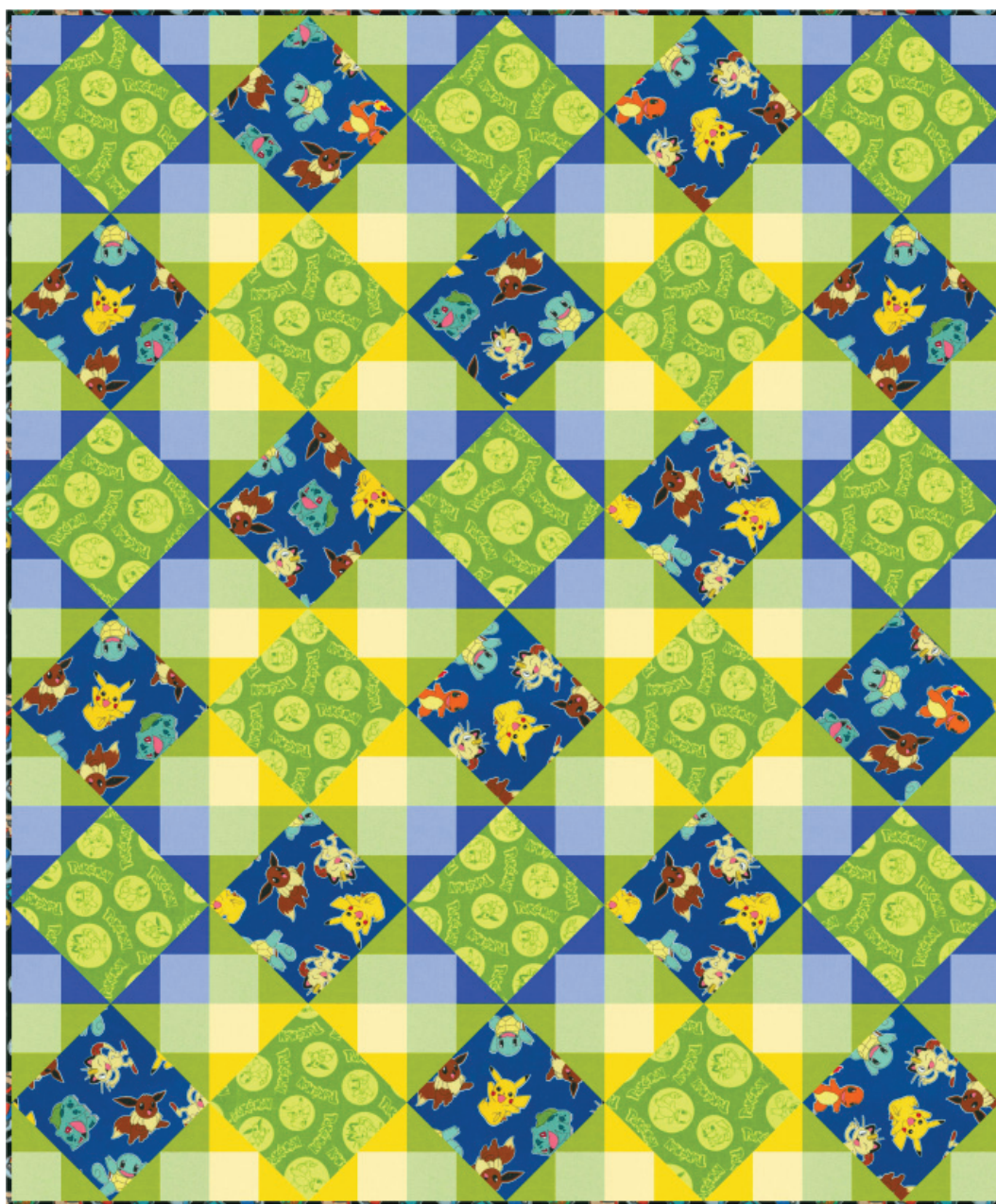




Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A and B, cut:

three 6-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:
fifteen 6-7/8" squares

From Fabric C, cut:

three 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-six 2-3/4" squares

From Fabric D, cut:

three 3-1/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-six 3-1/8" squares. Cut each square in half once on a diagonal, creating two triangles

From Fabric E, cut:

four 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixty 2-3/4" squares

From Fabric F, cut:

five 3-1/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixty 3-1/8" squares. Cut each square in half once on a diagonal, creating two triangles

From Fabric G, cut:

two 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-four 2-3/4" squares

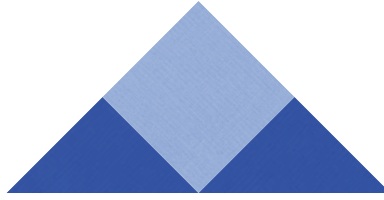
From Fabric F, cut:

two 3-1/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-four 3-1/8" squares. Cut each square in half once on a diagonal, creating two triangles

