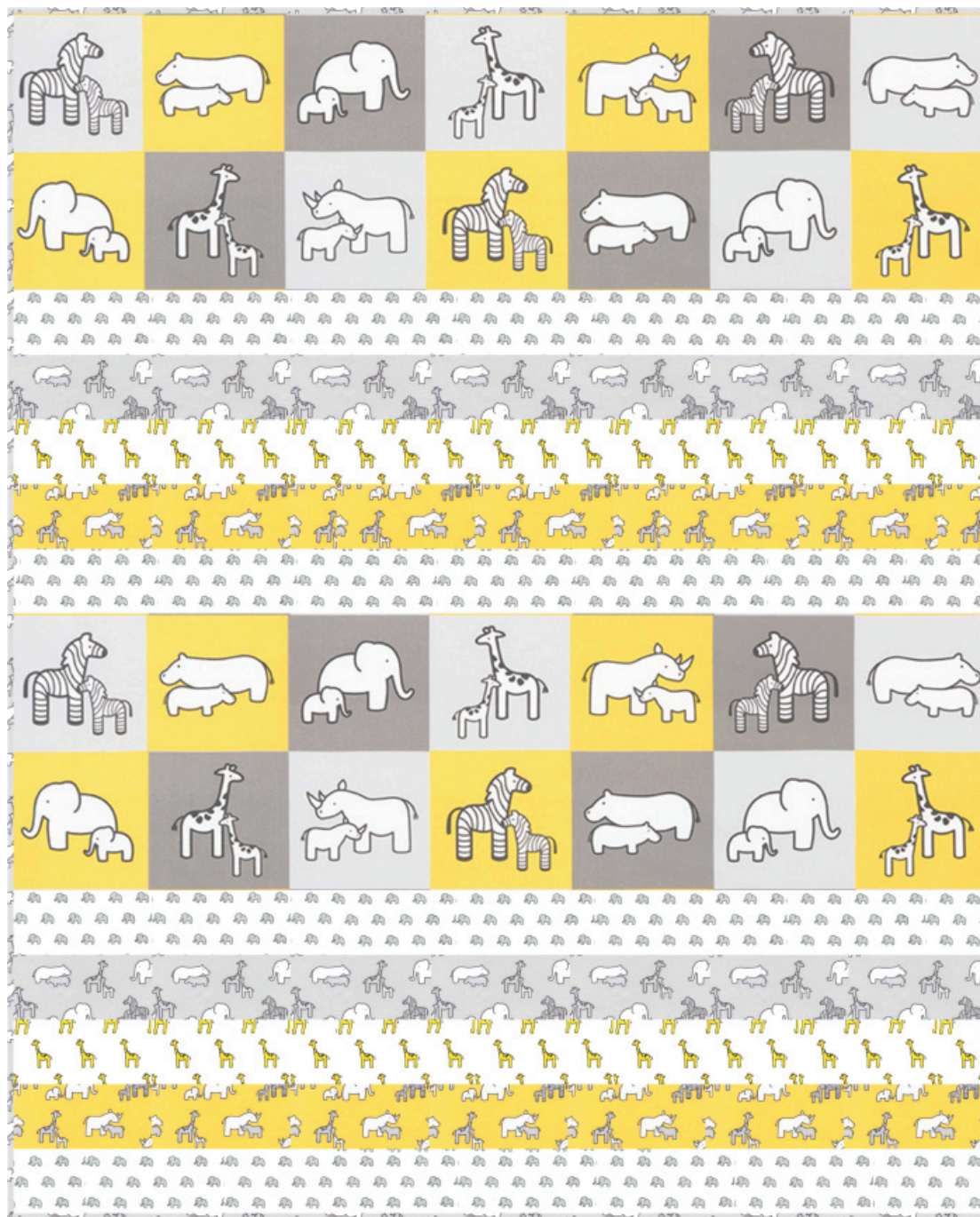



Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 43" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 43" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

two 12-1/2" x 42-1/2" panels

From Fabric B cut:

four 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Trim to 42-1/2" long.

