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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

one 17" x WOF strip. Subcut:
 one 17" square for the Large HSTs
 Trim the remainder of the strip to make two 3" wide strips. Subcut:
 sixteen 3" squares for the Small HSTs
one each of Templates 2-10

From Fabric B, cut:

one 17" x WOF strip. Subcut:
 one 17" square for the Large HSTs
 Trim the remainder of the strip to make two 3" wide strips. Subcut:
 twelve 3" squares for the Small HSTs
two each of Templates 13-16

From Fabric C, cut:

one 17" x WOF strip. Subcut:
 one 17" square for the Large HSTs
 Trim the remainder of the strip to make two 3" wide strips. Subcut:
 twelve 3" squares for the Small HSTs
one each of Templates 2-10
one each of Templates 17-21
one each of Templates 22-32
one each of Templates 33-41

From Fabric D, cut:

one 17" x WOF strip. Subcut:
 one 17" square for the Large HSTs
 Trim the remainder of the strip to make two 3" wide strips. Subcut:
 twelve 3" squares for the Small HSTs
one of Template 1
one each of Templates 22-32
one each of Templates 33-41

From Fabric E, cut:

one 17" x WOF strip. Subcut:
 one 17" square for the Large HSTs
 Trim the remainder of the strip to make two 3" wide strips. Subcut:
 twelve 3" squares for the Small HSTs

From Fabric F, cut:

one 17" x WOF strip. Subcut:

one 17" square for the Large HSTs

Trim the remainder of the strip to make two 3" wide strips. Subcut:

twelve 3" squares for the Small HSTs

one of Template 1

four of Template 12

From Fabric G, cut:

one 17" x WOF strip. Subcut:

one 17" square for the Large HSTs

Trim the remainder of the strip to make two 3" wide strips. Subcut:

sixteen 3" squares for the Small HSTs

one of Template 1

one each of Templates 17-21

one each of Templates 22-32

one each of Templates 33-41

From Fabric H, cut:

one 17" x WOF strip. Subcut:

one 17" square for the Large HSTs

Trim the remainder of the strip to make one 3" wide strip. Subcut:

eight 3" squares for the Small HSTs

From Fabric I, cut:

four of Template 11

From Fabric J, cut:

one each of Templates 2-10

two each of Templates 13-16

one each of Templates 17-21

From Fabric K, cut:

one of Template 1

From Fabric L, cut:

one each of Templates 2-10

one each of Templates 17-21

one each of Templates 22-32

one each of Templates 33-41

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the Placemats

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the Runner

Prepare the Templates

Step 1: Copy all templates at 100%.

Step 2: On the fusible web, trace the indicated number of each Template, as instructed on the Template sheets. Be sure to note the quantity. *Tip: In addition to the piece number, include the fabric letter shown on the Template. This will help you to ensure you are fusing it to the correct fabric.*

Step 3: Cut out each traced shape, leaving 1/4"-1/2" of excess fusible web outside the marked lines. You will NOT cut on the marked/traced lines at this point.

Step 4: Follow in the steps below to fuse each piece to the appropriate fabric. Fuse, following the manufacturer's instructions, then cut out each shape on the marked line.

