Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42 " wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

From each square in the Ten Square Pack, cut:
two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 4-1/2" squares from each strip.
Note: A total of one-hundred and fifty-nine 4-1/2" squares are needed.

## From Fabric A, cut:

fourteen 2-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips. one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip. one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 13^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip.
two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips.
two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips.
two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips.
two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips. two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips. one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 74-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip.

Note: Sew WOF strips together, end-to-end, as needed in order to make these lengths.

## Assemble the Rows

Step 1: Sew two squares together. Press the seam open or to one side.
Step 2: Sew a 13" Fabric A strip to the bottom of the row, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing. This is Row 1.


Step 3: Sew six squares together. Press the seams open or to one side.
Step 4: Sew a 24-1/2" Fabric A strip to the bottom of the row, aligning the edges. Press toward the sashing. This is Row 2.


Step 5: Sew eight squares together. Press the seams open or to one side.
Step 6: Sew a 36-1/2" Fabric A strip to the bottom of the row, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing. This is Row 3.


Step 7: Sew twelve squares together. Press the seams open or to one side.
Step 8: Sew a 48-1/2" Fabric A strip to the bottom of the row, aligning the edges. Press toward the sashing. This is Row 4.


Step 9: Sew fourteen squares together. Press the seams open or to one side.
Step 10: Sew a 60-1/2" Fabric A strip to the bottom of the row, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing. This is Row 5.


Step 11: Sew eighteen squares together. Press the seams open or to one side.
Step 12: Sew a 72-1/2" Fabric A strip to the bottom of the row, aligning the edges. Press toward the sashing. This is Row 6.


Step 13: Sew nineteen squares together. Press the seams open or to one side. This is Row 7.


Step 14: Sew twenty squares together. Press the seams open or to one side.
Step 15: Sew a 74-1/2" Fabric A strip to the top of the row, aligned with the right edge. Press toward the sashing. This is Row 8.


Step 16: Sew seventeen squares together. Press the seams open or to one side.
Step 17: Sew a 72-1/2" Fabric A strip to the top of the row, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing. This is Row 9.


Step 18: Sew fifteen squares together. Press the seams open or to one side.
Step 19: Sew a 60-1/2" Fabric A strip to the top of the row, aligning the edges. Press toward the sashing. This is Row 10.


Step 20: Sew eleven squares together. Press the seams open or to one side.
Step 21: Sew a 48-1/2" Fabric A strip to the top of the row, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing. This is Row 11.


Step 22: Sew nine squares together. Press the seams open or to one side.
Step 23: Sew a 36-1/2" Fabric A strip to the top of the row, aligning the edges. Press toward the sashing. This is Row 12.


Step 24: Sew five squares together. Press the seams open or to one side.
Step 25: Sew a 24-1/2" Fabric A strip to the top of the row, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing. This is Row 13.


Step 26: Sew three squares together. Press the seams open or to one side.
Step 27: Sew a 12-1/2" Fabric A strip to the top of the row, aligning the edges. Press toward the sashing. This is Row 14.

## Assemble the Quilt

Step 28: Align the center seams of Rows 1-6 and sew them together.
Press the seams toward the sashing.


Step 29: Align the right edge of Row 7 to the bottom of the unit you created with Rows 1-6. Sew Row 7 to the unit, then press the seam towards the sashing.


Step 30: Align the center seams of Rows 9-14 and sew them together. Press the seams toward the sashing.


Step 31: Align the square portions of Rows 8 and 9 as shown, then sew Row 8 to the top of the unit you created with Rows 9-14. Press the seam toward the sashing.


Step 32: Align the two units you have created with one another as shown, then sew them together. Press the seam toward the sashing.



Step 33: Trim the quilt top to approximately $51^{\prime \prime} \times 65^{\prime \prime}$, cutting off the ends of each row to square up the quilt. Because the outer edges of the quilt are now bias edges, you may wish to sew a line of stay-stitching around the outermost edge of the quilt, 1/8" from the edge. This will prevent the quilt top from stretching during quilting.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

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
