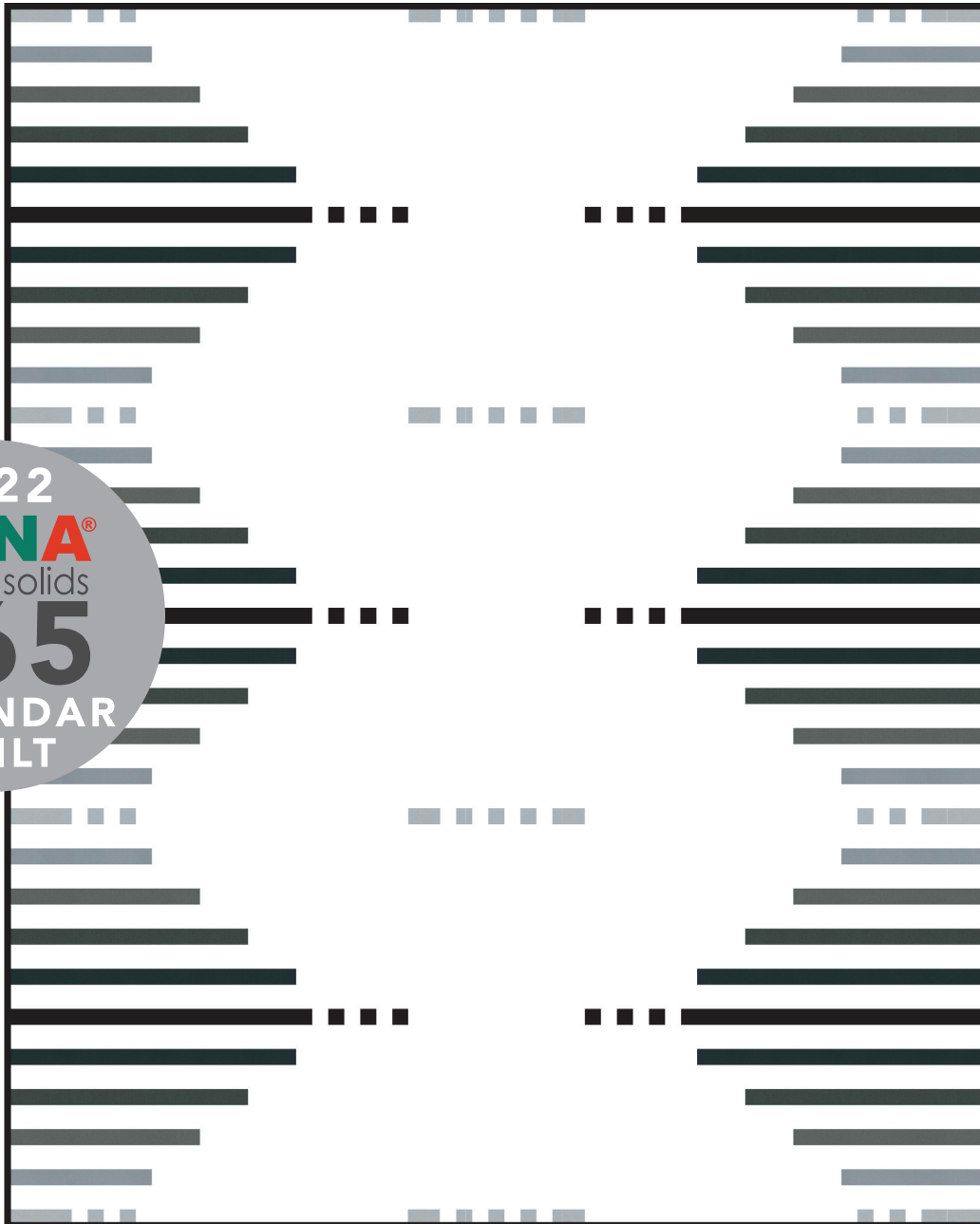



Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

- three 25-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 - sixty 2" x 25-1/2" rectangles
- one 24-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
 - three 11-1/2" x 24-1/2" rectangles

