

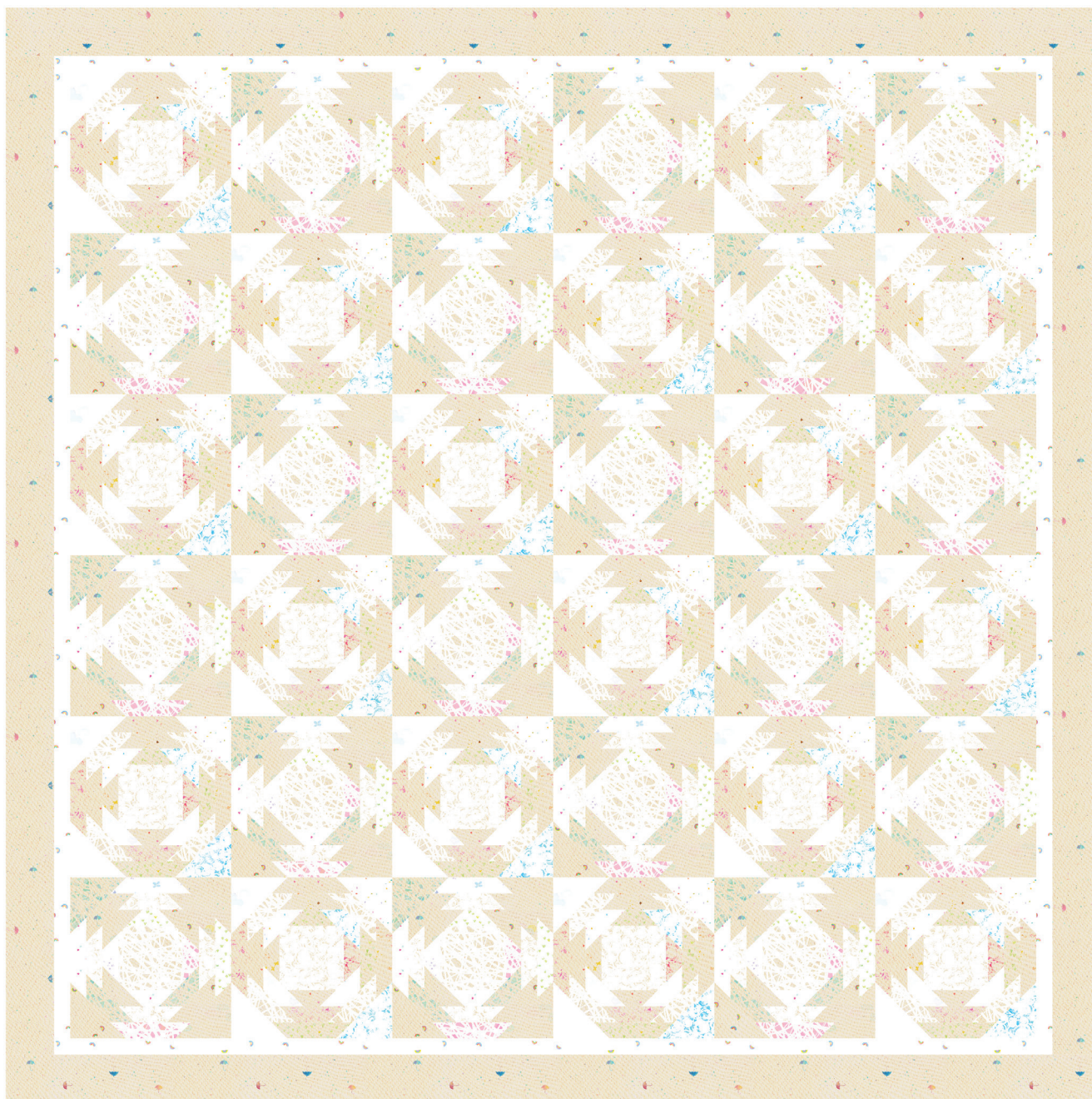

Finished quilt measures: 68" x 68"

















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

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### From each of Fabrics A and B, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eighteen 4-1/2" squares for the block centers

one 4-3/8" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 4-3/8" squares. Cut each in half along one diagonal for the Piece 6 units

