

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A-C, cut:

one 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: six 6-1/2" squares

From each of Fabrics D-G, cut:

one 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: three 6-1/2" squares

From each of Fabrics H and K, cut:

three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixteen 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles two 4" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixteen 4" squares for the HSTs

From each of Fabrics I and J, cut:

three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: fourteen 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles two 4" x WOF strips. Subcut: fourteen 4" squares for the HSTs

From Fabric L, cut:

six 4" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixty 4" squares for the HSTs

ten 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixty 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:: two 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" top/bottom outer borders two 2-1/2" x 72-1/2" side outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 4" Fabric L square with a 4" Fabric H square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3-1/2" square. Repeat to make sixteen L/H HSTs.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:



fourteen L/I HSTs



fourteen L/J HSTs



Assemble the Blocks

Step 3: Gather: one Fabric D square two Fabric H rectangles two Fabric L rectangles four L/H HSTs


Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 4: Sew the units together to form the block. Press the seams toward the rectangles.


Step 5: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The resulting block should measure 12-1/2" square.

Step 6: Repeat Steps 3-5 to make the remaining twenty-nine blocks, using the Quilt Assembly Diagram for specific fabric pairings, or pair the A-G and H-K fabrics to your liking.



Assemble the Quilt



Step 7: Arrange the blocks into six rows of five blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 8: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 9: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 10: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
