



Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 43" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 43" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 22" x 40-1/2" center panel

From Fabric B, cut:

nine 2-7/8" x WOF strips. From four strips, subcut:

four 2-7/8" x 33-1/2" strips

Sew the remaining five strips together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

four 2-7/8" x 50-1/2" strips

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 1-1/2" x 25-1/2" strips

two 1-1/2" x 33-1/2" strips

two 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips

two 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Trim to:

two 2-1/4" x 4-1/2" strips

From Fabric C, cut:

four 3-1/2" x length of fabric strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 3-1/2" x 31-1/2" strips

From the remaining width of fabric, cut:

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 3-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips

From Fabric D, cut:

nine 2-7/8" x WOF strips. From two strips, subcut:

four 2-7/8" x 33-1/2" strips

Sew the remaining five strips together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

four 2-7/8" x 50-1/2" strips

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding

From Fabric E, cut:

five 2-7/8" x WOF strips. From four strips, subcut:

two 2-7/8" x 33-1/2" strips

Sew the remaining three strips together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 2-7/8" x 50-1/2" strips

From Fabric F, cut:

four 12-3/8" squares

From each of Fabrics G and H, cut:

one from Template 1

From Fabric I, cut:

two from Template 1

Assemble the Striped Outer Borders

Step 1: Gather:

two 2-7/8" x 33-1/2" Fabric D strips

two 2-7/8" x 33-1/2" Fabric B strips

one 2-7/8" x 33-1/2" Fabric E strip

Sew together along the longest edges, in this order: D-B-D-B-E. This is the top pieced border. Press the seams toward the darker fabrics. Repeat to make the bottom pieced border.



Step 2: Gather:

two 2-7/8" x 50-1/2" Fabric D strips

two 2-7/8" x 50-1/2" Fabric B strips

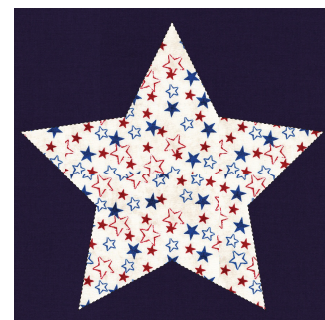
one 2-7/8" x 50-1/2" Fabric E strip

Sew together along the longest edges, in this order: D-B-D-B-E. This is a side pieced border. Press the seams toward the darker fabrics. Repeat to make the second side pieced border.



Step 3: Center the Fabric G/Template 1 piece right side up on top of a Fabric F square. Pin in place and edge stitch around the star shape to appliqué it to the Fabric F square. Be sure that at least 1/4" remains beyond each point so that the star points are not clipped off when the blocks are sewn to the borders.

Step 4: Repeat Step 3 with the remaining Template 1 pieces and Fabric F squares.



Step 5: Sew the Fabric G corner block to the left edge of the top pieced border. Sew one Fabric I corner block to the right edge of the top pieced border. Press the seams toward the border.



Step 6: Sew the Fabric I corner block to the left edge of the bottom pieced border. Sew one Fabric H corner block to the right edge of the bottom pieced border. Press the seams toward the border.



Assemble the Quilt



Step 7: Sew the 2-1/4" x 40-1/2" Fabric B side inner borders to the sides of the center panel. Press toward the darker fabric. Sew 1-1/2" x 25-1/2" Fabric B the top and bottom inner borders to the center panel. Press toward the darker fabric.

