# Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

# **Cutting Instructions**

# From Fabric A, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

six 5-1/2" squares. Cut two squares in half along the diagonal from upper left to lower right and cut four in half along the diagonal from lower left to upper right.

## From Fabric B, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twelve 5-1/2" squares. Cut six squares in half along the diagonal from upper left to lower right and cut six in half along the diagonal from lower left to upper right.

## From Fabric C, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

seven 5-1/2" squares. Cut four squares in half along the diagonal from upper left to lower right and cut three in half along the diagonal from lower left to upper right.

## From Fabric D, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

seven 5-1/2" squares. Cut two squares in half along the diagonal from upper left to lower right and cut five in half along the diagonal from lower left to upper right.

# From Fabric E, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eight 5-1/2" squares. Cut three squares in half along the diagonal from upper left to lower right and cut five in half along the diagonal from lower left to upper right.

# From Fabric F, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eight 5-1/2" squares. Cut four squares in half along the diagonal from upper left to lower right and cut four in half along the diagonal from lower left to upper right.

# From Fabric G, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eight 5-1/2" squares. Cut four squares in half along the diagonal from upper left to lower right and cut four in half along the diagonal from lower left to upper right.

# From Fabric H, cut:

one 5" x WOF strip. Subcut:

six 5-1/2" squares. Cut five squares in half along the diagonal from upper left to lower right and cut one in half along the diagonal from lower left to upper right.

# From Fabric I, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 5-1/2" squares. Cut all four squares in half along the diagonal from upper left to lower right.

# From Fabric J, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

six 5-1/2" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal.

# From Fabric K, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

six 5-1/2" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal.

# From Fabric L, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twelve 5-1/2" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal.

## From Fabric M, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

six 5-1/2" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal.

## From Fabric N, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twelve 5-1/2" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal.

# From Fabric O, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

six 5-1/2" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal.

six 4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 4" x 61-1/2" side outer borders

two 4" x 58" top/bottom outer borders

# From Fabric P, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

six 5-1/2" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal.

## From Fabric Q. cut:

twenty-four 1-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

forty-eight 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" block sashing strips

Sew the remaining twelve strips together, end-to-end, then cut:

five 1-1/2" x 49" row sashing strips

two 1-1/2" x 59-1/2" side inner borders

two 1-1/2" x 51" top/bottom inner borders

# From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

# Assemble the Blocks



**Step 1:** Gather:

two Fabric J triangles

one Fabric A triangle in the orientation shown

one Fabric B triangle in the orientation shown

**Step 2:** Sew the triangles together in pairs, along the longest edge, to form two half-square triangle units. Press. Trim to 5" square, as needed.

**Step 3:** Sew the HSTs together to form a block. Press. The block should measure 5" x 9-1/2" unfinished.

**Step 4:** Continue sewing blocks in this way, referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement and print orientation. It can be helpful to gather each of the pieces for each block before sewing.

Make six blocks using Fabric J

Make six blocks using Fabric K

Make twelve blocks using Fabric L


Make six blocks using Fabric M

Make twelve blocks using Fabric N

Make six blocks using Fabric O

Make six blocks using Fabric P

Note: Pay careful attention to the orientation and direction of the print triangles. Not all print triangles will be used.




**Step 5:** Arrange the Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, noting the solid colors in each column and the orientation of each block. Sew each row together, using Fabric Q block sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make six block rows.

- **Step 6:** Sew the rows together, using a Fabric Q row sashing strip between each row. Press seams open or to the sashing.
- **Step 7:** Sew the Fabric Q side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric Q top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.
- **Step 8:** Sew the Fabric O side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric O top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
