
PUPPY PLAYGROUND

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

eight 9-1/2" x 11" rectangles

From Fabric B, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew three strips together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2-1/2" x 54" top/bottom middle borders

From the remaining two strips, subcut:

six 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles

six 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

six 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" side block borders

six 1-1/2" x 13" top/bottom block borders

From Fabric C, cut:

five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eight 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" side block borders

eight 1-1/2" x 13" top/bottom block borders

From Fabric D, cut:

three 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" side block borders

four 1-1/2" x 13" top/bottom block borders

From Fabric E, cut:

three 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twelve 5" x 5-1/2" rectangles

twelve 5" x 3-1/2" rectangles

six 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then trim:

four 3-1/2" x 54" row sashing strips

From Fabric F, cut:

one 9-1/2" x 11" rectangle

From the remaining yardage, fussy cut:

three 4" x remaining WOF strips. Sew three strips together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 4" x 54" top/bottom outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

Step 1: Sew a 1-1/2" \times 9-1/2" Fabric C block border to the left and right edges of a Fabric A block center. Press. Sew a 1-1/2" \times 13" Fabric C block border to the top and bottom edges of the block. Press. The block should measure 11-1/2" \times 13".



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to create nine blocks, in the following quantities:



two with Fabric D borders



four with Fabric C borders



three with Fabric B borders (including one with a Fabric F block center)


Assemble the Sashing

Step 3: Sew a 2-1/2" \times 5-1/2" Fabric B rectangle between two 5" \times 5-1/2" Fabric E rectangles, as shown. Press. Repeat to make six wide sashing units like this.



Step 4: Sew a 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" Fabric B rectangle between two 5" x 3-1/2" Fabric E rectangles, as shown. Press. Repeat to make six narrow sashing units like this.





Step 5: Arrange the Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using the narrow sashing units between each block and the wide sashing units at the end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing units. Repeat to make three block rows.

- **Step 6:** Gather the block rows and the four Fabric E row sashing strips. Sew together, placing a sashing strip between each row. Press seams toward the sashing.
- **Step 7:** Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.
- Step 8: Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

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