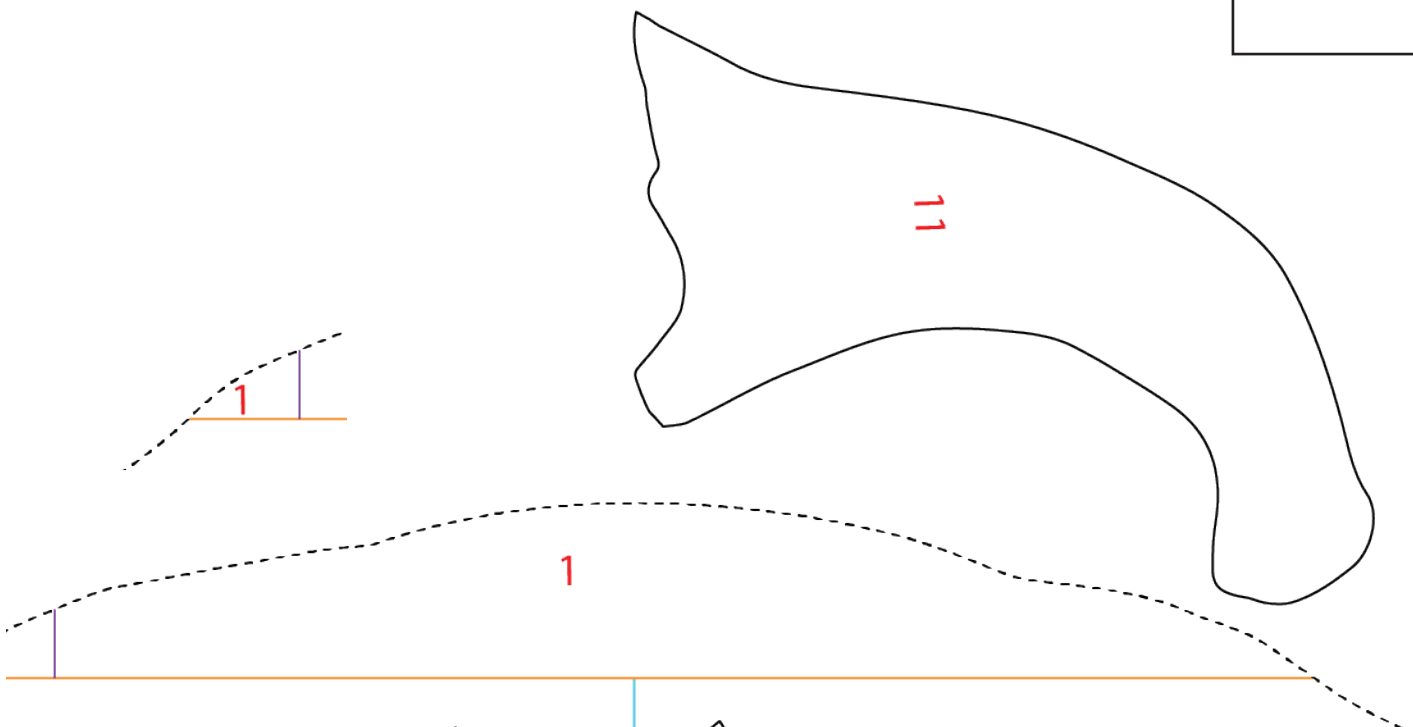
Templates

Print at 100%.

Check size printed correctly using 1" box for scale prior to cutting fabric.

