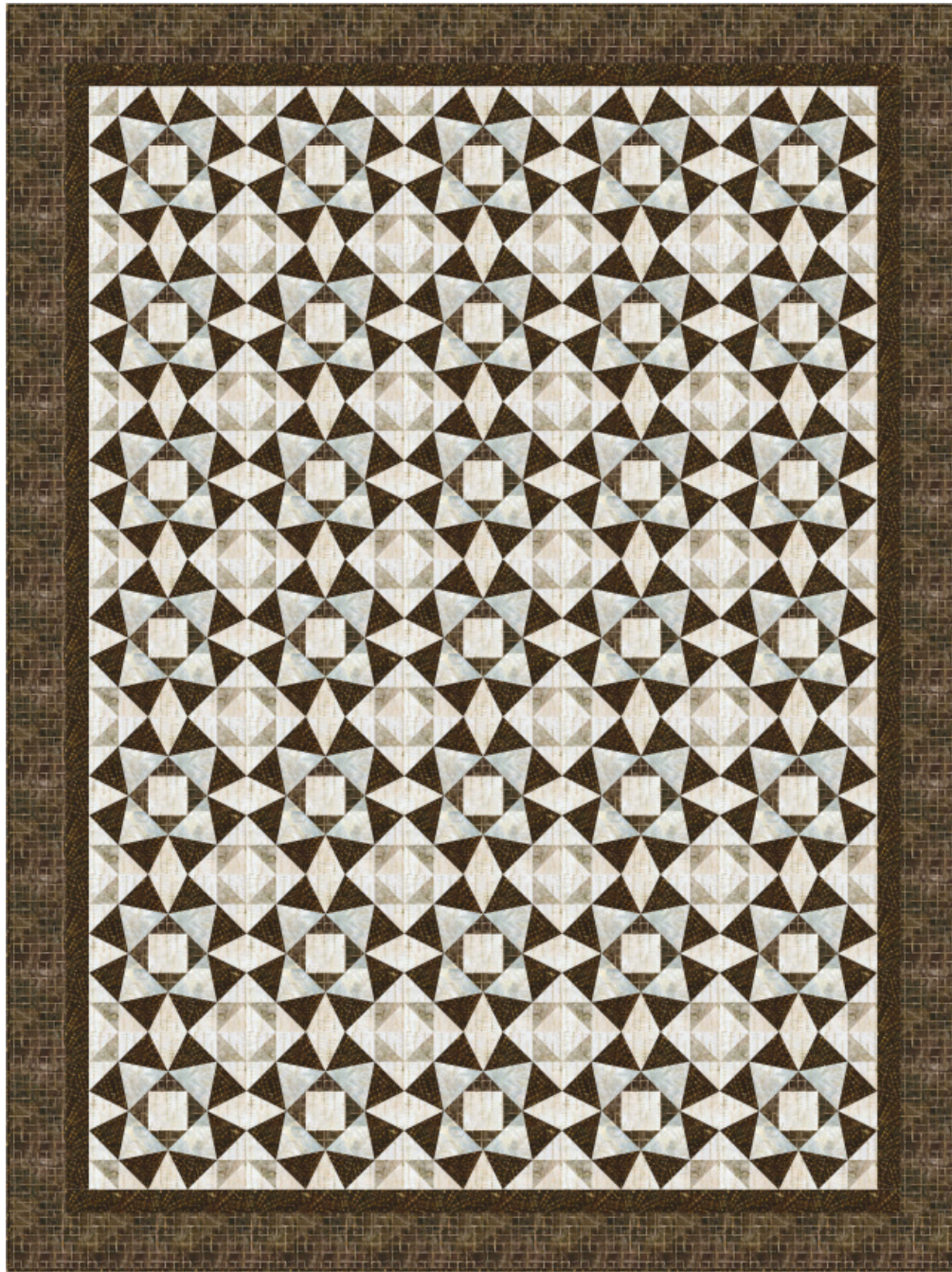



Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

Note: For the Fog Colorstory, see alternate cutting directions on pages 9-11.