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eight 1-1/2" x 4-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 1 units

eight 1-1/2" x 4-3/4" rectangles for the Piece 2 units

eight 1-1/2" x 5-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 3 units

eight 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles for the Piece 4 units

eight 1-1/2" x 6-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 5 units



**From each of Fabrics C-I, cut:**

one 4-3/8" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 4-3/8" squares. Cut each in half along one diagonal for the Piece 6 units

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eight 1-1/2" x 4-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 1 units

eight 1-1/2" x 4-3/4" rectangles for the Piece 2 units

eight 1-1/2" x 5-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 3 units

eight 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles for the Piece 4 units

eight 1-1/2" x 6-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 5 units

**From Fabric J, cut:**

one 4-3/8" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 4-3/8" squares. Cut each in half along one diagonal for the Piece 6 units

thirteen 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew seven strips together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" side Border 1 strips

two 1-1/2" x 62-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 strips

From the remaining six strips, subcut:

eight 1-1/2" x 4-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 1 units

eight 1-1/2" x 4-3/4" rectangles for the Piece 2 units

eight 1-1/2" x 5-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 3 units

eight 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles for the Piece 4 units

eight 1-1/2" x 6-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 5 units

**From Fabric K, cut:**

one 4-3/8" x WOF strip. Subcut:

five 4-3/8" squares. Cut each in half along one diagonal for the Piece 6 units

seven 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew seven strips together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 3-1/2" x 62-1/2" side Border 2 strips

two 3-1/2" x 68-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 strips

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

nine 1-1/2" x 4-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 1 units

nine 1-1/2" x 4-3/4" rectangles for the Piece 2 units

nine 1-1/2" x 5-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 3 units

nine 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles for the Piece 4 units

nine 1-1/2" x 6-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 5 units

**From each of Fabrics L-R, cut:**

one 4-3/8" x WOF strip. Subcut:

five 4-3/8" squares. Cut each in half along one diagonal for the Piece 6 units

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

nine 1-1/2" x 4-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 1 units

nine 1-1/2" x 4-3/4" rectangles for the Piece 2 units

nine 1-1/2" x 5-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 3 units

nine 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles for the Piece 4 units

nine 1-1/2" x 6-1/4" rectangles for the Piece 5 units

**From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Organize the Cut Units

In order to make assembly more streamlined, it is recommended that you organize the cut pieces into two piles/stacks:

### Stack A (for the A Blocks)

all of the Fabric A squares

all of the Piece 1, 3 and 5 units from Fabrics K-R

all of the Piece 2, 4 and 6 units from Fabrics A-J

### Stack B (for the B Blocks)

all of the Fabric B squares

all of the Piece 1, 3 and 5 units from Fabrics A-J

all of the Piece 2, 4 and 6 units from Fabrics K-R

## Assemble the A Blocks

### **Step 1:** Gather:

one Fabric A square

four Piece 1 units (in assorted fabrics)

four Piece 2 units (in assorted fabrics)

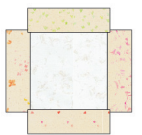
four Piece 3 units (in assorted fabrics)

four Piece 4 units (in assorted fabrics)

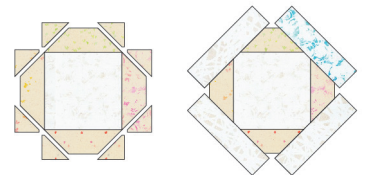
four Piece 5 units (in assorted fabrics)

four Piece 6 units (in assorted fabrics)

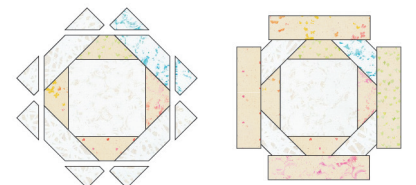
**Step 2:** Center and sew a Piece 1 unit to each edge of the center square. Press.



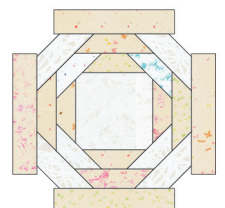
**Step 3:** Trim the unit, as shown, making a 45-degree cut at each corner. The cut line will be placed at the finished corner of the center square. Center and sew a Piece 2 unit to each cut edge. Press.



**Step 4:** Trim the unit, as shown. The cut line will be placed along the raw outer edge of the Piece 1 units sewn in Step 2. Center and sew a Piece 3 unit to each cut edge. Press.



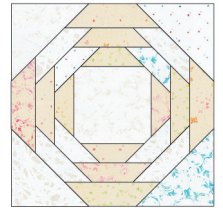
**Step 5:** Continue adding the Piece 4 units and then the Piece 5 units, using the process shown in Step 4. Press.



