Finished quilt measures: $52^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{\prime \prime}$

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42 " wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 20-1/2" $\times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ center panel

## From Fabric B, cut:

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 pieces
two 2-1/2" $\times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 1 pieces
two 2-1/2" $\times 30-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 3 pieces
Sew the remaining three strips together, end-to-end, then trim:
two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 46-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 3 pieces
five 1-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" top/bottom Border 4 pieces
two 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" side Border 4 pieces
twelve 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Trim to:
thirty-six $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece 7 units for Log Cabin Blocks A \& B thirty-six 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" piece 6 units for Log Cabin Blocks A \& B thirty-six 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece 3 units for Log Cabin Blocks A \& B thirty-six 1-1/2" square piece 2 units for Log Cabin Blocks A \& B

## From Fabric C, cut:

two 5-1/2" $\times$ length of fabric strips. Subcut:
two 5-1/2" $\times 62-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 5 pieces
two 1-1/2" $\times$ length of fabric strips. Subcut:
two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 2 pieces
From the remaining width of fabric, cut:
four 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 5-1/2" x 52-1/2" top/bottom Border 5 pieces
seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Trim to:
two 1-1/2" x 26-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 pieces
eighteen $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece 9 units for Log Cabin Block A
eighteen $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece 8 units for Log Cabin Block A

## From Fabric D, cut:

one 1-1/2" x WOF strip. Trim to:
eighteen 1-1/2" square piece 1 units for Log Cabin Block A

## From Fabric E, cut:

three 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Trim to:
eighteen 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" piece 5 units for Log Cabin Block A eighteen $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece 4 units for Log Cabin Block A

## From Fabric F , cut:

one 1-1/2" x WOF strip. Trim to:
eighteen 1-1/2" square piece 1 units for Log Cabin Block B

From Fabric G, cut:
three 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Trim to:
eighteen 1-1/2" x $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece 5 units for Log Cabin Block B eighteen $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece 4 units for Log Cabin Block B

## From Fabric H , cut:

five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Trim to:
eighteen $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece 9 units for Log Cabin Block B eighteen 1-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece 8 units for Log Cabin Block B

From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Log Cabin A Blocks



Step 1: Gather:
one each of pieces 1-9 for Block A
Step 2: Sew Piece 1 (the Fabric D square) to the bottom of Piece 2 (the Fabric B square). Press toward the darker fabric.

Step 3: Sew Piece $3\left(1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right.$ Fabric B) to the right edge of the unit. Press toward the darker fabric.

Step 4: Sew Piece $4\left(1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right.$ Fabric E) to the bottom edge of the unit. Press toward the darker fabric.

Step 5: Sew Piece $5\left(1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right.$ Fabric E) to the left edge of the unit. Press toward the darker fabric.

Step 6: Sew Piece $6\left(1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right.$ Fabric B) to the top edge of the unit. Press toward the darker fabric.

Step 7: Sew Piece $7\left(1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right.$ Fabric B) to the right edge of the unit. Press toward the darker fabric.

Step 8: Sew Piece $8\left(1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right.$ Fabric C) to the bottom edge of the unit. Press toward the darker fabric.

Step 9: Sew Piece $9\left(1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right.$ Fabric C) to the left edge of the unit. Press toward the darker fabric.

The block should measure 5-1/2" square. Repeat Steps 1-9 to make eighteen A Blocks.


Step 10: Gather:
one each of pieces 1-9 for Block B
Step 11: Using the same process described in Steps 1-9, sew each piece together in order to form the B Block, referring to the fabric placement shown in the Block Assembly Diagram.

The block should measure 5-1/2" square. Repeat Steps 1011 to make eighteen B Blocks.

## Assemble the Quilt



Step 12: Sew the side Border 1 strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 strips to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 13: Sew the side Border 2 strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 strips to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 14: Sew the side Border 3 strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 strips to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 15: Gather five A Blocks and five B Blocks. Sew together to form a column, alternating Blocks A and B and noting the fabric placement and block orientation shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew to the left edge of the quilt center. Press. Repeat to make a second column and sew to the right edge of the quilt center.

Step 16: Gather four A Blocks and four B Blocks. Sew together to form a row, alternating Blocks $A$ and $B$ and noting the fabric placement and block orientation shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew to the top edge of the quilt center. Press. Repeat to make a second row and sew to the bottom edge of the quilt center.

Step 17: Sew the side Border 4 strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 4 strips to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 18: Sew the side Border 5 strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 5 strips to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