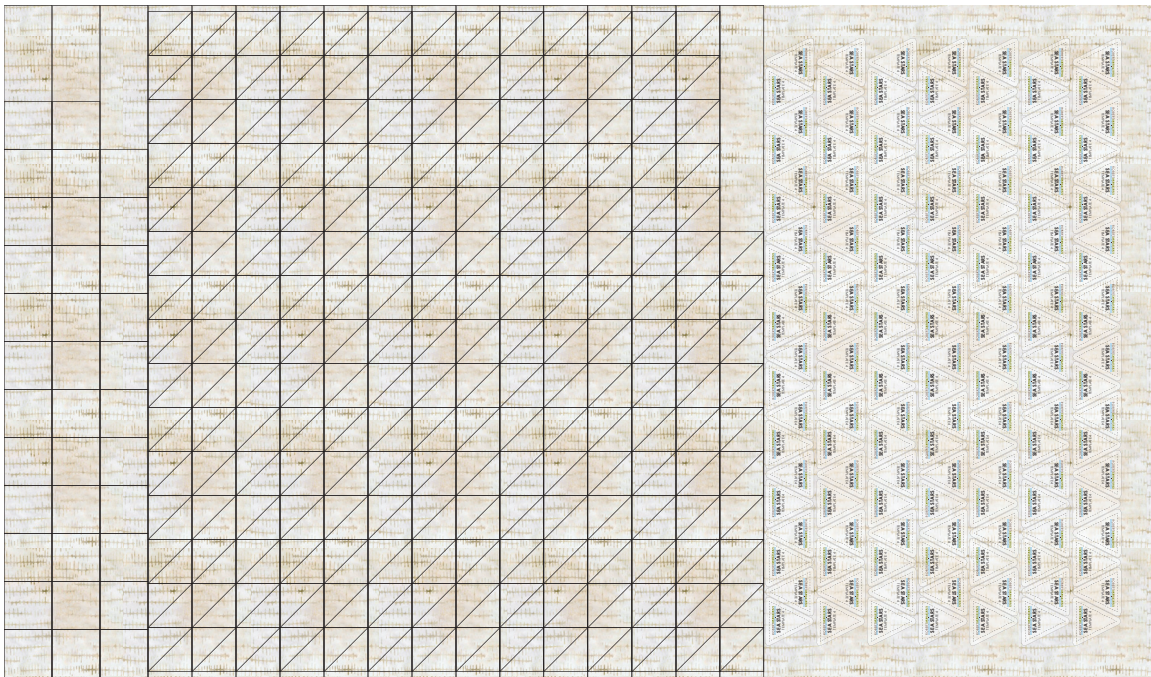
From Fabric A, cut:

three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-five 3" squares. *Note: for the Fog Colorstory, cut these from Fabric F*

fourteen 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two-hundred ten 2-3/4" squares. Cut each square in half once along a diagonal.
one hundred forty of Template 4



From Fabric B, cut:

one hundred forty of Template 1

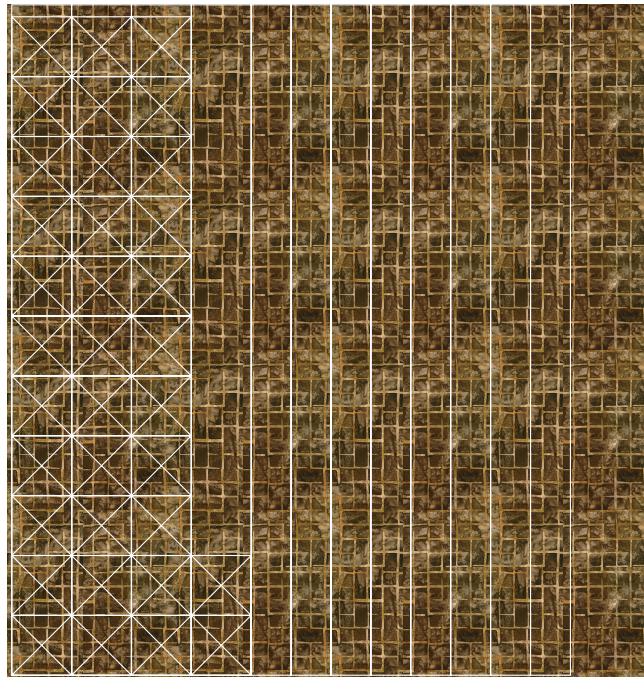


From Fabric C, cut:

four 3-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-five 3-3/4" squares. Cut each square in half along both diagonals, creating four triangles each.