Align multiple parts of the templates along the matching colored lines.

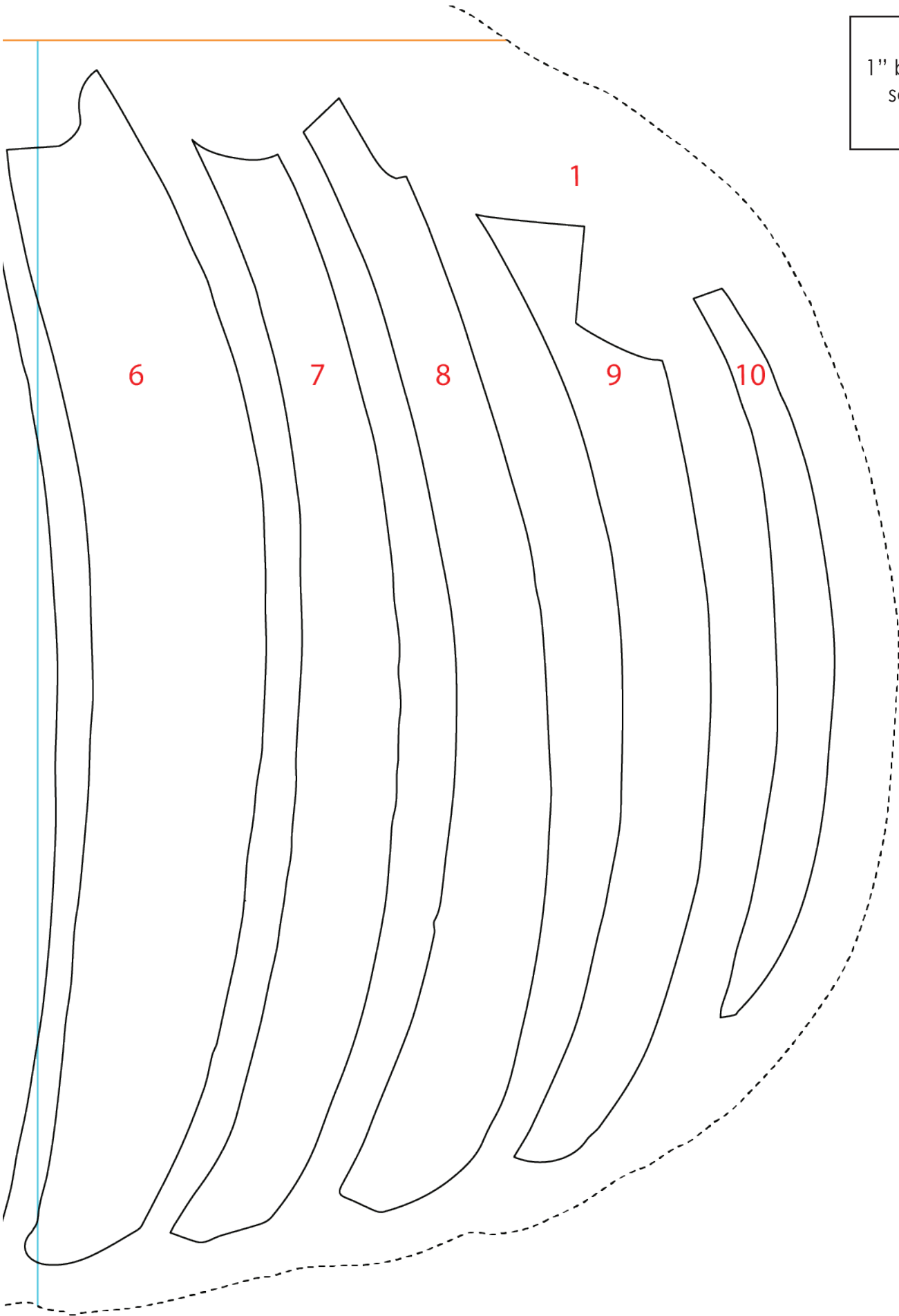
Tape together to form the full templates.