**Step 6:** Center and place a Piece 6 triangle to each corner, along the long raw edge remaining on Piece 4. Press.

**Step 7:** Trim the A Block to 10-1/2" square.

Repeat Steps 1-7 to make a total of eighteen A Blocks.



## Assemble the B Blocks

**Step 8:** Gather:

one Fabric B square

four Piece 1 units (in assorted fabrics)

four Piece 2 units (in assorted fabrics)

four Piece 3 units (in assorted fabrics)

four Piece 4 units (in assorted fabrics)

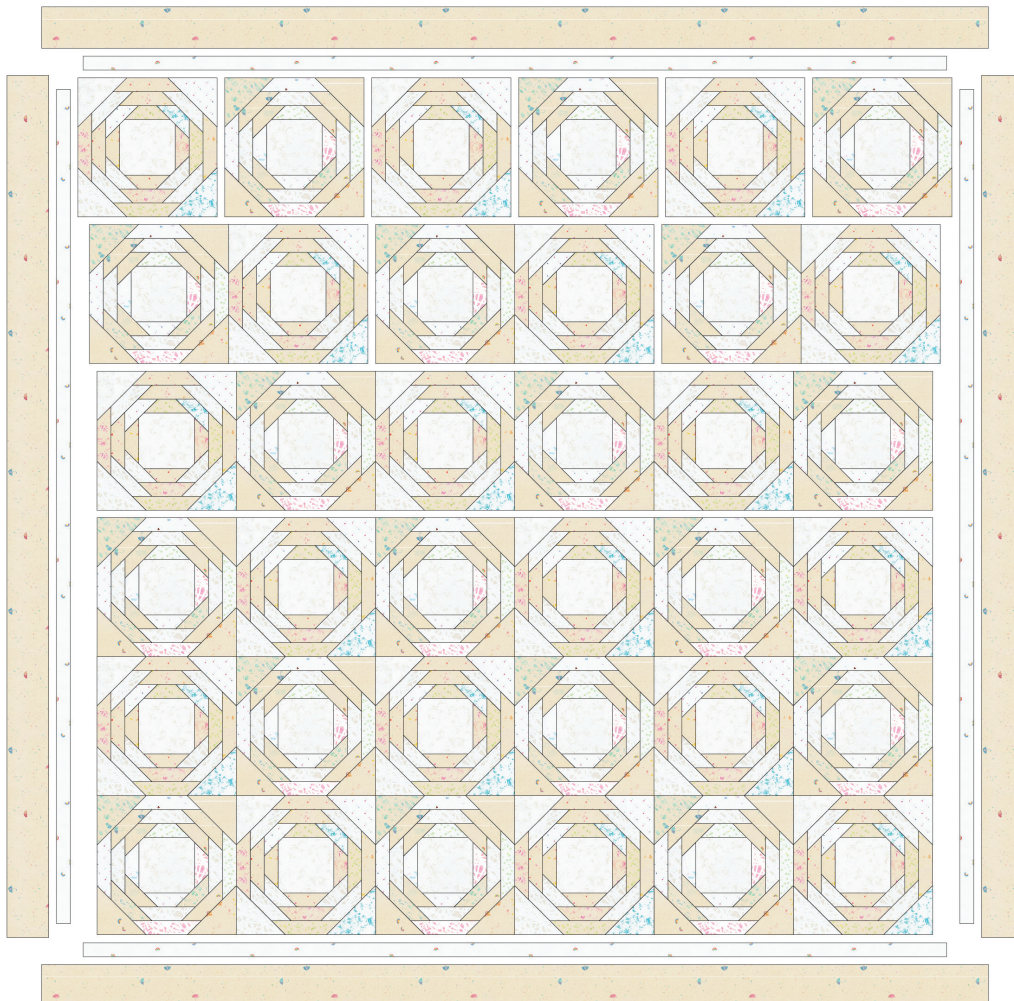
four Piece 5 units (in assorted fabrics)

four Piece 6 units (in assorted fabrics)



**Step 9:** Repeat Steps 1-7 to make a total of eighteen B Blocks.

## Assemble the Quilt



**Step 10:** Arrange the A and B Blocks into six rows of six blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

**Step 11:** Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

**Step 12:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

**Step 13:** Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 14:** Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