one 16-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
one 16-1/2" x 19" rectangle for the Row 2 units
Trim the remainder of the strip to 13-1/2" wide, then subcut:
one 13-1/2" x 19" rectangle for the Row 3 units

one 10-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
one 10-1/2" x 19" rectangle for the Row 4 units
Trim the remainder of the strip to 7-1/2" wide, then subcut:
one 7-1/2" x 19" rectangle for the Row 5 units

one 13" x WOF strip. Subcut:
one 13" x 17-1/2" rectangle for the Row 1 units
two 13" x 1-1/2" strips for the Row 1 units
Trim the remainder of the unit to 10" wide, then subcut:
three 1-1/2" x 10" strips for the Row 6 units
Trim the remainder of the unit to 7" wide, then subcut:
four 1-1/2" x 7" strips for the Row 7 units

From Fabric B, cut:

one 7" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 2-1/2" x 7" rectangles for the Row 7 units
three 1-1/2" x 7" strips for the Row 7 units
Trim the remainder of the strip to 4-1/2" wide, then subcut:
one 4-1/2" x 13" rectangle for the Row 1 unit
Trim the remainder of the strip into two 1-1/2" wide strips, then subcut:
two 1-1/2" x 13" strips for the Row 1 units

From Fabric C, cut:

one 9-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
one 9-1/2" x 19" rectangle for the Row 2 units

From Fabric D, cut:

one 12-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
one 12-1/2" x 19" rectangle for the Row 3 units

From Fabric E, cut:

one 15-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
one 15-1/2" x 19" rectangle for the Row 4 units

From Fabric F, cut:

one 18-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
one 18-1/2" x 19" rectangle for the Row 5 units

From Fabric G, cut:

one 10" x WOF strip. Subcut:
one 10" x 19-1/2" rectangle for the Row 6 units
three 10" x 1-1/2" strips for the Row 6 units

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Note

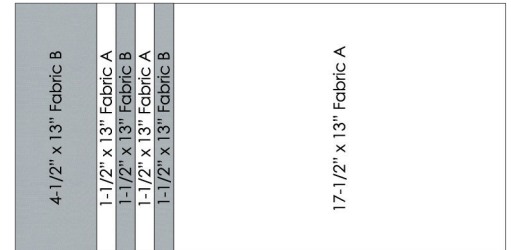
This quilt is assembled in units that are subcut, to avoid piecing many tiny pieces. Organize the cut pieces in piles by row for easy assembly.

Assemble the Row 1 Units

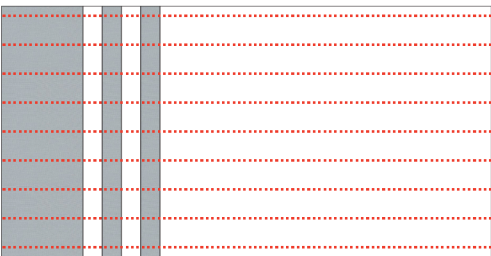
Step 1: Gather:

one 4-1/2" x 13" Fabric B rectangle
two 1-1/2" x 13" Fabric A rectangles
two 1-1/2" x 13" Fabric B rectangles
one 17-1/2" x 13" Fabric A rectangle

Arrange together as shown and sew together.
Press toward the darker fabric.



Step 2: Subcut the unit into eight 1-1/2" x 25-1/2" Row 1 units.

