## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From the Roll Up Strips, cut:

a total of one hundred $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

- Tip: Cut the exact fabrics in the quantities shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, or for a more random layout, cut two rectangles from twenty of the strips and three rectangles from the remaining twenty and mix and match to your desire.

From Fabric A, cut:
one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

- ten 3 " squares for the HSTs
twenty-four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew ten strips together, end-to-end, then trim:
- four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 46-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ row sashing strips
- two 2-1/2" $\times 58-1 / 2$ " side outer borders
- two 2-1/2" $\times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom outer borders
- From the remaining strips, cut:
- eighty 2-1/2" squares for the pumpkin corners. Mark a diagonal line on the back of each square.
- forty $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- fifteen $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for the block sashing

From Fabric B, cut:
one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

- ten 3 " squares for the HSTs

From the Binding Fabric, cut:
six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 3" Fabric A square with a 3 " Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the
 darker fabric. Trim to $2-1 / 2$ " square. Repeat to make twenty A/B HSTs.

## Assemble the Blocks



Step 2: Gather:
five assorted print rectangles from the Roll Up
four 2-1/2" Fabric A squares
one $\mathrm{A} / \mathrm{B}$ HST
two 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles

Step 3: Place a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square at the left end of a print rectangle, right sides together. Note the orientation of the marked diagonal line. Sew on the marked line, then trim away the excess fabric, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press. Repeat on the right end of the rectangle with another $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square. Repeat to make a second unit like this.


Arrange the Step 3 units and three remaining print rectangles together to form the pumpkin center. Note the block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 4: Sew the rectangles together to form the Block Center. Press the seams toward the center strip.

Step 5: Sew the Fabric A rectangles to either side of the HST. Press the seams away from the HST.

Step 6: Sew the Step 4 and Step 5 units together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The resulting Pumpkin Block should measure 10-1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of twenty Pumpkin Blocks. Note that in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, fourteen stems point one direction, and six stems point the other direction.


Assemble the Quilt


Step 7: Arrange the Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make five block rows.

Step 8: Sew the sashing and block rows together. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 9: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
