## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

### **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, cut:

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: forty 3-1/2" squares for the HSTs twenty-six 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: eighty 3" x 10-1/2" rectangles eighty 3" squares

#### From each of Fabrics B-E, cut:

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixteen 3-1/2" squares for the HSTs one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: five 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles

#### From each of Fabrics F-Q, cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: six 3-1/2" squares for the HSTs one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: five 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a 3-1/2" Fabric A square with a 3-1/2" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3" square. Repeat to make twenty A/B HSTs.



**Step 2:** Repeat Step 1 to make:

twenty A/C HSTs	twenty A/D HSTs	twenty A/E HSTs	six B/C HSTs
six C/D HSTs	six D/E HSTs	six E/B HSTs	six F/G HSTs

#### Assemble the Blocks



Step 3: Gather:

one B/C HST one C/D HST one D/E HST one E/B HST

one rectangle in each of Fabrics B-E four Fabric A squares

Arrange the HSTs into two rows of two. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

**Step 4:** Sew the HSTs together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite directions. Sew the rows together to form the center Four-Patch. Press.

**Step 5:** Arrange the center Four-Patch and the remaining units together in three rows of three. Sew the units together to form rows, pressing the seams toward the B-E rectangles. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block center.





Step 6: Gather: the Step 5 Block Center four Fabric A rectangles one A/B HST one A/C HST one A/D HST one A/E HST

Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

**Step 7:** Sew the units together to form the rows. Press the seams away from the Fabric A rectangles.

**Step 8:** Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The resulting Block should measure 15-1/2" square. Repeat to make five Blocks in this fabric arrangement.



**Step 9:** Repeat Steps 3-8 to make five Blocks in each of the other fabric arrangements.



#### Assemble the Quilt



**Step 10:** Arrange the blocks into five rows of four blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 11: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

**Step 12:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