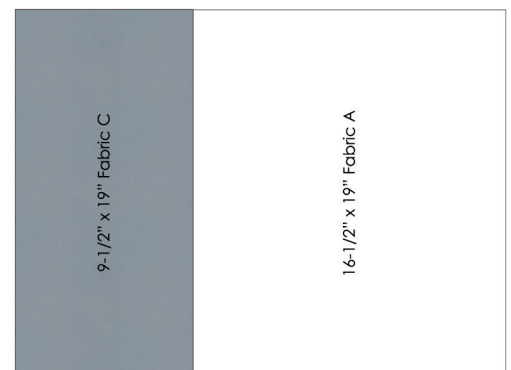


Assemble the Row 2 Units

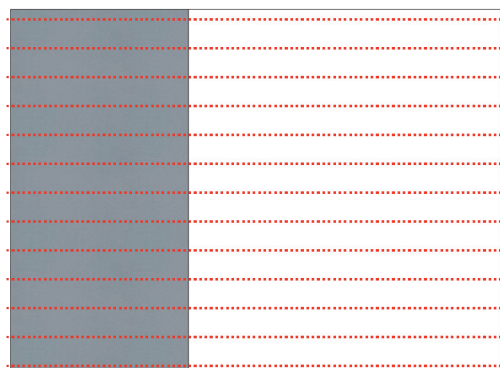
Step 3: Gather:

one 9-1/2" x 19" Fabric C rectangle
one 16-1/2" x 19" Fabric A rectangle

Arrange together as shown and sew together.
Press toward the darker fabric.



Step 4: Subcut the unit into twelve 1-1/2" x 25-1/2" Row 2 units.



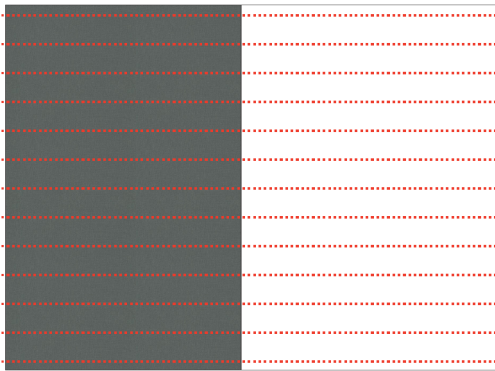
Assemble the Row 3 Units

Step 5: Gather:
one 12-1/2" x 19" Fabric D rectangle
one 13-1/2" x 19" Fabric A rectangle

Arrange together as shown and sew together. Press toward the darker fabric.



Step 6: Subcut the unit into twelve 1-1/2" x 25-1/2" Row 3 units.



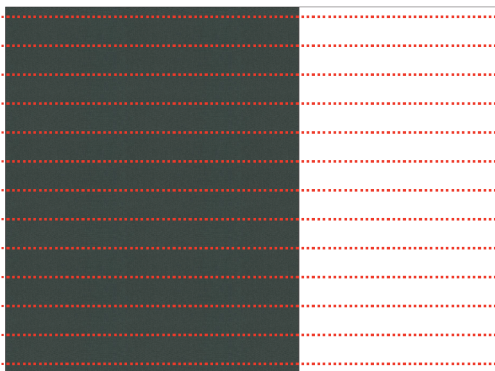
Assemble the Row 4 Units

Step 7: Gather:
one 15-1/2" x 19" Fabric E rectangle
one 10-1/2" x 19" Fabric A rectangle

Arrange together as shown and sew together. Press toward the darker fabric.



Step 8: Subcut the unit into twelve 1-1/2" x 25-1/2" Row 4 units.

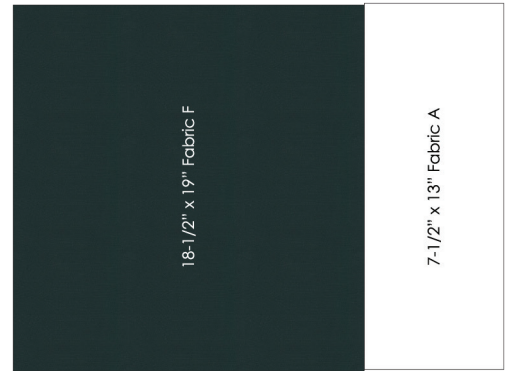


Assemble the Row 5 Units

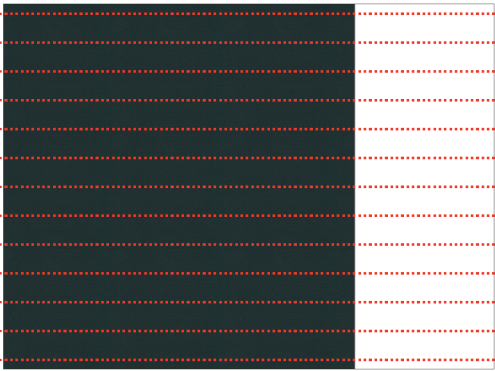
Step 9: Gather:

one 18-1/2" x 19" Fabric F rectangle
one 7-1/2" x 19" Fabric A rectangle

Arrange together as shown and sew together. Press toward the darker fabric.