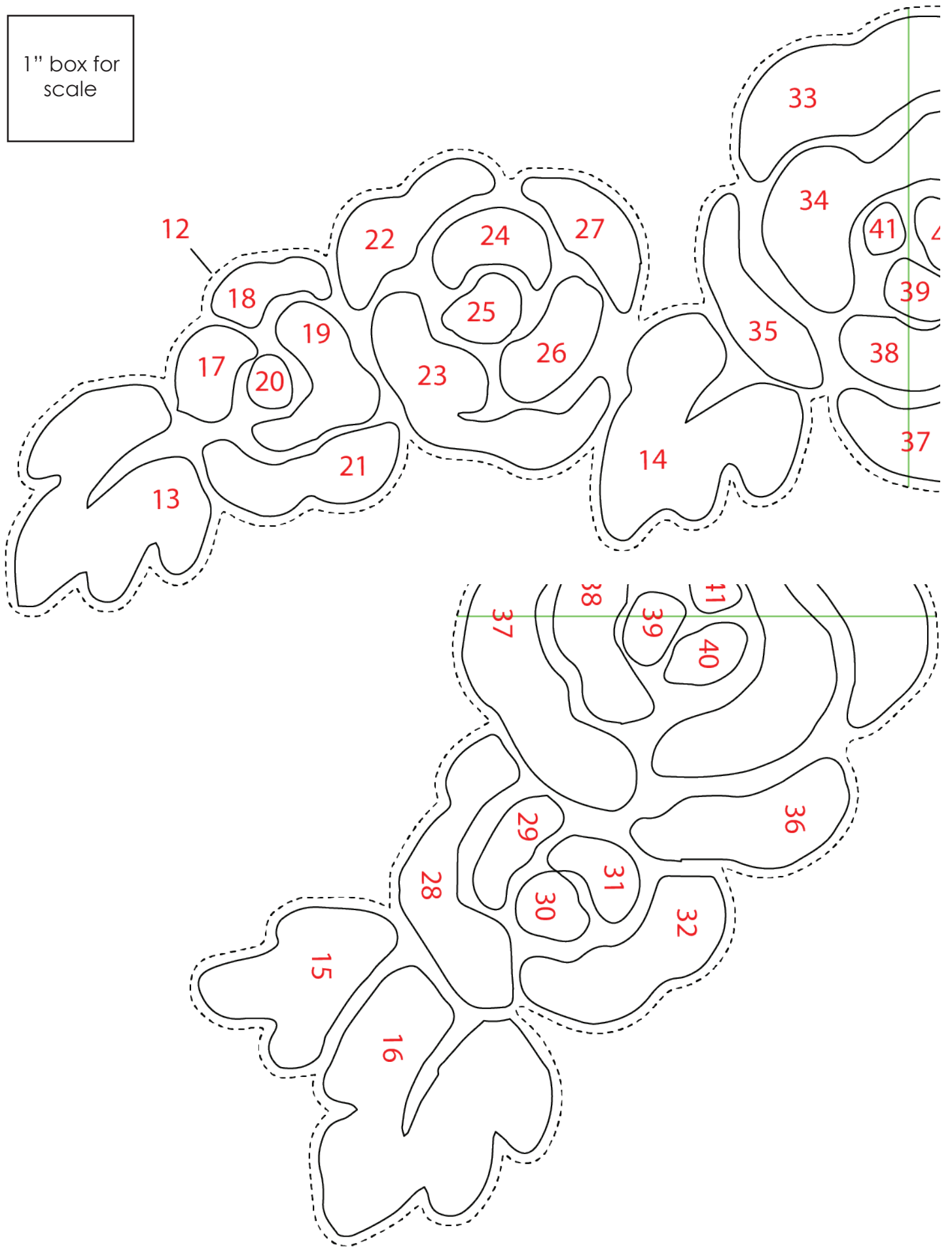

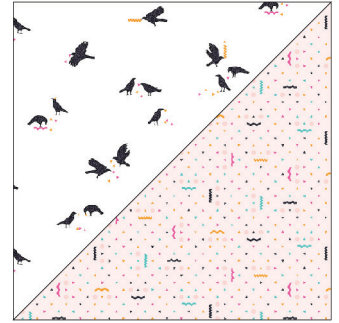

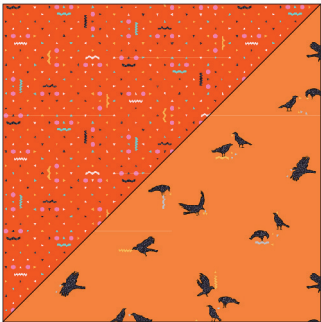


Assemble the Half-Square Triangles

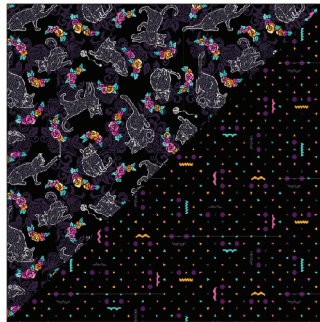
Step 1: Pair a 17" Fabric A square with a Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 16-1/2" square. Make two A/B HSTs. These will be referred to as the Large HSTs.



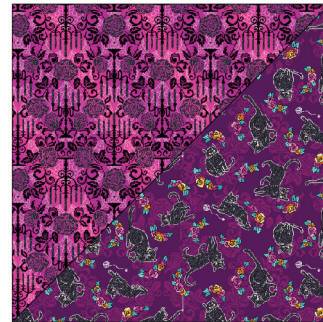
Repeat to make:



two C/D Large HSTs



two E/F Large HSTs




two G/H Large HSTs

Step 2: Using the 3" squares, and trimming to 2-1/2" square when finished, repeat Step 1 to make:

 sixteen A/G Small HSTs

 twenty-four B/C Small HSTs

 twenty-four D/E Small HSTs

 twenty-four F/G Small HSTs

 sixteen H/A Small HSTs

Assemble the Placemats



Step 3: Sew eight A/G Small HSTs together to form the left edge of Placemat 1. Press.

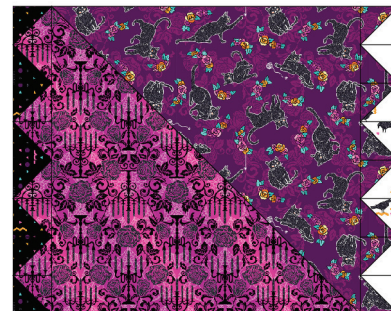
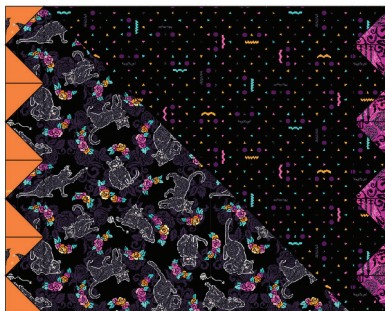
Sew eight B/C Small HSTs together to form the right edge of Placemat 1. Press



Step 4: Sew the HST units from Step 3 to the left and right edges of the A/B Large HST, noting the fabric placement in the diagram. Press.



