

Finished quilt measures: 51" x 51"



Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Assemble the quilt

Step 6: Assemble rows with each containing three blocks separated by 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric E-I pieced sashing strips. Notice the layout of the pieced strips.

Step 7: Sew each row together with a horizontal sashing strip. Rotate every other strip as show in the quilt assembly diagram.

Step 8: Sew a 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" Fabric A strip to each side of the quilt top. Press towards Fabric A.

Step 9: Sew a 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" Fabric A strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press towards Fabric A.



Attach the Mitered Borders & Finish the Quilt


Step 10: Mark 1/4" away from each corner of the quilt top using a water-soluble fabric marker.

Step 11: Center and sew the border strips edges of the quilt top between your marks. . Each border strip will overhang the corner of the quilt.

Step 12: Fold the quilt top diagonally from one corner, RST. Align the border edges of the quilt, then lay the quilt top flat. Use a ruler with a 45° marking to draw a diagonal line from the 1/4" markings you made at the corner in Step 15 with a water-soluble fabric marker.

Step 13: Sew on the marked line, then trim the overhanging border strip 1/4" away from the sewn seam.

Step 14: Repeat to sew each of the miter the border strips on each of remaining corners of the quilt.



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
