CUTTING:
Block Centers: Cut all Centers $71 / 2$ " square (number of squares for each fabric listed above). From Birthday Party and large Cakes prints (first four Center fabrics listed above), fussy-cut 71/2" squares on point (bias-cut diamonds). Beginner quilters may want to stabilize these bias squares with lightweight stabilizer before adding Corners. For the remaining Center fabrics, cut $71 / 2$ " crosswise strips, then cut into $71 / 2$ " squares.
Block Corners: Cut all Corners 7" square from 7" crosswise strips (number of squares listed above. Then cut each square diagonally in half to make two triangles.


Block 4C Frame: Cut two strips $11 / 2$ x $51 / 2 "$ and two strips $11 / 2$ x $71 / 2 "$.

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Use the chart above and/or the quilt photo to sort Corners with their respective Centers.
All Blocks except 4C: One Block at a time, sew two opposite Corners to a Center, and press Corners away from Center. Then sew the other two Corners to the Center, and press away from Center.
Block 4C: Trim 1" from all four edges of Center 4C to make a $51 / 2 "$ square. Sew $51 / 2$ " strips to two opposite sides of Center and press away from Center. Sew $71 / 2$ strips to remaining sides and press. You should now have a $71 / 2 "$ square. Then add Corners as with other Blocks.
Square Up: Using a square ruler, trim all Blocks to measure 11 " square.

## QUILT TOP:

Use the chart above and/or the quilt photo to lay out Blocks as shown, placing similar Blocks away
 from each other. Sew Blocks A-E together to make seven rows, then sew rows together to complete quilt top. You may choose to layer, quilt as desired, and bind your quilt top without a border.

OPTIONAL 3" BORDER: (as shown in photo)
Cut (or cut and piece) two lengthwise strips $61 / 2 \times 81$ " for side borders, and two lengthwise strips $61 / 2 \times 60 "$ for top and bottom borders. Press under $1 / 4 "$ on one long edge of all borders. Center and sew
 unfolded edges of all four borders to quilt top, ending stitching $1 / 4$ from each corner. Miter border corners 3 " out from quilt top. Cut batting and backing $581 / 2 \times 791 / 2$. Center batting and backing under quilt top and baste layers together. Fold borders to back of quilt and miter corners. Sew borders to backing. Quilt as desired.