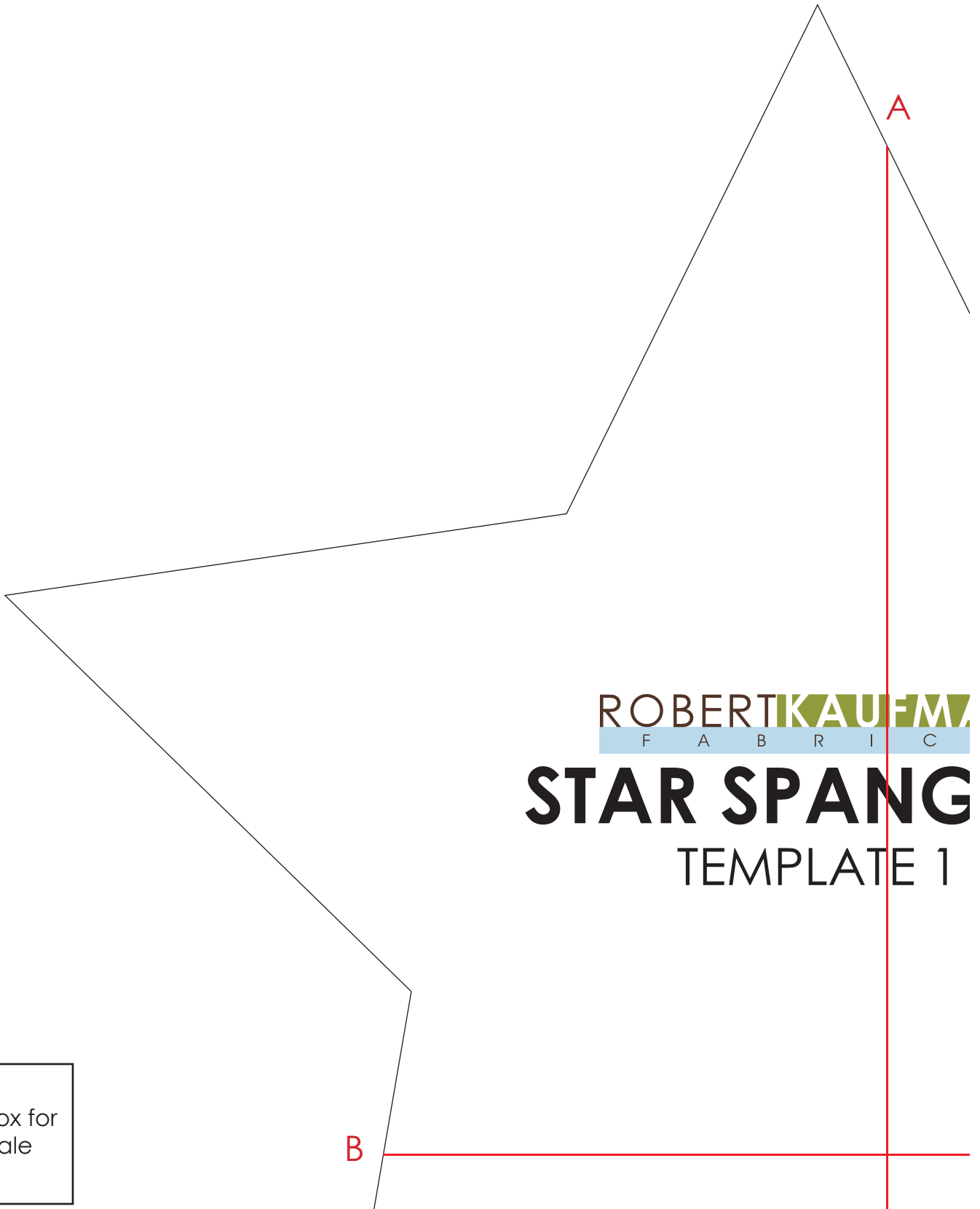
Step 8: Sew the 3-1/2" x 42-1/2" Fabric C side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the darker fabric. Sew the 3-1/2" x 31-1/2" Fabric C top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the darker fabric.

Step 9: Sew the 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" Fabric B side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the darker fabric. Sew the 1-1/2" x 33-1/2" Fabric B top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the darker fabric.

Step 10: Sew the side pieced borders to the sides of the quilt center, noting the fabric placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press toward the darker fabric. Sew the top and bottom pieced borders to the quilt center, noting the fabric placement and corner star block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press toward the darker fabric.

Your quilt top is now complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