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding



From Fabric D, cut:

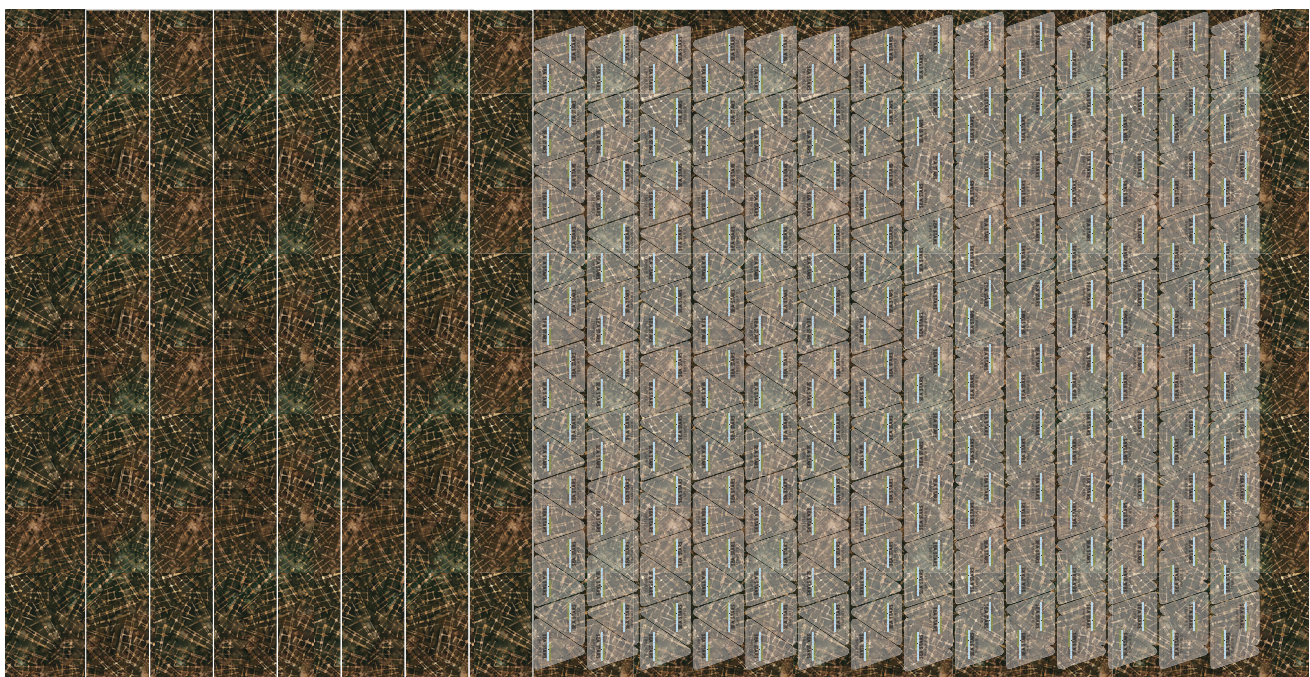
seven 4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 4" x 73-1/2" side outer borders

two 4" x 60-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

one hundred forty of Template 2

one hundred forty of Template 3



From Fabric E, cut:

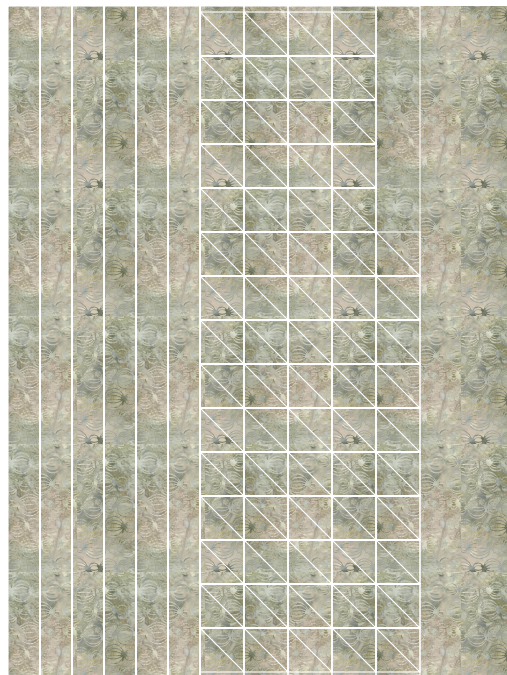
six 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 2" x 70-1/2" side inner borders

