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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From Fabric A, cut:**

five 10" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
twenty 10" squares for the HSTs

### **From Fabric B, cut:**

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:  
two 2-1/2" x 58-1/2" top/bottom inner borders  
two 2-1/2" x 63-1/2" side inner borders

### **From Fabric C, cut:**

seven 5" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:  
two 5" x 67-1/2" top/bottom outer borders  
two 5" x 67-1/2" side outer borders

### **From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

### **From the Ten-Square Pack:**

Select one square of the print that matches Fabric A, and add it to the Fabric A squares, for a total of twenty-one. Set aside any remaining matching squares for a future project.

Select twenty-one print squares to use for the Half-Square Triangles.

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a Fabric A square with a 10" square from the Ten-Square pack, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 9-1/2" square.



Repeat to make forty-two HSTs, each made from Fabric A paired with another print.



## Assemble the Quilt



**Step 2:** Arrange the blocks into seven rows of six blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, ensuring that the Fabric A portions of the HSTs align to form the diamond design shown.

**Step 3:** Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

**Step 4:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

**Step 5:** Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 6:** Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