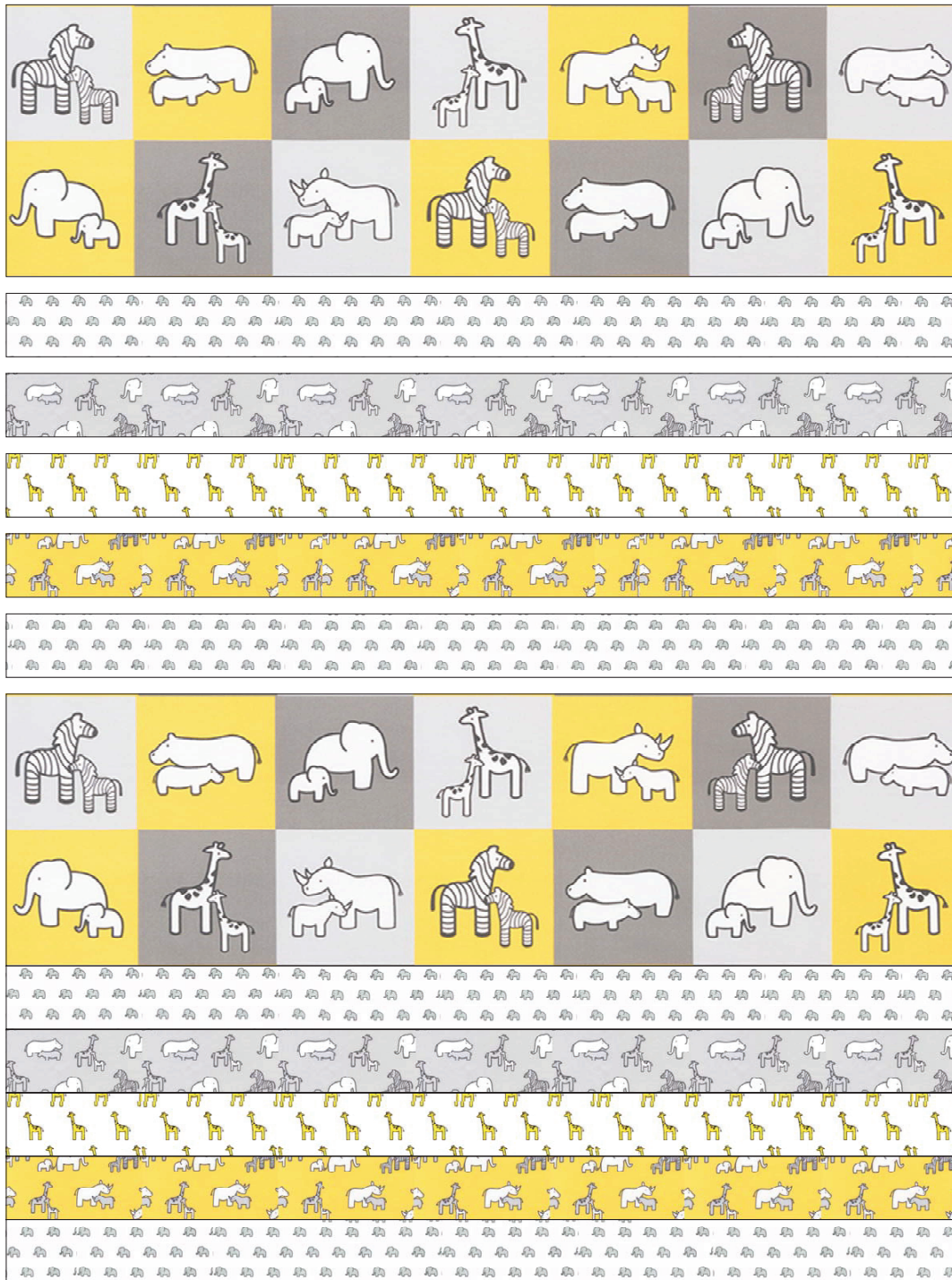
From each of Fabrics C-E, cut:

two 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Trim to 42-1/2" long.

