Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

ten 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: seventy 5-1/2" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

eleven 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: seventy-two 5-1/2" squares

From Fabric C, cut:

eleven 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: one-hundred and forty-two 3" squares

From Fabric D, cut:

sixteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixty-three 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" sashing rectangles eleven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: two-hundred and eighty-two 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric E, cut:


three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: forty 2-1/2" cornerstone squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:


seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks


Step 1: Mark a diagonal line on each 3" Fabric C square and each 1-1/2" Fabric D square.




Step 2: Place a marked Fabric C square on three corners of a 5-1/2" Fabric A square. Place a marked Fabric D square on the remaining corner. Sew on the marked lines. Trim the excess fabric 1/4" away from the sewn seams. Press. Make fifty-six #1 Units.




Step 3: Place a marked Fabric C square on three corners of a 5-1/2" Fabric B square. Place a marked Fabric D square on the remaining corner. Sew on the marked lines. Trim the excess fabric 1/4" away from the sewn seams. Press. Make fifty-four #2 Units.




Step 4: Place a marked Fabric C square on two adjacent corners of a 5-1/2" Fabric B square. Place a marked Fabric D square on one of the remaining corners as shown. Sew on the marked lines. Trim the excess fabric 1/4" away from the sewn seams. Press. Make eight #3 Units.




Step 5: Place a marked Fabric C square on two adjacent corners of a 5-1/2" Fabric B square. Place a marked Fabric D square on one of the remaining corners as shown. Sew on the marked lines. Trim the excess fabric 1/4" away from the sewn seams. Press. Make ten #4 Units.




Step 6: Place a marked Fabric C square on two adjacent corners of a 5-1/2" Fabric A square. Place a marked Fabric D square on one of the remaining corners as shown. Sew on the marked lines. Trim the excess fabric 1/4" away from the sewn seams. Press. Make eight #5 Units.




Step 7: Place a marked Fabric C square on two adjacent corners of a 5-1/2" Fabric A square. Place a marked Fabric D square on one of the remaining corners as shown. Sew on the marked lines. Trim the excess fabric 1/4" away from the sewn seams. Press. Make six #6 Units.




Step 8: Arrange two #1 Units and two #2 Units in two rows of two as shown. Sew the units together to make rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make twenty-four A Blocks.




Step 9: Arrange one #1 Unit, one #3 Unit, and one #4 Unit in two rows as shown. Sew the two units in the bottom row together, then press. Sew the unit in the upper row to the bottom row, then press. Make eight B Blocks.



Step 10: Arrange one #2 Unit, one #5 Unit, and one #6 Unit in two rows as shown. Sew the two units in the bottom row together, then press. Sew the unit in the upper row to the bottom row, then press. Make six C Blocks.




Step 11: Arrange one #4 Unit and one #5 Unit in one column as shown. Sew the two units together, then press. Make two D Blocks.



Assemble the Blocks

- **Step 12:** Arrange the blocks into eight diagonal rows. Note the block placement and orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.
- **Step 13:** Separate the blocks in each row with 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric D sashing rectangles. Note the placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.
- **Step 14:** Sew the blocks and sashing rectangles together to form diagonal rows. Press the seams toward the sashing rectangles.
- **Step 15:** Place the remaining 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric D sashing rectangles and the 2-1/2" Fabric E cornerstone squares in between the diagonal rows to form sashing strips. Note the placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.
- **Step 16:** Sew the sashing rectangles and cornerstone squares together to form the horizontal rows. Press the seams toward the sashing rectangles.

Step 17: Sew the rows and horizontal sashing strips together to form the quilt center. Press.



Step 18: Measure and mark 1/4" past each seam intersection along the perimeter of the quilt top as shown. Trim the quilt top along this line.

Step 19: Staystitch 1/8" away from the edge of the quilt top to prevent stretching.



Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