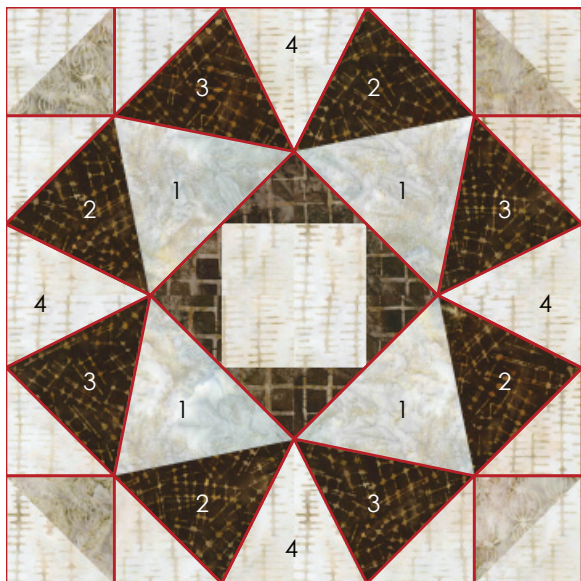
two 2" x 53-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

five 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

seventy 2-3/4" squares. Cut each square in half once along a diagonal.



Assemble the Blocks

**Step 1:** Gather:

one 3" Fabric A center square (Fabric F for Fog colorstory)

four Fabric C triangles

four Fabric B/Template 1 pieces

four Fabric D/Template 2 pieces

four Fabric D/Template 3 pieces

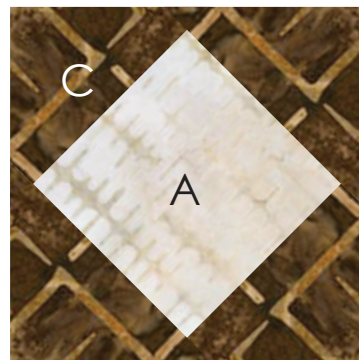
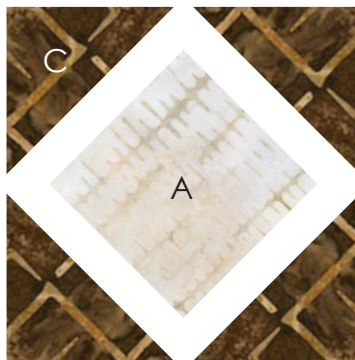
four Fabric A/Template 4 pieces

four Fabric E triangles

twelve Fabric A triangles

Arrange the pieces following the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 2: Sew a Fabric C triangle to opposite sides of a 3" Fabric A square. Press seam allowances toward the triangles. Repeat on remaining sides of the Fabric A square.



Step 3: Sew a Fabric D/Template 3 and Fabric D/Template 2 triangle to two sides of a Fabric B triangle. Press toward Fabric D. Repeat for all Fabric B and D triangles to create four units like this.



Step 4: Sew a Fabric A/Template 4 triangle to the right edge of each completed Step 3 unit. Press toward Fabric A. Repeat to create four units like this.



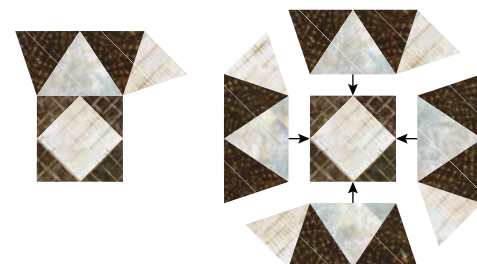
Step 5: Place a Fabric A and E triangle right sides together. Sew along the long edge, creating a half square triangle (HST). Press the seam toward Fabric A. Repeat to create a four units like this.



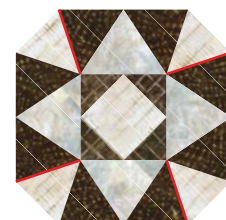
Step 6: Sew a Fabric A triangle to the remaining edges of the Fabric E triangle in a completed Step 5 unit. Press each seam toward the Fabric E triangle. Repeat to create a four units like this.



