## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 23" x 42-1/2" center panel

#### From Fabric B, cut:

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then cut:

two 1-1/2" x 23" top/bottom Border 1 pieces

two 1-1/2" x 44-1/2" side Border 1 pieces

five 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixty-four 3" squares for the HSTs

#### From Fabric C, cut:

four 2-1/2" x length of fabric strips. Subcut:

two 2-1/2" x 25" top/bottom Border 2 pieces

two 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" side Border 2 pieces

five 3-1/2" x length of fabric strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then cut:

two 3-1/2" x 47" top/bottom Border 4 pieces

two 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" top/bottom Border 4 pieces

#### From Fabric D, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixteen 4-1/2" squares for the block centers

#### From Fabric E, cut:

one 8-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

two 3" x 8-1/2" rectangles

four 2-1/4" x 8-1/2" rectangles

one 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

six 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixty-four 3" squares for the HSTs

two 3" x 8-1/2" rectangles

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixty-four 2-1/2" squares

#### From Fabric F, cut:

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then cut:

two 1-1/2" x 45" top/bottom Border 3 pieces

two 1-1/2" x 66-1/2" side Border 3 pieces

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Star Blocks

**Step 1:** Pair a 3" Fabric B square with a 3" Fabric E square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make one hundred twenty-eight B/E HSTs.





**Step 2:** Sew one pair of B/E HSTs together, along a Fabric E edge, as shown. Press. Repeat for all HSTs to make sixty-four pairs.

**Step 3:** Gather: four 2-1/2" Fabric E squares four HST pairs from Step 2 one 4-1/2" Fabric D square

Arrange as shown, following the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together, pressing the seams away from the Step 2 units. The block should measure 8-1/2" square. Repeat to make sixteen blocks.



### Assemble the Pieced Borders



**Step 4:** Gather: four Star Blocks two 2-1/4" x 8-1/2" Fabric E rectangles two 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric E rectangles\*\* one 3" x 8-1/2" Fabric E rectangle\*\*

\*\*Note the orientation of the cut shown. Be sure to select the correct print orientation here.

Sew together to form a side pieced border. Press the seams toward the Fabric E rectangles. Repeat to make a second side pieced border.

**Step 5:** Gather: four Star Blocks two 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric E rectangles\*\* one 3" x 8-1/2" Fabric E rectangle\*\*

\*\*Note the orientation of the cut shown. Be sure to select the correct print orientation here.



Sew together to form a top pieced border. Press the seams toward the Fabric E rectangles. Repeat to make the bottom pieced border.



**Step 6:** Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the Fabric A quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 7:** Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the Fabric A quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 8:** Sew the side Pieced Border to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the quilt center. Sew the top/bottom Pieced Border to the quilt center. Press toward the quilt center.

**Step 9:** Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 10:** Sew the top and bottom Border 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 4 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