Step 10: Subcut the unit into twelve 1-1/2" x 25-1/2" Row 5 units.



Assemble the Row 6 Units

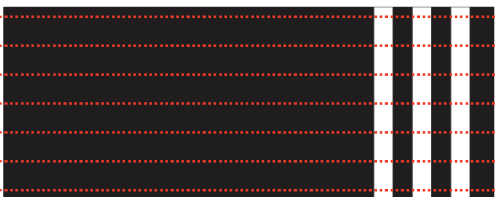
Step 11: Gather:

one 19-1/2" x 10" Fabric G rectangle
three 1-1/2" x 10" Fabric A rectangles
three 1-1/2" x 10" Fabric G rectangles

Arrange together as shown and sew together. Press toward the darker fabric.



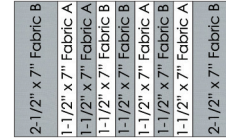
Step 12: Subcut the unit into six 1-1/2" x 25-1/2" Row 6 units.



Assemble the Row 7 Units

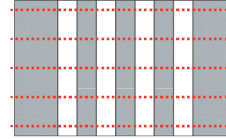
Step 13: Gather:

- two 2-1/2" x 7" Fabric B rectangle
- three 1-1/2" x 7" Fabric B rectangles
- four 1-1/2" x 7" Fabric A rectangles



Arrange together as shown and sew together. Press toward the darker fabric.

Step 14: Subcut the unit into four 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" Row 7 units.

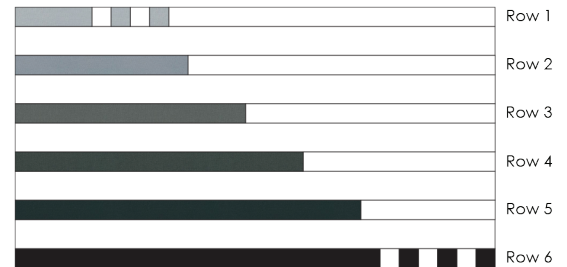


Assemble the A Units

Step 15: Gather:

- one each of Rows 1-6
- five 2" x 25-1/2" Row A strips

Arrange together as shown and sew together, noting the placement of the pieced Rows. Press toward the pieced rows. Repeat to make six A Units.

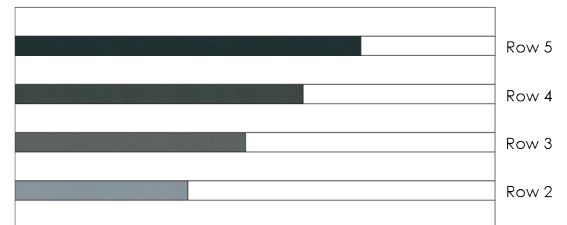


Assemble the B Units

Step 15: Gather:

- one each of Rows 2-5
- five 2" x 25-1/2" Fabric A strips

Arrange together as shown and sew together, noting the placement of the pieced Rows. Press toward the pieced rows. Repeat to make six B Units.



