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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A-F, cut:

three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 nine 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

From each of Fabrics G-I, cut:

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 thirteen 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric J, cut:

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 fourteen 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

From each of Fabrics K and L, cut:

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 fourteen 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric M

eight 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
 two 4-1/2" x 83-1/2" side outer borders
 two 4-1/2" x 73-1/2" top/bottom outer borders
 three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 eleven 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric N, cut:

three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 eleven 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric O, cut:

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 82-1/2" side inner borders

two 1-1/2" x 63-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eleven 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

From each of Fabrics P-R, cut:

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

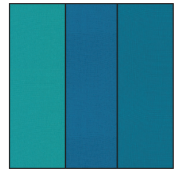
seven 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

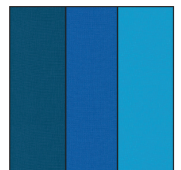
nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

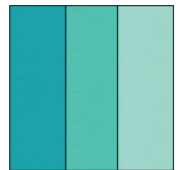
Step 1: Sew a Fabric A, Fabric B and Fabric C rectangle together, in that order, along the longest edge. Press. Repeat to make nine ABC Blocks.



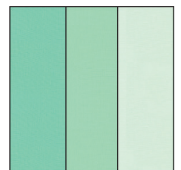
Step 2: Sew a Fabric D, Fabric E and Fabric F rectangle together, in that order, along the longest edge. Press. Repeat to make nine DEF Blocks.



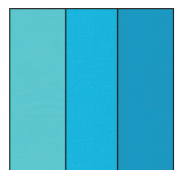
Step 3: Sew a Fabric G, Fabric H and Fabric I rectangle together, in that order, along the longest edge. Press. Repeat to make thirteen GHI Blocks.



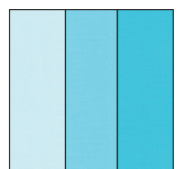
Step 4: Sew a Fabric J, Fabric K and Fabric L rectangle together, in that order, along the longest edge. Press. Repeat to make fourteen JKL Blocks.



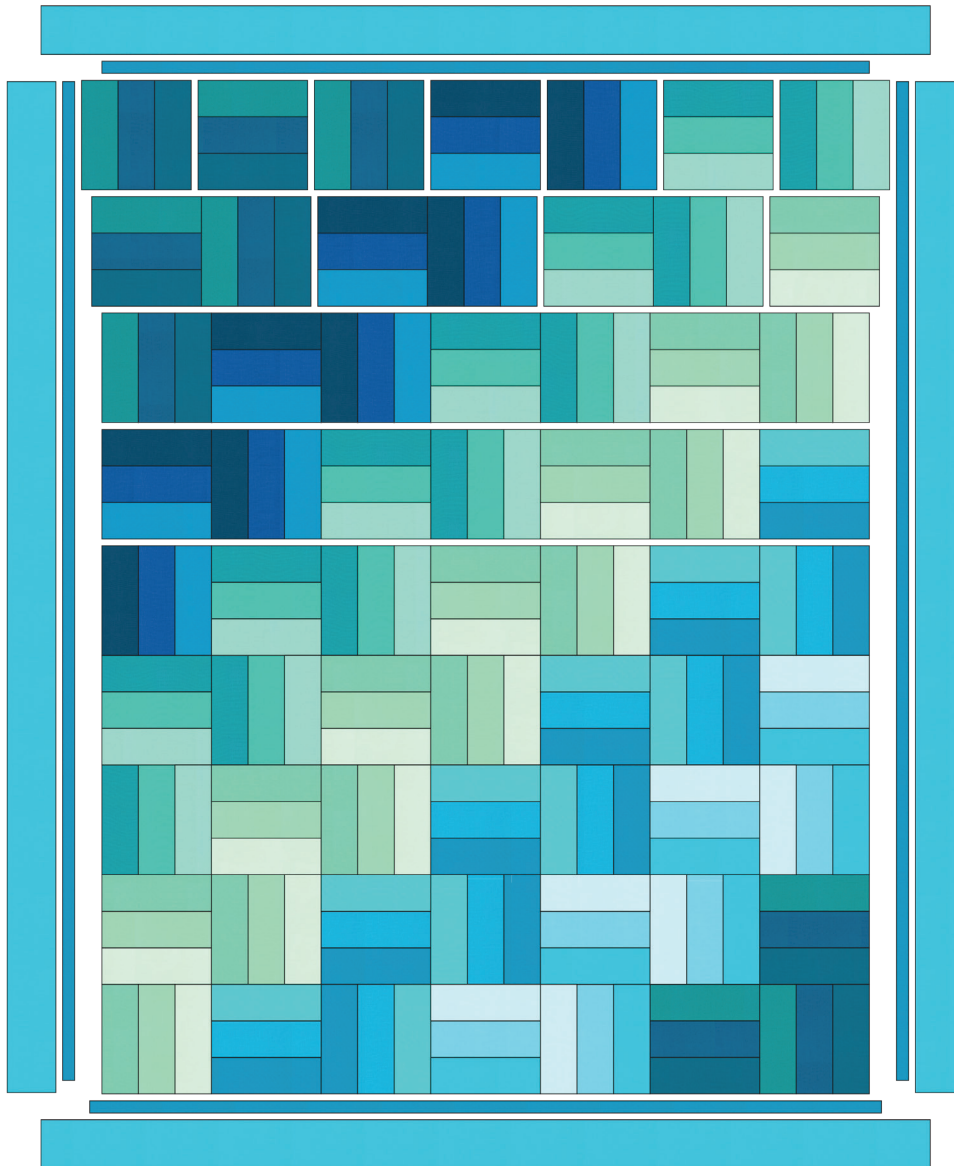
Step 5: Sew a Fabric M, Fabric N and Fabric O rectangle together, in that order, along the longest edge. Press. Repeat to make eleven MNO Blocks.



Step 6: Sew a Fabric P, Fabric Q and Fabric R rectangle together, in that order, along the longest edge. Press. Repeat to make seven PQR Blocks.



Assemble the Quilt



Step 7: Arrange the blocks into nine rows of seven blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 8: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 9: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 10: Sew the Fabric O top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric O side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 11: Sew the Fabric M side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric M top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
