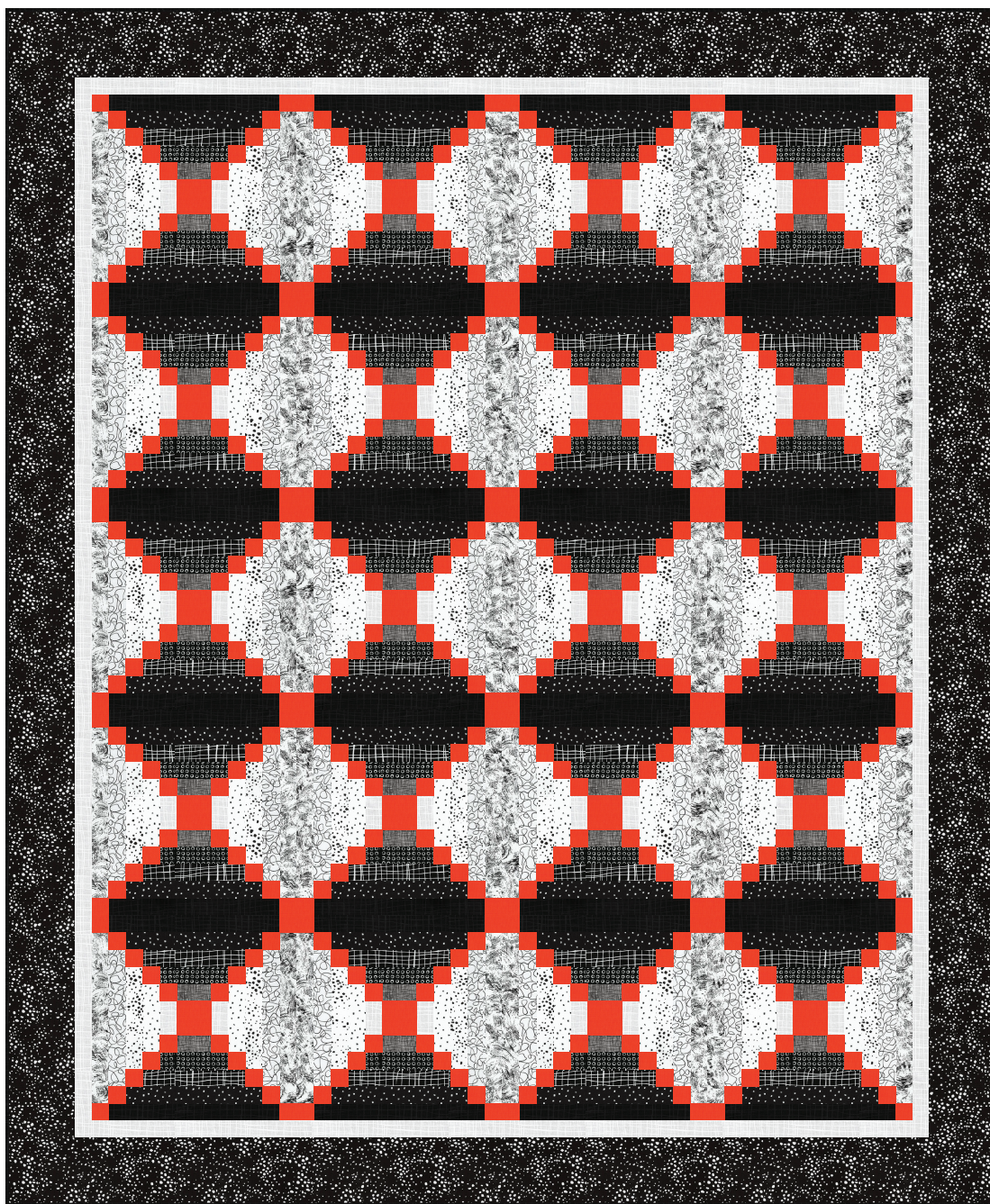

Finished quilt measures: 58" x 70"













## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From Fabric A, cut:**

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
twenty 2-1/2" squares for Block Piece 1  
fifteen 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
four hundred 1-1/2" squares

