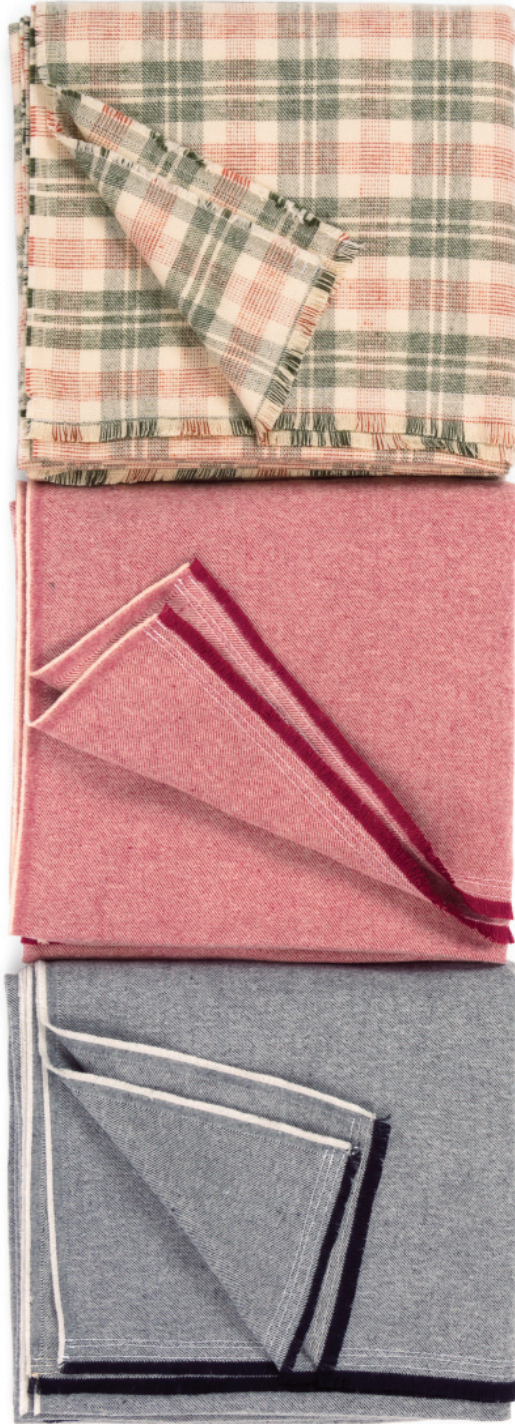

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 44" wide.


Cranberry Colorstory

Color	Fabric	Name/SKU	Yardage
	A	SRKF-16407-113 CRANBERRY	2-1/2 yards

Pepper Colorstory

Color	Fabric	Name/SKU	Yardage
	A	SRKF-16408-188 PEPPER	2-1/2 yards

Olive Colorstory

Color	Fabric	Name/SKU	Yardage
	A	SRKF-16414-49 OLIVE	2-1/2 yards

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 44" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:
one 88" x WOF piece

Sewing Instructions

Step 1: Leave the selvage edges intact. These will prevent fraying along these two edges.

Step 2: Sew along the remaining two (cut) edges at 1/2", 3/4" and 1" from the cut edge. Backstitch at each end.

Step 3: Using a seam ripper or straight pin, gently pull threads to create frayed edges. Continue in this manner until you have only a few threads left outside of the stitching from Step 2.