Assemble the Left and Right Columns

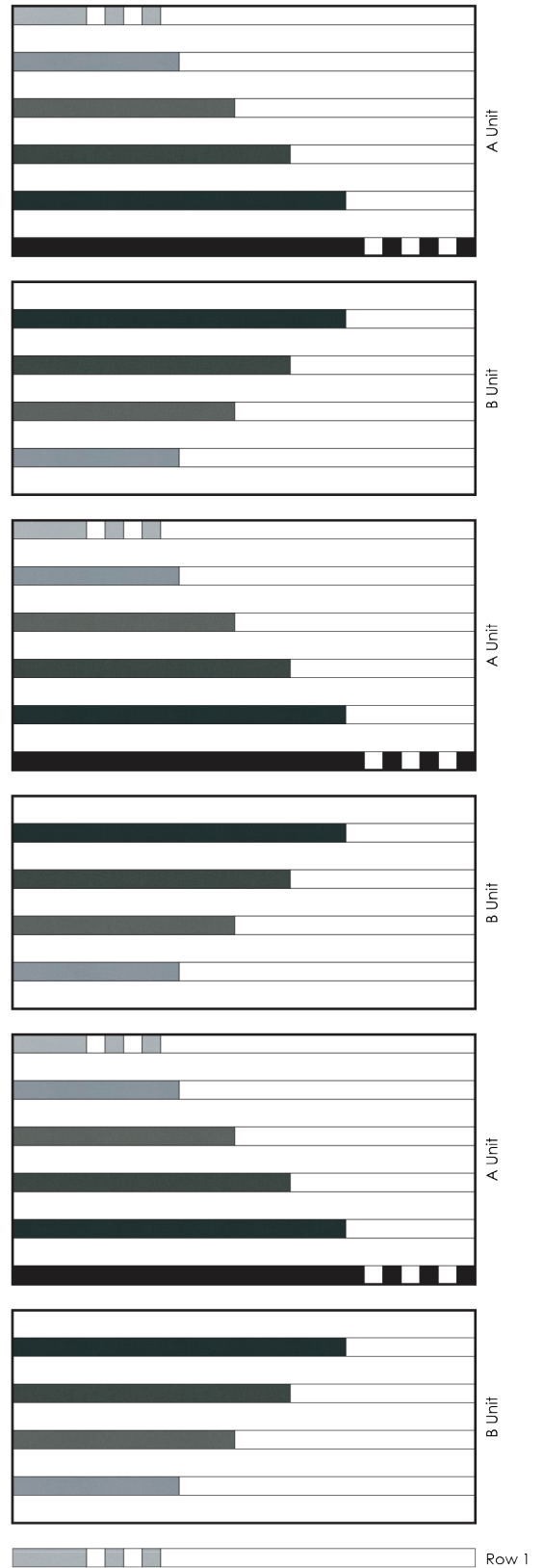
Step 17: Gather:

three A Units

three B Units

one remaining Row 1 unit

Arrange together as shown and sew together to form the Left Column, noting the placement and orientation of the pieced Rows. Press. Repeat to form the Right Column.



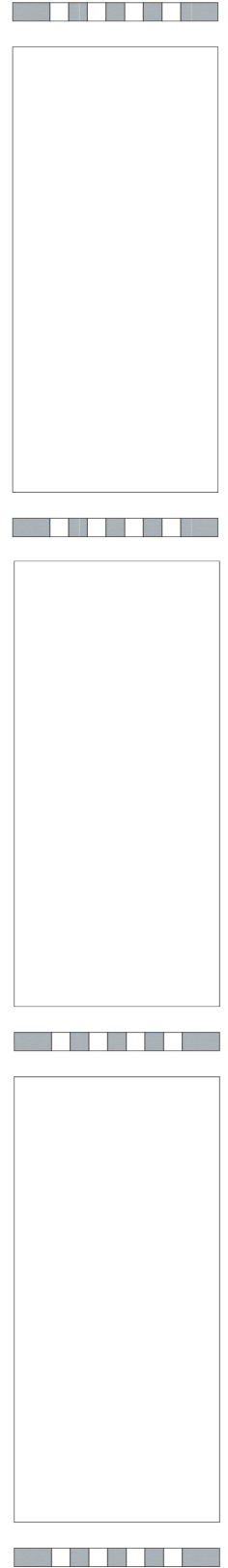
Assemble the Center Column

Step 18: Gather:

four of Row 7

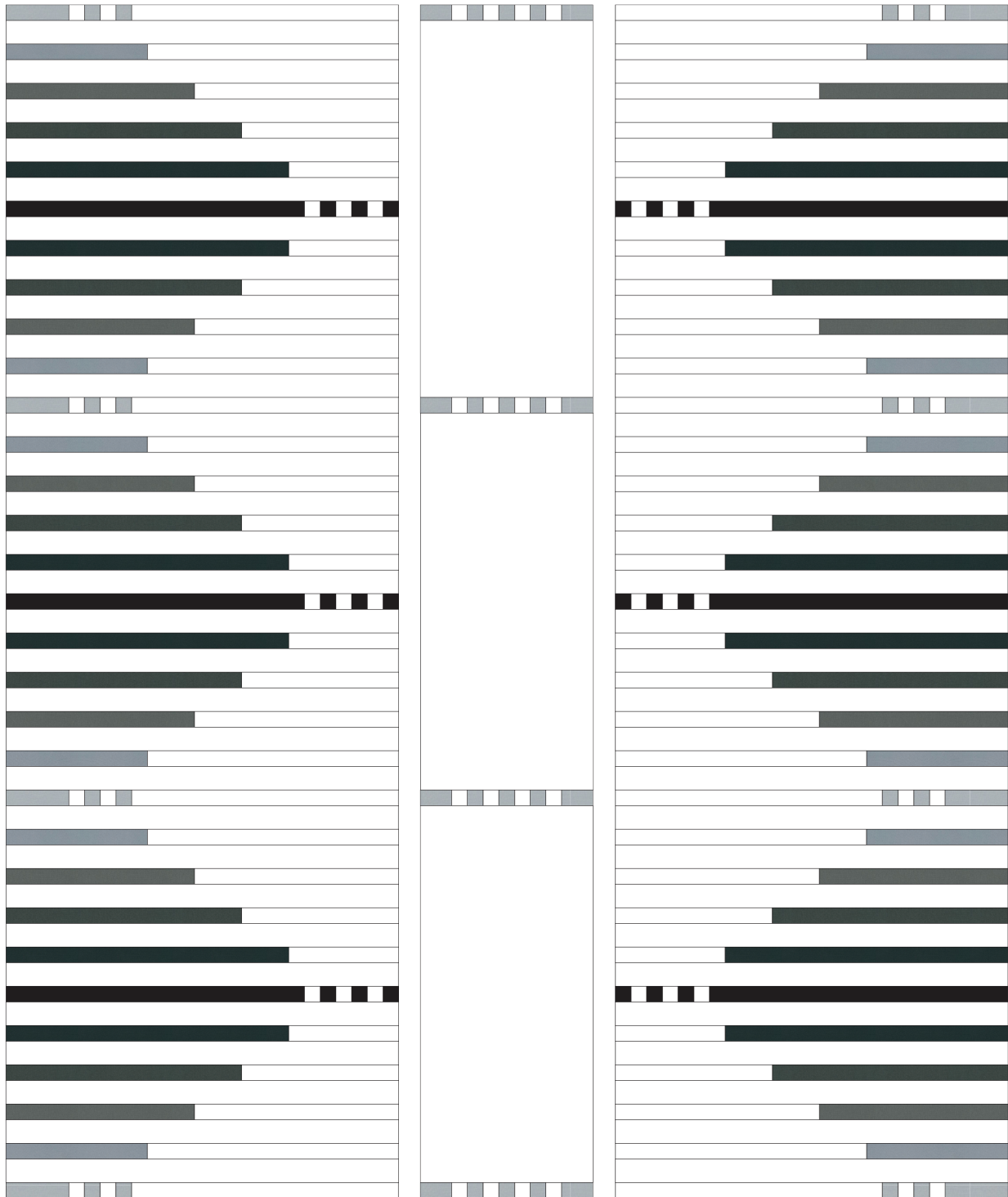
three 11-1/2" x 24-1/2" Fabric A rectangles

Arrange together as shown and sew together to form the Center Column, noting the placement of the pieced Rows. Press toward the pieced rows.



Assemble the Quilt

Step 19: Sew the Left, Center and Right Columns together. Press.



Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