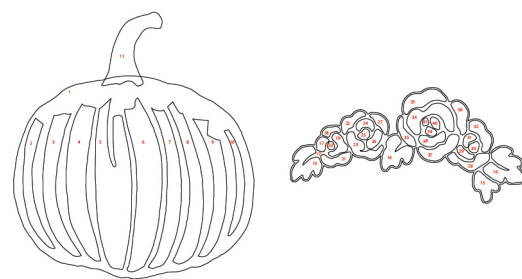
Step 5: Repeat the process in Steps 3 and 4 to make Placemats 2, 3 and 4, referring to the diagrams for fabric placement and unit orientation.



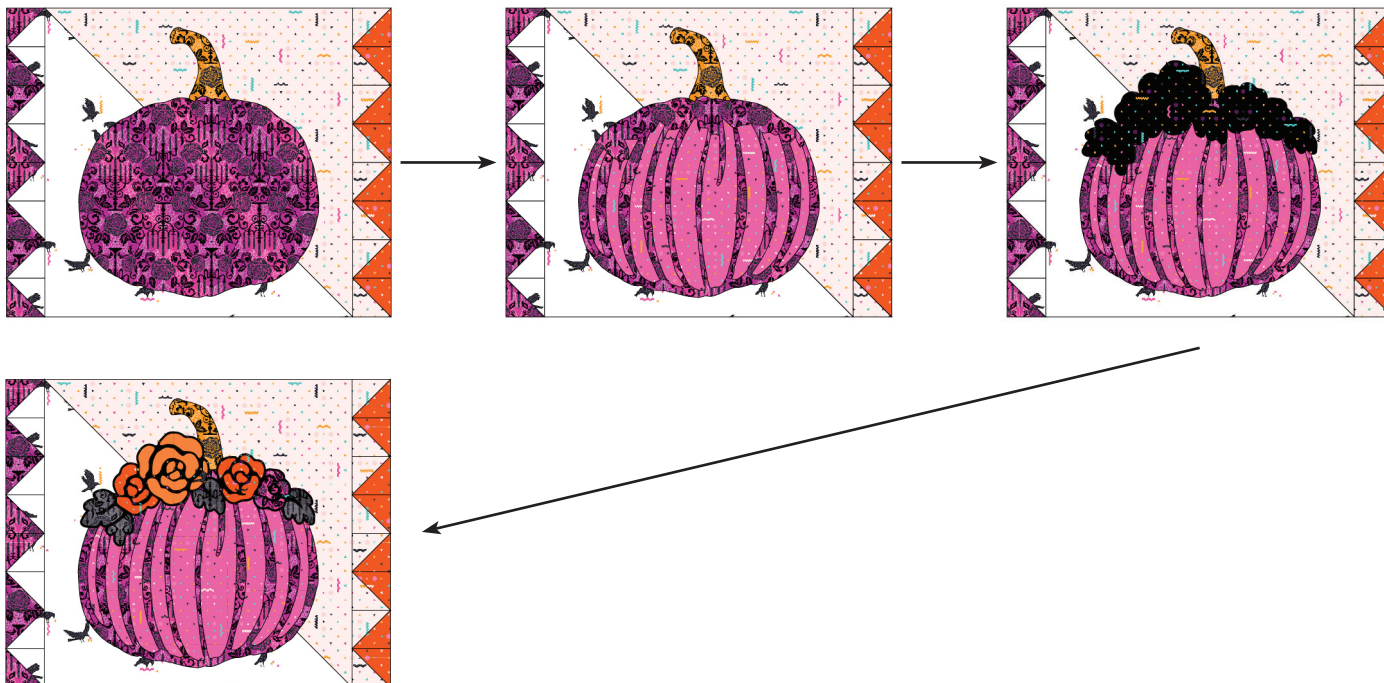
Step 6: Repeat the process in Steps 3 and 4 to make the Runner. Press.



Step 7: Using the Appliqué Placement diagram as a guide, place the assorted Template pieces in the locations indicated. Pin in place on their respective Placemats or Runner.



One piece at a time, peel the paper backing from the lower layer Template pieces and fuse to the base. Continue by peeling the backing to the upper layer Template pieces and fusing to the base as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Edge stitch the templates to the block.



Repeat for all four Placemats and the Runner.



Your Placemats and Runner tops are complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
