Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Color	Fabric	Name/SKU	Yardage
	A		2 yards (makes 3 scarves)

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

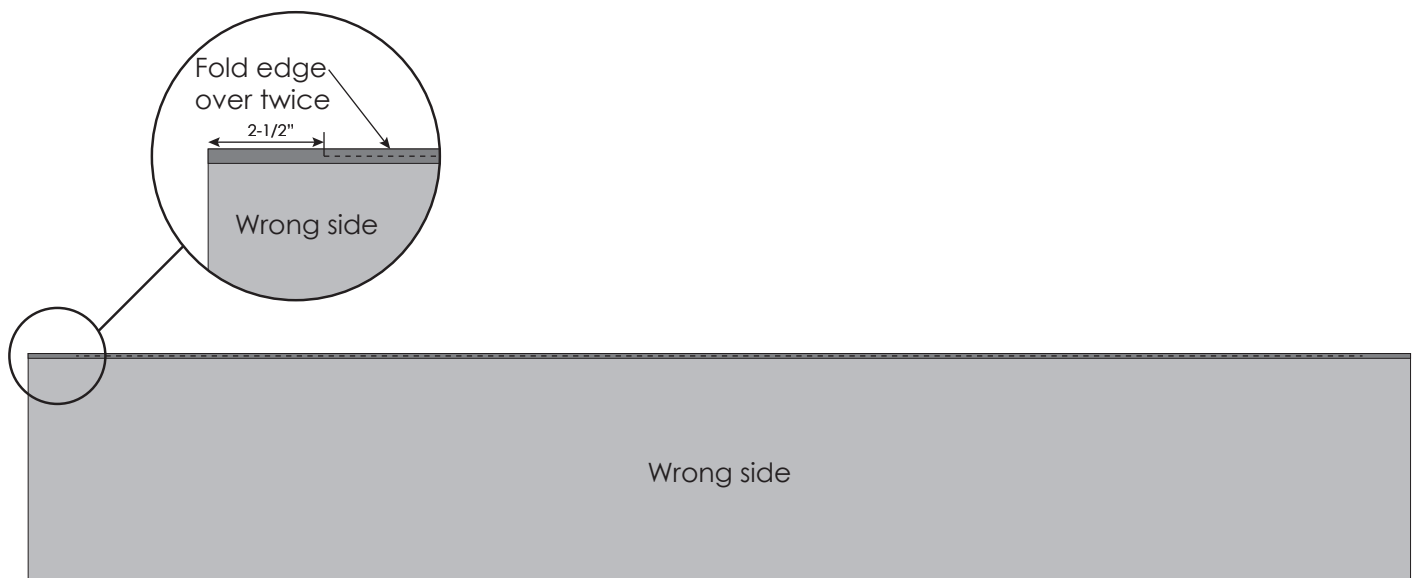
Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

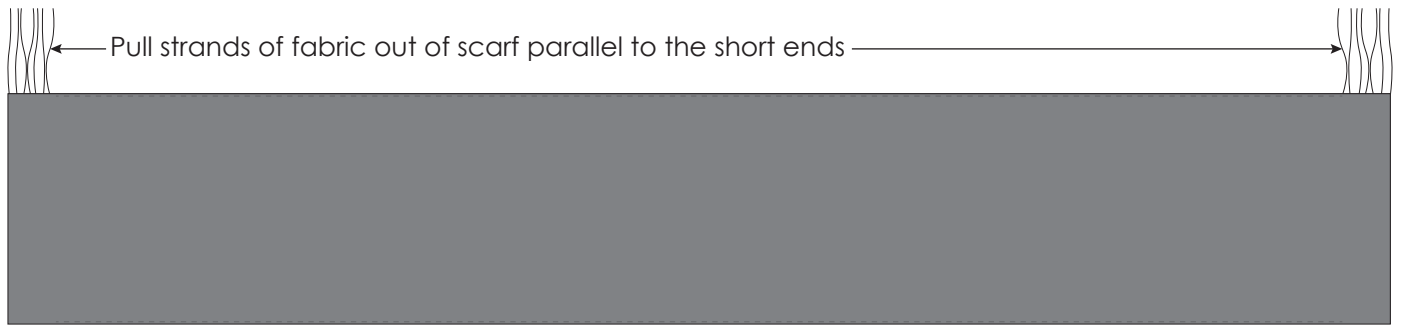
three 13" x Length of Fabric strips.

Assemble the Scarves

Step 1: Fold the long edges of one strip under 1/4" to the wrong side and press. Fold another 1/4" under and press, so that all raw edges are encased. Stitch along both long edges, leaving the outer 2-1/2" of each end unsewn.



Step 2: Pull threads from the short ends to create frayed edges.



Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make a total of three scarves from Fabric A.