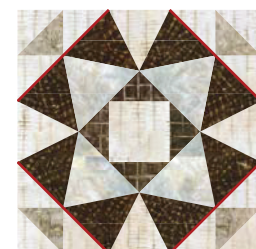
Step 7: Sew the Fabric B/Template 1 section of each unit to one side of the center square-in-a-square. Start and stop each seam on the marked dots. Press two opposite seams toward the square and the remaining two opposite seams away from the square.



Step 8: Align the two edges of one unsewn angled seam (that begins at one corner of the center square and extends to the edge of the block). Sew from the marked dot all the way to the edge of the block. Press.

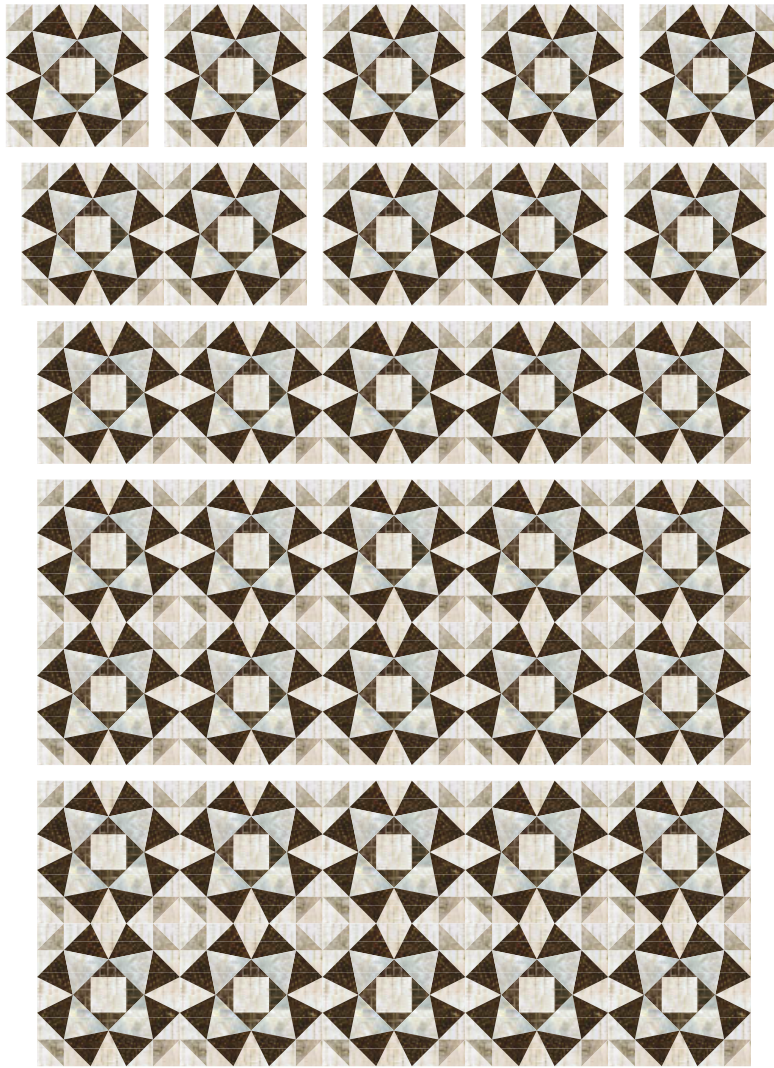


Step 9: Sew a completed Step 6 unit to the corners of the block. Press toward the corners of the block.



The resulting block will measure 10-1/2" square. Repeat to make thirty-five blocks.

Assemble the Quilt



Step 10: Arrange the blocks into seven rows of five blocks.

Step 11: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 12: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Add the Borders

