

## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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### Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### From Fabric A, cut:

two 7-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
four 7-1/2" x 20-1/2" rectangles

### From each of Fabrics B-E, fussy cut:

two 5-1/2" x 20-1/2" top/bottom placemat borders, centering the print along the length

### From the Backing, cut:

two 22" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
four 19" x 22" rectangles

### From each of the Binding fabrics, cut:

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

## Assemble the Placemats



**Step 1:** Sew a Fabric B rectangle to the top and bottom of a Fabric A rectangle. Press. Repeat with the Fabric C-E rectangles and remaining A rectangles. Press.

**Step 2:** Layer the backing, batting (or fusible fleece) and placemat front on a work surface, with the wrong sides of the fabric facing the batting. Center all three layers. Baste in place and quilt as desired.

**Step 3:** Trim to 17" x 20". Make four placemats this way. Sew the binding strips together, then bind the placemat.