### **From Fabric B, cut:**

three 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
forty 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles for Block Piece 2  
six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:  
two 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" side inner borders  
two 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

### **From Fabric C, cut:**

three 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
forty 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles for Block Piece 3

### **From Fabric D, cut:**

five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
forty 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for Block Piece 4

### **From Fabric E, cut:**

five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
forty 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for Block Piece 5

### **From Fabric F, cut:**

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
forty 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for Block Piece 6

### **From Fabric G, cut:**

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
forty 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for Block Piece 7

### **From Fabric H, cut:**

ten 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
forty 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles for Block Piece 8

**From Fabric I, cut:**

ten 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

forty 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles for Block Piece 9

**From Fabric J, cut:**

ten 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

forty 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles for Block Piece 10

**From Fabric K, cut:**

ten 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

forty 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles for Block Piece 11

**From Fabric L, cut:**

six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 4-1/2" x 62-1/2" side outer borders

two 4-1/2" x 58-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

**From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Block

**Step 1:** Sew a 1-1/2" Fabric A square to the ends of each of:

Piece 3



Piece 5



Piece 7



Piece 9

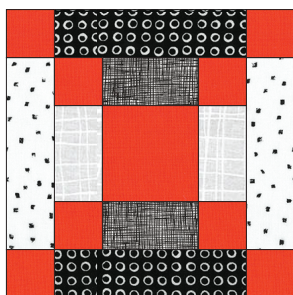
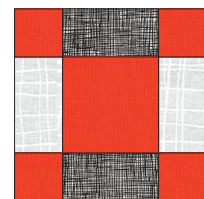


Piece 11



Press toward the squares.

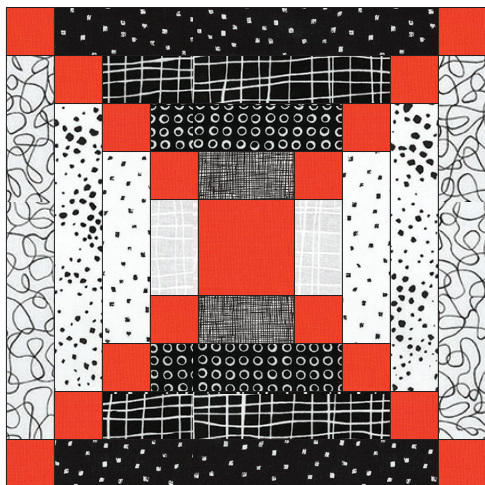
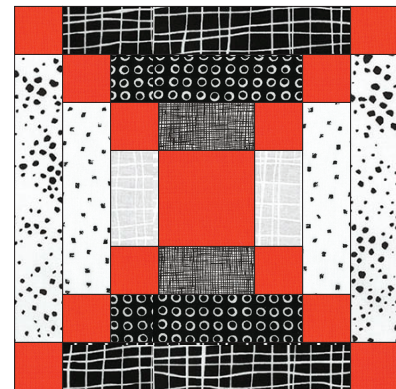
**Step 2:** Sew a Fabric B/Piece 2 rectangle to the left and right edges of a Fabric A/Piece 1 center square. Press toward the center. Sew a Piece 3 unit to the top and bottom. Press toward the center.



**Step 3:** Sew a Fabric D/Piece 4 rectangle to the left and right edges of the block. Press toward the center. Sew a Piece 5 unit to the top and bottom. Press toward the center.



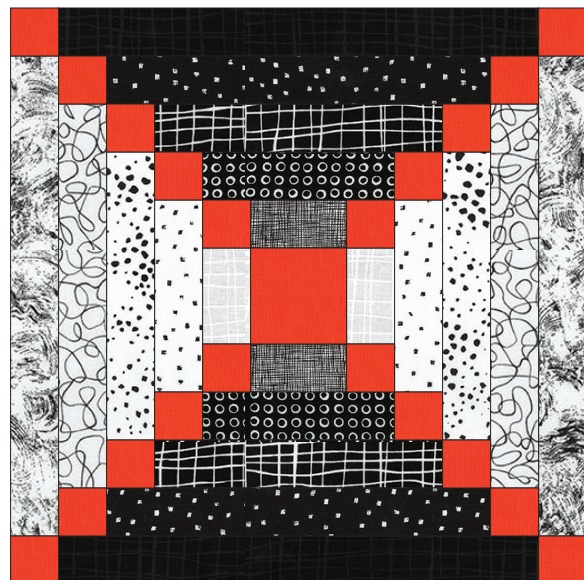
**Step 4:** Sew a Fabric F/Piece 6 rectangle to the left and right edges of the block. Press toward the center. Sew a Piece 7 unit to the top and bottom. Press toward the center.