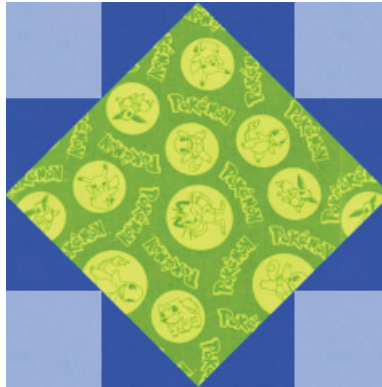
From Fabric I, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding

Assemble the A Blocks

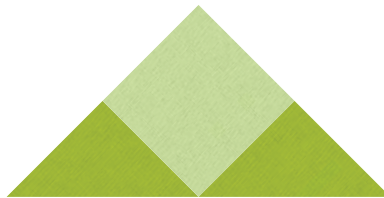


Step 1: Sew a Fabric D triangle to two adjacent sides of a Fabric C square. Press the seams toward the triangles. Repeat for all remaining Fabric C squares.



Step 2: Sew one completed Step 1 unit to each edge of a Fabric A square. Press the seams toward the square. Trim the block to 9-1/2" square, if necessary. Repeat to create nine A Blocks.

Assemble the B Blocks

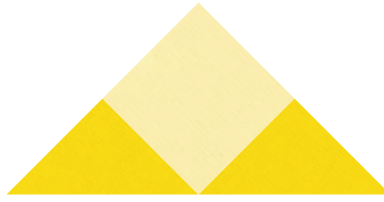


Step 3: Sew a Fabric F triangle to two adjacent sides of a Fabric E square. Press the seams toward the triangles. Repeat for all remaining Fabric E squares.

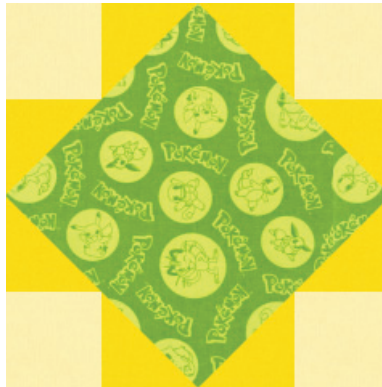


Step 4: Sew one completed Step 3 unit to each edge of a Fabric B square. Press the seams toward the square. Trim the block to 9-1/2" square, if necessary. Repeat to create fifteen B Blocks.

Assemble the C Blocks

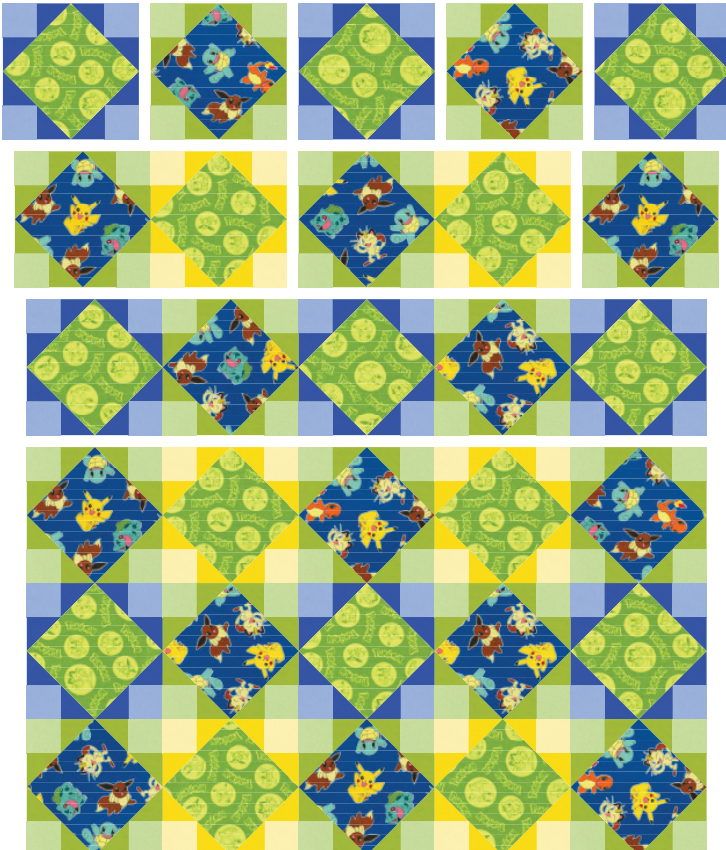


Step 5: Sew a Fabric H triangle to two adjacent sides of a Fabric G square. Press the seams toward the triangles. Repeat for all remaining Fabric G squares.



Step 6: Sew one completed Step 5 unit to each edge of a Fabric A square. Press the seams toward the square. Trim the block to 9-1/2" square, if necessary. Repeat to create six C Blocks.

Notes Before You Begin



Step 7: Arrange the blocks into six rows of five blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 8: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams toward the B Blocks.










Step 9: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt is now complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
