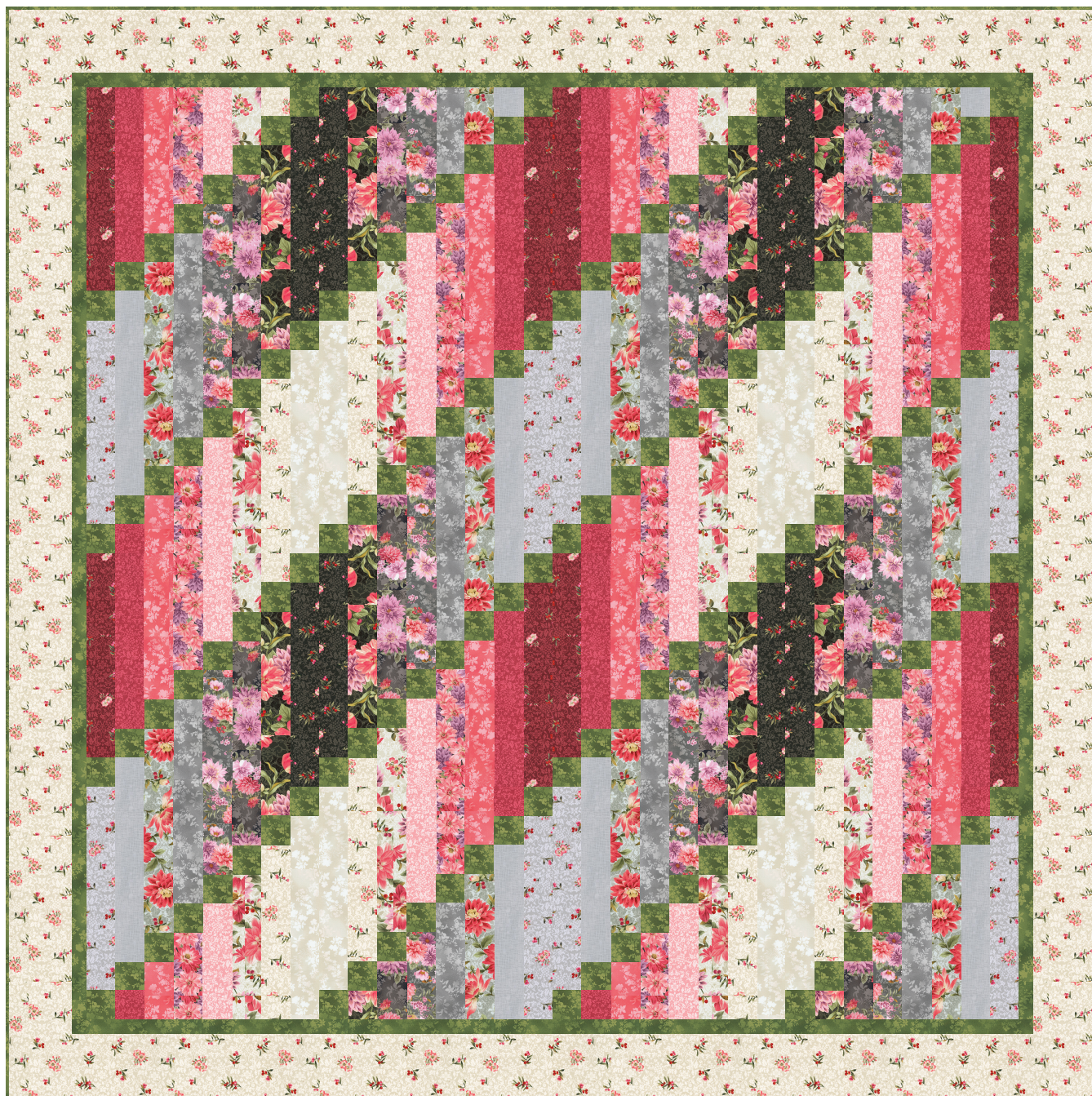

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

seven 5" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 5" x 66-1/2" side outer borders
two 5" x 75-1/2" top/bottom outer borders
four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles
eight 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
one hundred twenty-eight 2-1/2" squares
seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 1-1/2" x 64-1/2" side inner borders
two 1-1/2" x 66-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

From each of Fabrics C, I, P and Q, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" rectangles

From each of Fabrics D and O, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles
eight 2-1/2" squares

From each of Fabrics E, H, K and N, cut:

three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles
eight 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

From each of Fabrics F, G, L and M, cut:

three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles
eight 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric J, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles
eight 2-1/2" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the A Blocks

Step 1: Gather:

one 14-1/2" Fabric C strip
one 14-1/2" Fabric I strip
one 12-1/2" Fabric D strip
one 10-1/2" Fabric E strip
one 8-1/2" Fabric F strip
one 6-1/2" Fabric G strip
one 4-1/2" Fabric H strip
one 2-1/2" Fabric A square
one 12-1/2" Fabric J strip
one 10-1/2" Fabric K strip
one 8-1/2" Fabric L strip
one 6-1/2" Fabric M strip
one 4-1/2" Fabric N strip
one 2-1/2" Fabric O square
eight 2-1/2" Fabric B squares



Arrange the units into eight columns. Note the fabric placement and order in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 2: Sew the pieces together to form the columns. Press the seams toward the Fabric B squares.

Step 3: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The resulting A Block should measure 16-1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of eight A Blocks.

Assemble the B Blocks

Step 4: Gather:

- one 14-1/2" Fabric P strip
- one 14-1/2" Fabric Q strip
- one 12-1/2" Fabric O strip
- one 10-1/2" Fabric N strip
- one 8-1/2" Fabric M strip
- one 6-1/2" Fabric L strip
- one 4-1/2" Fabric K strip
- one 2-1/2" Fabric J square
- one 12-1/2" Fabric A strip
- one 10-1/2" Fabric H strip
- one 8-1/2" Fabric G strip
- one 6-1/2" Fabric F strip
- one 4-1/2" Fabric E strip
- one 2-1/2" Fabric D square
- eight 2-1/2" Fabric B squares



Arrange the units into eight columns. Note the fabric placement and order in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 5: Sew the pieces together to form the columns. Press the seams toward the Fabric B squares.

Step 6: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The resulting B Block should measure 16-1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of eight B Blocks

Assemble the Quilt



Step 7: Arrange the blocks into four rows of four blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 8: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 9: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 10: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 11: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
