








Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

*Note: In the Emerald Colorstory, Fabric H will be used for Fabric K, Fabric G will be used for Fabric I and Fabric C will be used for Fabric J. These are indicated in the piecing by a ***

From Fabric A, cut:

twenty-four of Template 4

From Fabric B, cut:

twenty-four of Template 4

four Template 1

From Fabric C, cut:

twenty-four of Template 4

From Fabric D, cut:

six 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 3-1/2" x 60-1/2" side inner borders

two 3-1/2" x 65-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

thirty-two of Template 4

From Fabric E, cut:

one 19" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 19" squares. Cut each square in half along one diagonal.

forty of Template 4

From Fabric F, cut:

forty-eight of Template 4

eight of Template 3

eight of Template 3 Reversed

From Fabric G, cut:

forty of Template 4

From Fabric H, cut:

thirty-two of Template 4

From Fabric I, cut:

seven 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 3-1/2" x 65-1/2" side middle borders

two 3-1/2" x 71-1/2" top/bottom middle borders

eight of Template 2

eight of Template 2 Reversed

From Fabric J, cut:

twenty-four of Template 4

From Fabric K, cut:

seven 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2" x 71-1/2" side inner borders

two 2" x 74-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

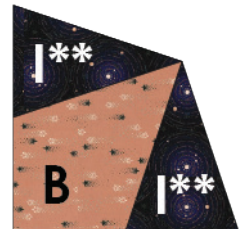
From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Triangle Units

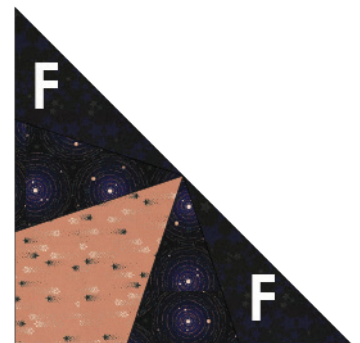
*Note: In the Emerald Colorstory, Fabric H will be used for Fabric K, Fabric G will be used for Fabric I and Fabric C will be used for Fabric J. These are indicated in the piecing by a ***

Step 1: Sew a Template 2 and Template 2-Reversed triangle to the long edges of Template 1. Press.

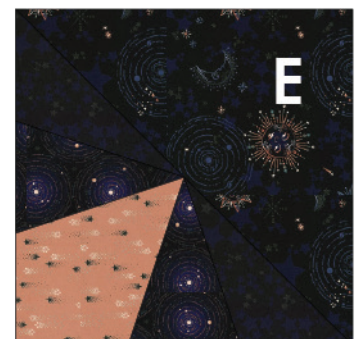


Step 2: Sew a Template 3 and Template 3-Reversed triangle to the unit as shown. Press.

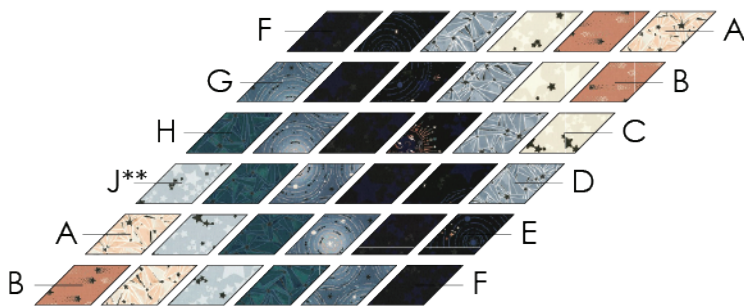
Make eight units like this.



Step 3: Sew a Fabric E triangle to the long edge of a Step 2 unit. Press. Trim to 18" square. Press. Repeat to make four units like this.

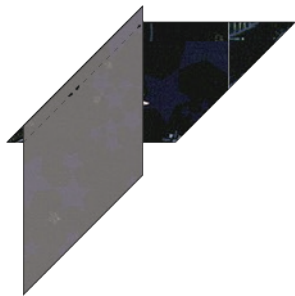


Assemble the Diamond Units

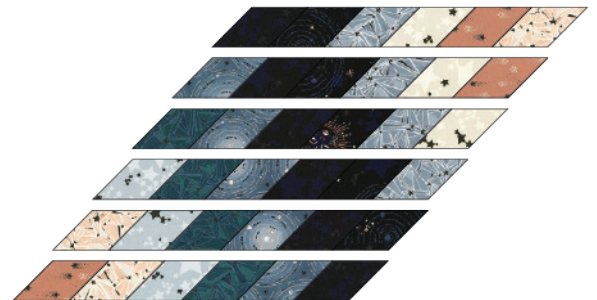


Step 4: Gather:
three A diamonds
three B diamonds
three C diamonds
three J diamonds
four D diamonds
four H diamonds
five E diamonds
five G diamonds
six F diamonds

