



Quilt designed Heidi Pridemore Throw Quilt- approximate size 53" square Intermediate Level All border strip length measurements are approximate. Please measure your quilt top before cutting the length of each border.

Fabrics Needed:

Background: 1 yards of AJS 6009-5
Outer Border: 1 yard of EA 2850-21

Fabric A: 1/4 yard of AJS 6005-136
Fabric B: 1/3 yard of AJS 6007-141
Fabric C: 1/3 yard of AJS-6009-148
Fabric D: 1/4 yard of AJS-6005-107

Cut:

sixty-four 3-7/8" squares Cut six 3" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece them together into two 3" x 48-1/2" strips and two 3" x 53-1/2" strips. Assembly Instructions:

This Quilt is made up of half-square triangles. Follow the directions below on how to make half-square triangles. Refer to the Pairs list to make the listed number of blocks.

- 1) Place one 3-7/8" square (Listed first) on top of one 3-7/8" square (listed second), right sides together. Draw a diagonal line through the center of the top block (Fig. 1).
- 2) Sew 1/4" away from the drawn diagonal line on each side (Fig. 2).
- 3) Cut the squares across the drawn diagonal line to make two half-square triangles (Fig. 3).
- 4) Open each half-square triangle formed and press.
- 5) Follow the Pairs list to make the correct number of half-square triangles.

NOTE: Remember one square of each make two half-square triangles.

- 6) Layout the half-square triangles following the quilt photo
- 7) Sew the half-square triangles into rows. This will make matching the points much easier. Sew the rows together to make the quilt top.
- 8) Sew one 3" x 48-1/2" Border strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 3" x 53-1/2" Border strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 9) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
