixteen 1-7/8" squares for the small flying geese

From each of Fabrics J and K, cut:

four 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles four 2-1/2" squares sixteen 1-7/8" squares for the small flying geese

From Fabric Q, cut:

four 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

forty-five 3-1/4" squares for the small flying geese twelve 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

ninety-two 4-1/2" squares for the large flying geese twelve 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

twenty 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 1-1/2" x 64-1/2" side inner borders two 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" top/bottom inner borders twelve 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" sashing strips sixteen 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

seventy-eight 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" block sashing strips one hundred eighty 1-1/2" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

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
