## Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### From Fabric A, cut:

one 30-1/2" x 40-1/2" piece for the quilt center

### From Fabric B, cut:

four 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 1-1/4" x 32" top/bottom inner borders

two 1-1/4" x 40-1/2" side inner borders

**From Fabric C, cut:**

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 2-1/2" x 36" top/bottom middle borders

two 2-1/2" x 42" side middle borders

**From Fabric D, cut:**

two 4-1/2" x length of fabric strips. Trim to make:

two 4-1/2" x 46" side outer borders

From the remaining width of fabric, cut:

three 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to make:

two 5-1/2" x 44" top/bottom outer borders

**From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Quilt



**Step 1:** Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 2:** Sew the side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 3:** Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