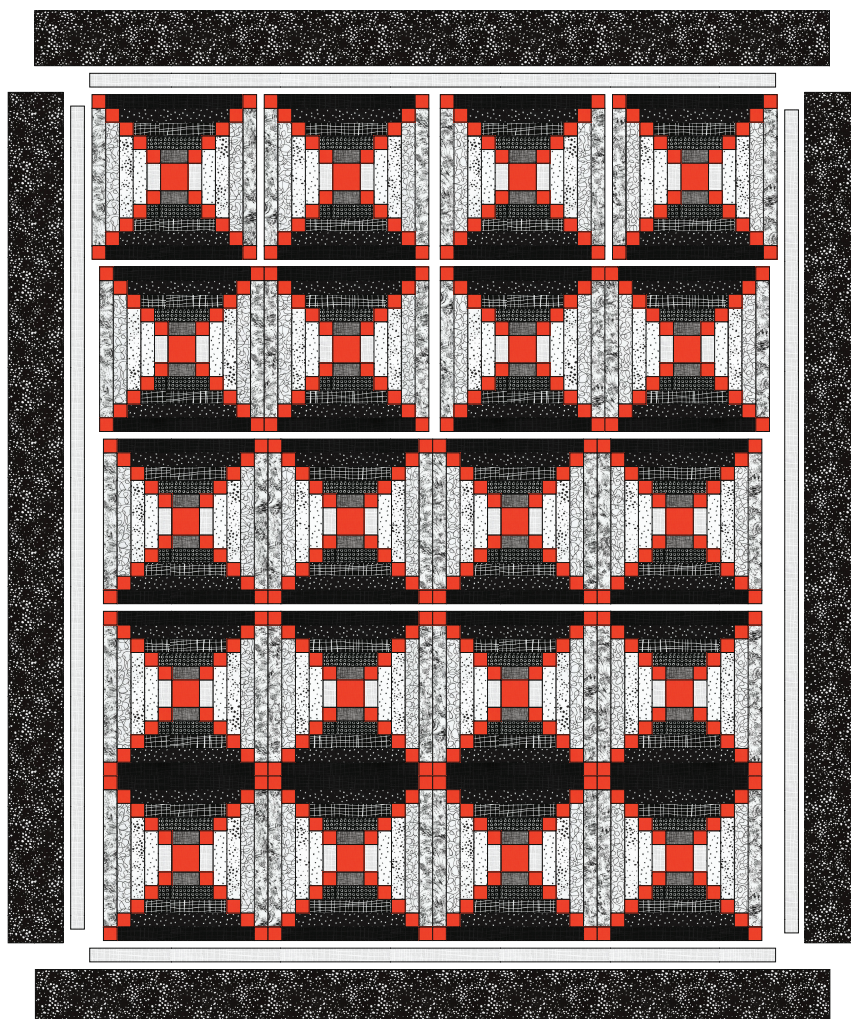
**Step 5:** Sew a Fabric H/Piece 8 rectangle to the left and right edges of the block. Press toward the center. Sew a Piece 9 unit to the top and bottom. Press toward the center.

**Step 6:** Sew a Fabric J/Piece 10 rectangle to the left and right edges of the block. Press toward the center. Sew a Piece 11 unit to the top and bottom. Press toward the center.

The resulting block should measure 12-1/2" square. Repeat Steps 1-6 to make twenty blocks.



## Assemble the Quilt



**Step 7:** Arrange the blocks into five rows of four blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

**Step 8:** Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

**Step 9:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

**Step 10:** Sew the Fabric B side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric B top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 11:** Sew the Fabric L side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric L top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
