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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

From Fabric A, cut:

one 13" x WOF strip. Subcut:

three 13" squares.

Subcut each square once diagonally to six yield large setting triangles.

one 10" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 10" squares.

Subcut each square once diagonally to yield four small setting triangles. From the remainder of the strip, cut two 4" strips. Subcut:

twelve 4" squares.

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 3" squares.

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles. twenty-four 2-1/2" squares.

From Fabric B, cut:

two 4" x WOF strips. Subcut: twelve 4" squares.

From Fabric C, cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: twelve 3-1/2" squares.

From Fabric D, cut:

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-four 3-1/2" squares.

From Fabric E, cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: twelve 3-1/2" squares.

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: six 2-1/2" squares.

From Fabric F, cut:

one 12-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 12-1/2" squares.

From Fabric G, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut: two 2-1/2" x 51-1/2" side inner borders. two 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" top and bottom inner borders.

From Fabric H, cut:

five 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut: two 5" x 55-1/2" side outer borders. two 5" x 47-1/2" top and bottom outer borders. six 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Assemble the Quarter-Square Triangles (QSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 4" Fabric A square with a 4" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3-1/2" square. Repeat to make twenty-four A/B HSTs.



Step 2: Pair a 3-1/2" Fabric C square with a A/B HST, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric C square, perpendicular to the seam of the HST beneath. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two mirrored quarter -square triangles (QSTs). Press toward the larger triangle. Trim to 3" square. Repeat to make twenty-four A/B/C QSTs.



Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 3: Pair a 3-1/2" Fabric D square with a 3-1/2" Fabric E square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3" square. Repeat to make twenty-four D/E HSTs.



Assemble the Corner Units



Step 4: Gather: one 3" Fabric A square two A/B/C QSTs that are mirrors of one another one D/E HST

Arrange the units in two rows of two units as shown.

Step 5: Sew the units together to form rows. Press the seams away from the QSTs. Nest the seams and sew the rows together to form the corner unit. Repeat to make twenty-four.



Assemble the Blocks



Step 6: Gather: four corner units four 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric A rectangles one 2-1/2" Fabric E square

Arrange the units in three rows of three units as shown.

Step 7: Sew the units together to form rows. Press the seams towards the Fabric A rectangles. Nest the seams and sew the rows together to form the block. Repeat to make six blocks. The blocks should measure 12-1/2" square.



Assemble the Quilt

Step 8: Arrange the blocks, Fabric A setting triangles, and Fabric F squares in diagonal rows as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew the rows together to form the diagonal rows, then press the seams away from the blocks. Nest the seams and sew the diagonal rows together to form the quilt center.





Step 9: Measure 1/4" past the edge of the each seam intersection along the edge of the quilt and trim it square.



Step 10: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 11: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

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
