

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From Fabric A, fussy cut:**

one 23" x 42" center panel

### **From Fabric B, cut:**

four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 4-1/2" x 16" rectangles for the top/bottom pieced Border 5 units

two 4-1/2" x 29" rectangles for the side pieced Border 5 units

eighteen 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for the pieced Border 5 units

four 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

seventy-two 2" squares for the HSTs

sixteen 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 45" side Border 2 strips

two 1-1/2" x 28" top/bottom Border 2 strips

two 1-1/2" x 53" side Border 4 strips

two 1-1/2" x 36" top/bottom Border 4 strips

two 1-1/2" x 63" side Border 6 strips

two 1-1/2" x 46" top/bottom Border 6 strips

seventy-two 1-1/2" squares

### **From Fabric C, cut:**

four 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 2" x 42" side Border 1 strips

two 2" x 26" top/bottom Border 1 strips

### **From Fabric D, cut:**

\*\*\*four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 3-1/2" x 47" side Border 3 strips

two 3-1/2" x 34" top/bottom Border 3 strips

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 2-1/2" squares

Trim to 2" wide, then subcut:

eight 2" squares for the HSTs

\*\*\*For the Multi Colorstory, cut these strips from Fabric M

**From each of Fabrics E-L, cut:**

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 2-1/2" squares

Trim to 2" wide, then subcut:

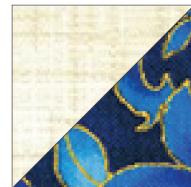
eight 2" squares for the HSTs

**From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

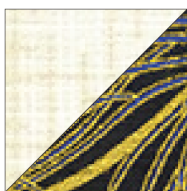
six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a 2" Fabric B square with a 2" Fabric D square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 1-1/2" square. Repeat to make sixteen B/D HSTs.



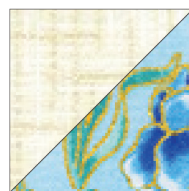
**Step 2:** Repeat Step 1 to make:



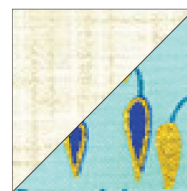

**Step 3:** Sew each HST to a matching HST to form pairs. Press. Make eight pairs from each fabric.



## Assemble the Star Blocks



**Step 4:** Gather:  
four Fabric D HST pairs  
one Fabric D square  
four Fabric B squares

Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

**Step 5:** Sew the units together to form the rows. Press the seams away from the HST pairs.

**Step 6:** Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The resulting Star Block should measure 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make two blocks from each of Fabrics D-L.



## Assemble the Star Border (Border 5)

**Step 7:** Gather Star Blocks in the following order and sew together to form the side pieced Border 5: Fabric L + Fabric K + Fabric I + Fabric J. Note the placement of the Fabric B rectangles. Press. Sew the 29" Fabric B rectangle to the Fabric L Block end. Press. Repeat to make a second side Border 5 unit like this.



**Step 8:** Gather Star Blocks in the following order and sew together to form the top pieced Border 5: Fabric F + Fabric G + Fabric H + Fabric D + Fabric E. Note the placement of the Fabric B rectangles. Press. Sew the 16" Fabric B rectangle to the Fabric E Block end. Press. Repeat to make a second Border 5 unit like this for the bottom border.



## Assemble the Quilt

**Step 9:** Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 10:** Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 11:** Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 12:** Sew the side Border 4 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 13:** Sew the side Border 5 units to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 5 units to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 14:** Sew the side Border 6 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 6 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

















