Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42 " wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From Fabric A, cut:

fifteen $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-six 3" x 10-1/2" rectangles for the Pumpkin Blocks.
thirty-six $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for the Pumpkin Blocks.
seventeen 2-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
seventy-two 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for the Bordered Nine-Patch Blocks. seventy-two 2-1/2" squares for the Bordered Nine-Patch Blocks.
one 2 " x WOF strip. Subcut: nine 2" squares for the HSTs.
five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-six 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for the Stem Units. seventy-two 1-1/2" squares for the Stitch-and-Flip Units.

## From Fabric B, cut:

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eighteen 2-1/2" squares for the Bordered Nine-Patch Blocks.
one 2" x WOF strip. Subcut: nine 2 " squares for the HSTs.

From each of Fabric C-H, cut:
one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
three $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles of each fabric for the Stitch-and-Flip Units.

## From each of Fabrics I and J, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
seventy-two 2-1/2" squares for the Bordered Nine-Patch Blocks.
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 2" Fabric A square with a 2" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 1-1/2" square. Make eighteen HSTs.


Step 2 : Place a 1-1/2" Fabric A square on each corner of a $4-1 / 2$ " $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square, oriented as shown. Sew on the marked lines. Cut on the marked lines, then press towards the corners.


Step 3: Repeat Step 2 to make Stitch-and-Flip Units in the fabrics and quantities shown below.


Assemble the Pumpkin Blocks
Step 4: Gather one HST and two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles. Sew the rectangles to two opposite edges of the HST as shown. Press. Repeat to make eighteen Stem Units.

Step 5: Sew a Stem Unit to the top of a Stitch-and-Flip Unit. Press towards the top.


Step 6: Sew a 3" x 5-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the top and bottom of the unit. Press towards the rectangles.


Step 7: Sew a $3^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle to the right and left edges of the unit. Press towards the rectangles to complete the Pumpkin Block.


Step 8: Repeat Steps 5-7 to make Pumpkin Blocks in the fabric combinations and quantities shown below.


## Assemble the Bordered Nine-Patch Blocks

Step 9: Gather four 2-1/2" Fabric A squares, one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square, and four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I squares. Arrange the squares in three rows of three to make a ninepatch. Sew the squares together to form rows, then press the seams towards the Fabric A squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press the seams in
 one direction. Make eighteen nine-patches.

Step 10: Gather one 2-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle and two 2-1/2" Fabric $J$ squares. Sew the squares to each short end of the rectangle, then press towards the rectangle. Make thirty-six units.

Step 11: Gather two 2-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles and one nine-patch from Step 9. Sew the two rectangles along the left and right edges of the nine-patch, then press towards the rectangles. Make eighteen units.

Step 12: Gather two Step 10 units and one Step 11 unit. Sew the Step 10 units to the top and bottom of the Step 11 unit. Press towards the top and bottom edges to complete the block. Make eighteen Bordered Nine-Patch Blocks.


## Assemble the Quilt



Step 13: Arrange the blocks into six rows of six blocks. Note the block placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 14: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the even-numbered rows.

Step 15: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.
Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
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
