Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

From Fabric A, cut:

two 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twelve 6-1/2" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

ten 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-four 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles twenty-four 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

 two 5-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut: twelve 5-1/4" squares. Cut each square along both diagonals, creating forty-eight triangles.
two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric D, cut:

two 12-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: thirty-one 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" sashing strips seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: forty-eight of Template 1 forty-eight of Template 1-Reversed

From Fabric E, cut:

three 4-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-four 4-7/8" squares. Cut each square in half once on the diagonal.

From Fabric F, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then set aside for the inner border.

From Fabric G, cut:

six 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then set aside for the outer border.

From the Binding, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Assemble the Blocks



Step 1: Sew a 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric B strip to the left and right edges of a Fabric A square. Press. Sew a 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom edges of a the unit. Press. Repeat to make twelve units like this.







Step 3: Sew a completed Step 2 unit to each edge of a Step 1 unit, centering along the edge. Press. Repeat to make twelve units like this.





Step 2: Sew a Template 1 and Template 1-Reversed unit to both angled edges of a Fabric C triangle, as shown. Press. Repeat to

create forty-eight units like this.

Step 4: Sew a Fabric E triangle to the four corners of each block unit. Center before sewing and press. Repeat to create twelve units like this.

The resulting Block should measure 12-1/2" square. Trim if needed. Make twelve Blocks.

Assemble the Quilt

Step 5: Arrange the Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each column together, using sashing strips between each block and at the beginning and end of each column. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make three block columns.

Step 6: Gather five cornerstone squares and four sashing strips. Sew each column together, using cornerstones between each sashing strip and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make four sashing columns.

Step 7: Sew the sashing and block columns together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 8: Measure the length of the quilt through the center. Cut two Fabric F side border

the border.

strips to this length. Sew the borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the border. Measure the width of the guilt through the center. Cut two Fabric F top/bottom border strips to this width. Sew the borders to the top and bottom of the guilt center. Press toward


Step 9: Measure the length of the quilt through the center. Cut two Fabric G side outer border strips to this length. Sew the borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the border. Measure the width of the quilt through the center. Cut two Fabric G top/bottom outer border strips to this width. Sew the borders to the top and bottom of the guilt center. Press toward the border.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