From Fabric C, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding

Assemble the Quilt



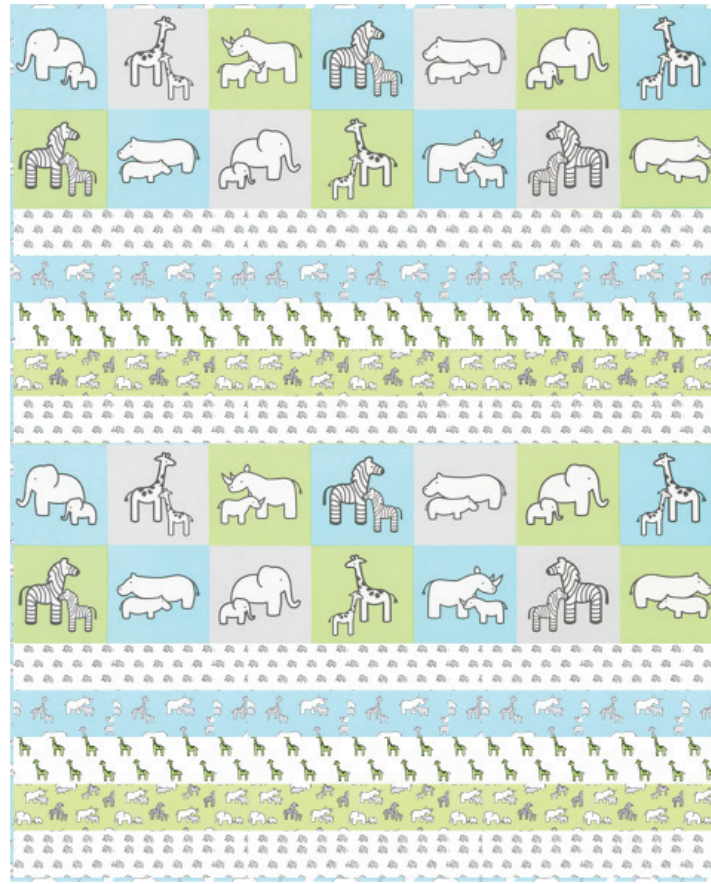
Step 1: Sew strips together along the longest edge, in the following order: Fabric B - Fabric C - Fabric D - Fabric E - Fabric B. Check the fabric orientation before sewing. Press the seams to one side. Repeat to form a second striped row.

Step 2: Sew one striped row to the bottom of each Fabric A panel section to form one quilt half. Press the seam toward the panel. Repeat to form the second half of the quilt.

Step 3: Sew the two quilt halves together, pressing the seam toward the panel.






Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

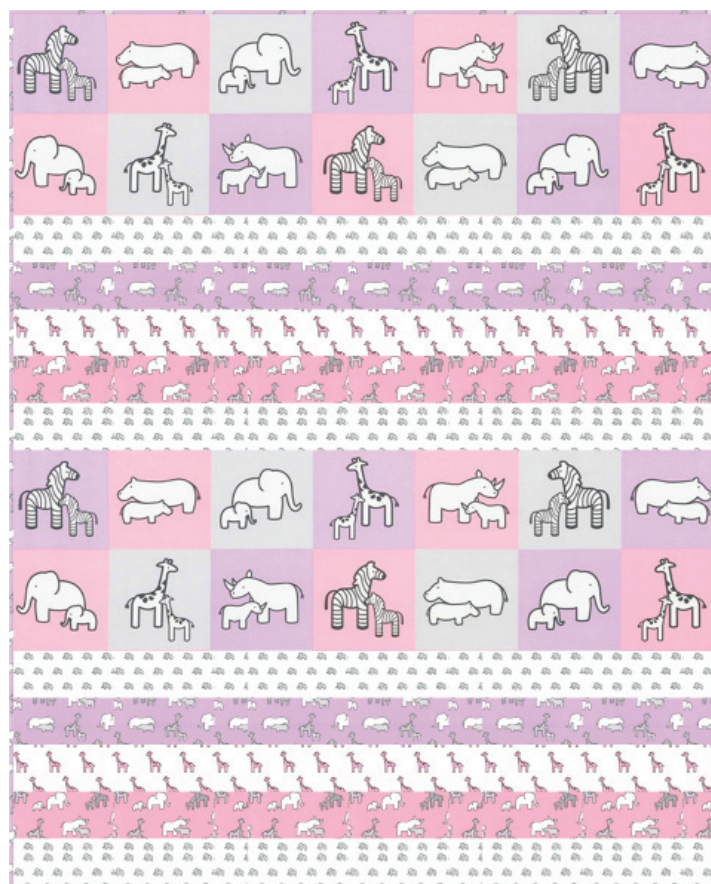
