Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: six 5-1/2" squares for the A Blocks

From Fabric B, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: eight 5-1/2" squares for the B Blocks

From Fabric C, cut:

four 3-1/2" x <u>length</u> of fabric strips. Sew together in pairs, then trim:
two 3-1/2" x 45" side outer borders
From the remaining width of fabric, cut:
four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together in pairs, then trim:
two 3-1/2" x 42-1/2" top/bottom outer borders
two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

six 5-1/2" squares for the C Blocks

From Fabric D, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangles for the blocks two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles for the blocks

From Fabric E, cut:

three 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: six 2" x 7-1/2" rectangles for the A Blocks six 2" x 9" rectangles for the A Blocks

From Fabric F, cut:

four 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: eight 2" x 7-1/2" rectangles for the B Blocks eight 2" x 9" rectangles for the B Blocks

From Fabric G, cut:

three 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: six 2" x 7-1/2" rectangles for the C Blocks six 2" x 9" rectangles for the C Blocks


From Fabric H, cut:

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: two 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" top/bottom inner borders two 1-1/2" x 43" side inner borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the A Blocks



Step 1: Gather:

one Fabric A square

one 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric D rectangle

one 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" Fabric D rectangle

one 2" x 7-1/2" Fabric E rectangle

one 2" x 9" Fabric E rectangle

Arrange the units as shown. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 2: Sew the 5-1/2" Fabric D rectangle to the left edge of the square. Press toward the rectangle. Sew the 7-1/2" Fabric D rectangle to the top edge of the square. Press toward the rectangle.

Step 3: Sew the 7-1/2" Fabric E rectangle to the left edge of the square. Press toward the rectangle. Sew the 9" Fabric E rectangle to the top edge of the square. Press toward the rectangle.

The resulting A Block should measure 9" square. Repeat Steps 1-3 to make a total of six A Blocks.

Assemble the B Blocks



Step 4: Gather:

one Fabric B square

one 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric D rectangle

one 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" Fabric D rectangle

one 2" x 7-1/2" Fabric F rectangle

one 2" x 9" Fabric F rectangle

Step 5: Repeat the process in Steps 1-3 to make a total of eight B Blocks.

Assemble the C Blocks



Step 6: Gather:

one Fabric C square


one 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric D rectangle

one 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" Fabric D rectangle

one 2" x 7-1/2" Fabric G rectangle

one 2" x 9" Fabric G rectangle

Step 7: Repeat the process in Steps 1-3 to make a total of six C Blocks.



Step 8: Arrange the blocks into five rows of four blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

- **Step 9:** Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.
- Step 10: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.
- **Step 11:** Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.
- **Step 12:** Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