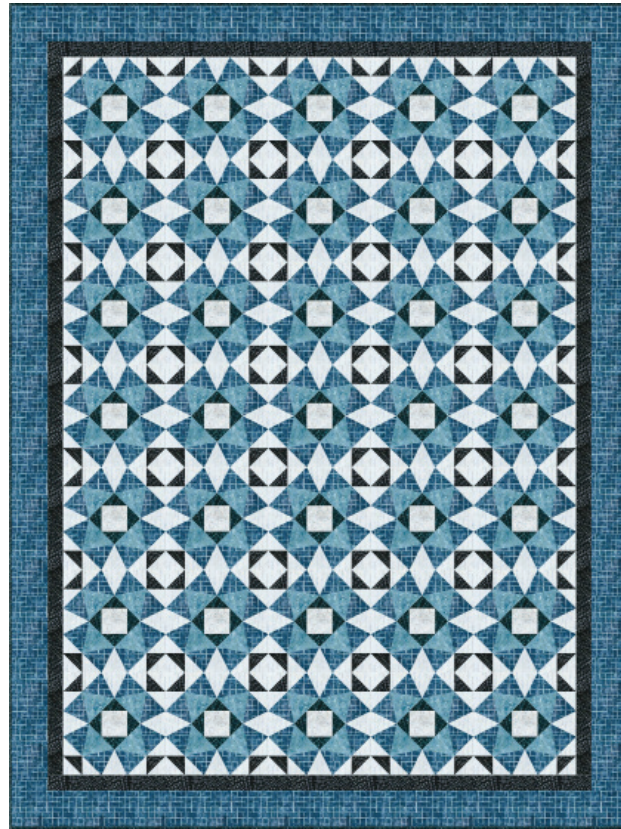
Step 13: Sew the 2" x 70-1/2" side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the 2" x 53-1/2" top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 14: Sew the 4" x 73-1/2" side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the 4" x 60-1/2" top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!






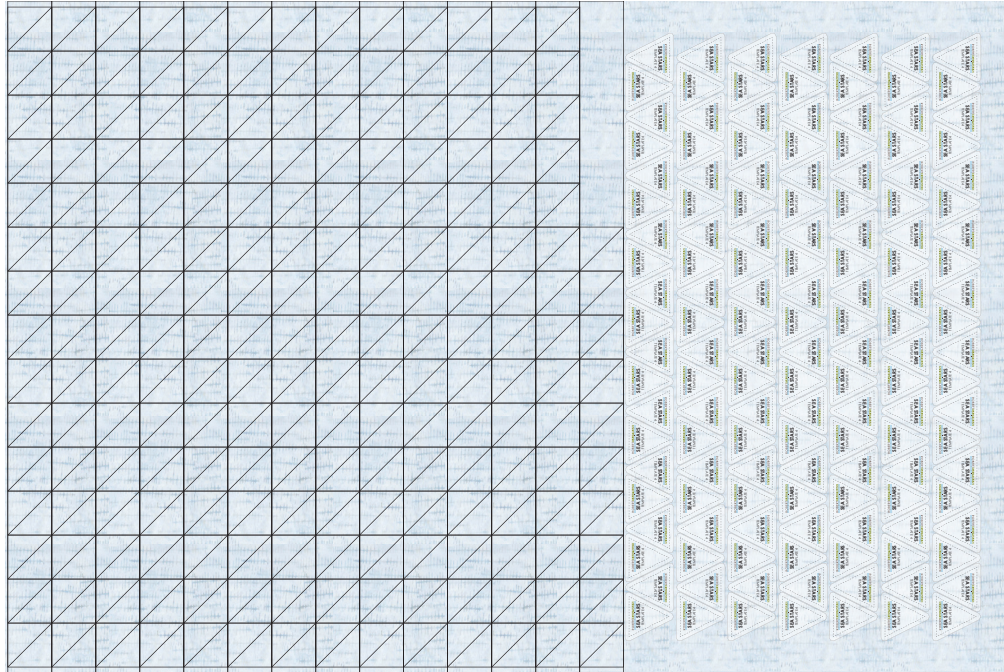

Alternate Cutting Instructions for Fog Colorstory

From Fabric A, cut:

fourteen 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two hundred ten 2-3/4" squares. Cut each square in half once along a diagonal.
one hundred forty of Template 4



From Fabric B, cut:

one hundred forty of Template 1



From Fabric C, cut:

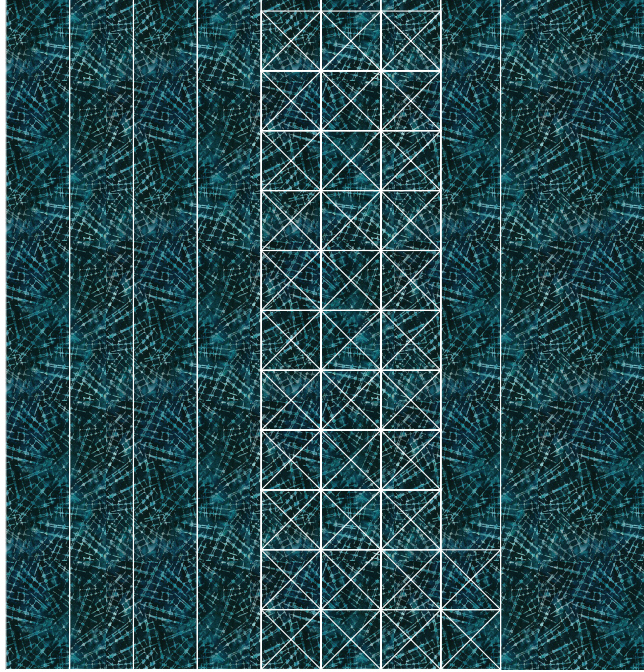
seven 4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 4" x 73-1/2" side outer borders

two 4" x 60-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

four 3-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-five 3-3/4" squares. Cut each square in half along both diagonals, creating four triangles each.



From Fabric D, cut:

six 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

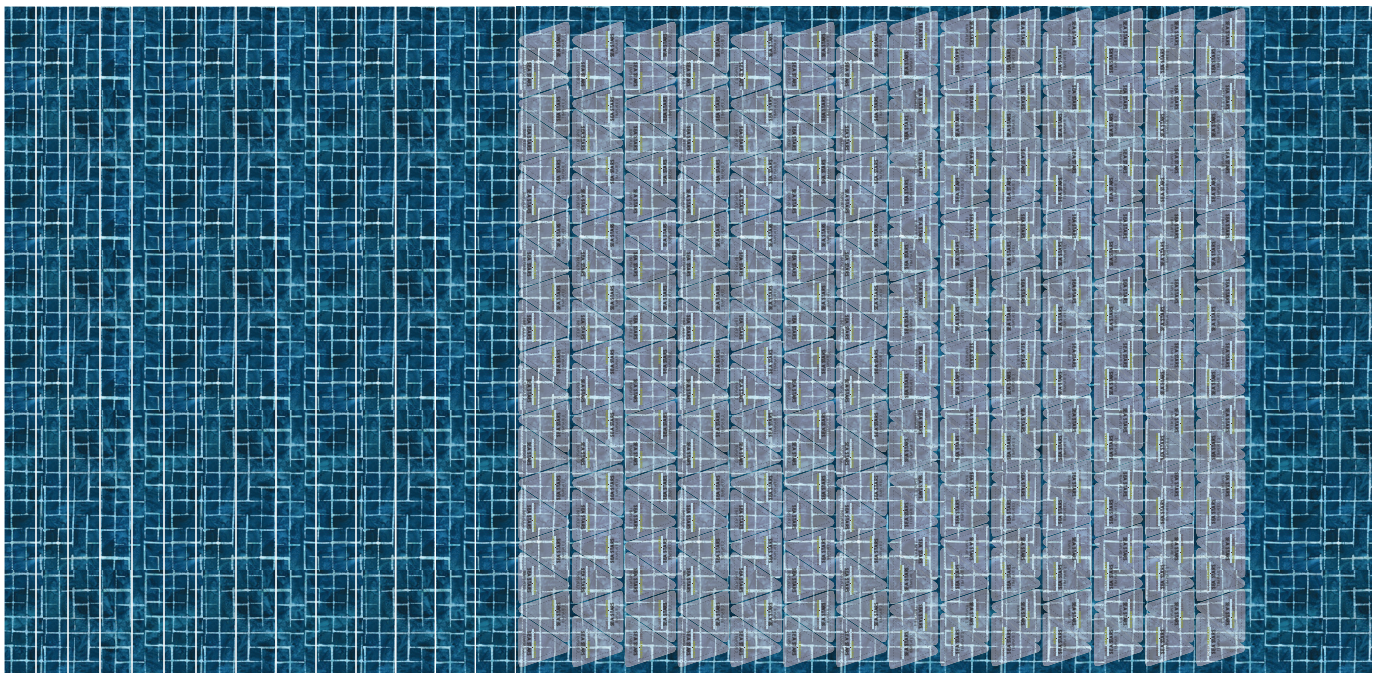
two 2" x 70-1/2" side inner borders

two 2" x 53-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding

one hundred forty of Template 2

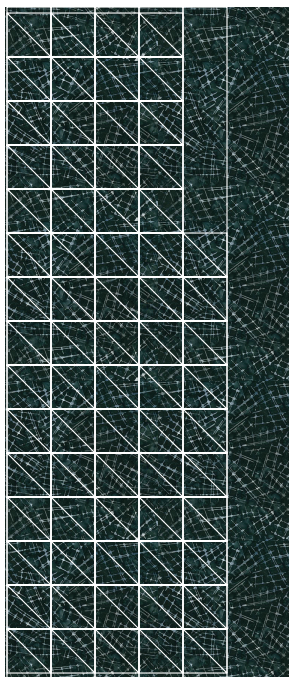

From Fabric E, cut:

five 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

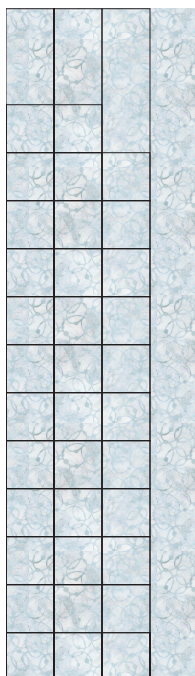
seventy 2-3/4" squares. Cut each square in half once along a diagonal.



From Fabric F, cut:

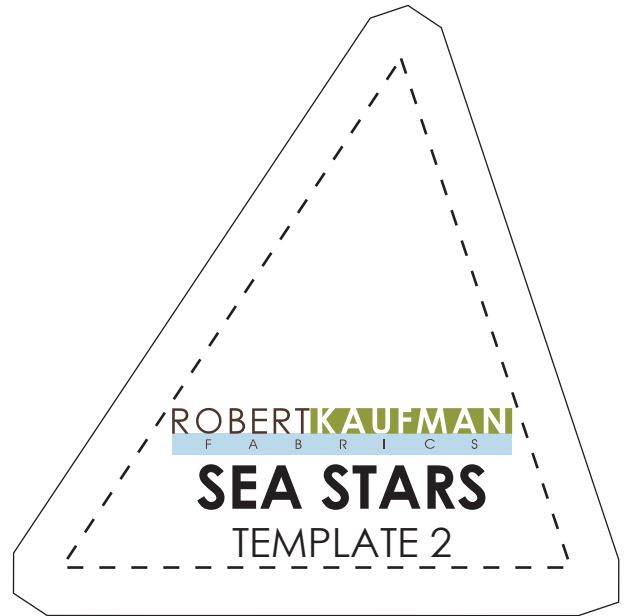
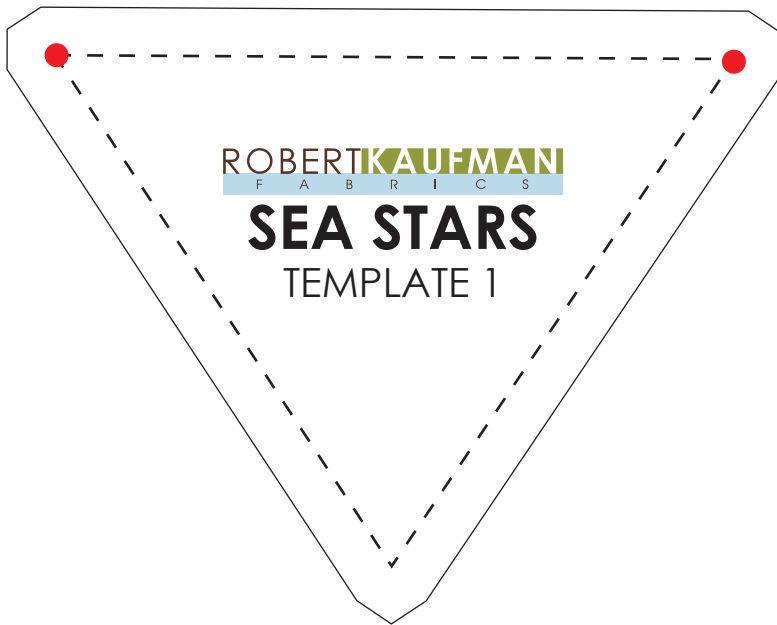
three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