Arrange the units into six rows of six. Note the fabric placement and diamond orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

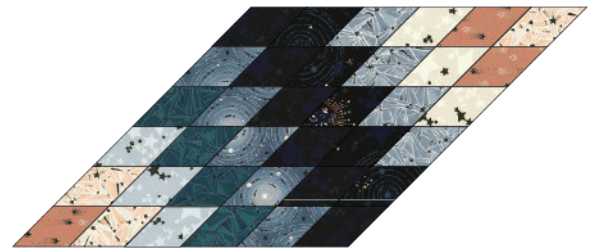


Step 5: Sew the units together to form the rows, offsetting as shown. Press the seams in opposite directions every other row.



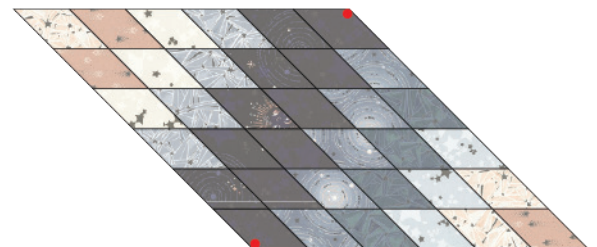
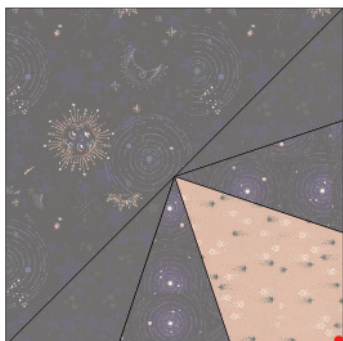
Step 6: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the Diamond Unit.

Make eight Diamond Units.



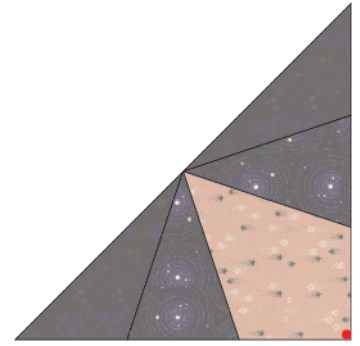
Mark the Y-Seam Points

Step 7: On the back side of each Diamond Unit, mark points 1/4" from each of the side points, as shown.



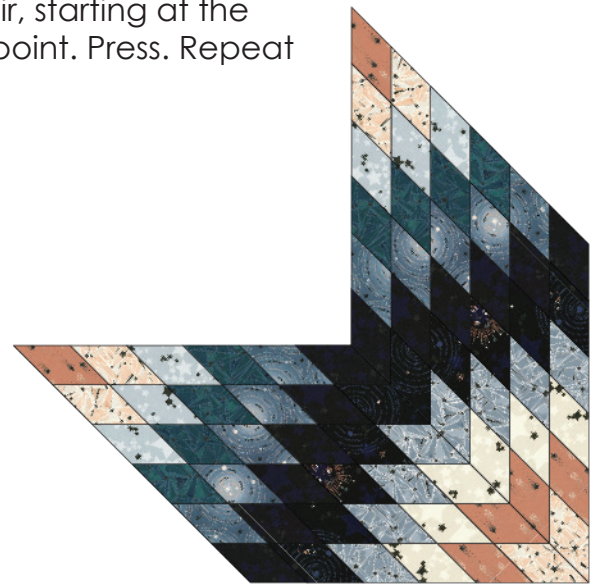
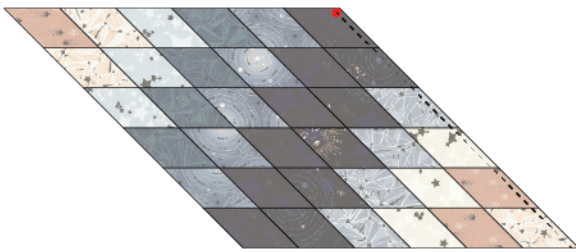
Step 8: On the back side of each Corner Unit, mark points 1/4" from the Fabric B point, as shown.

Step 9: On the back side of each Triangle Unit, mark points 1/4" from the Fabric B point, as shown.

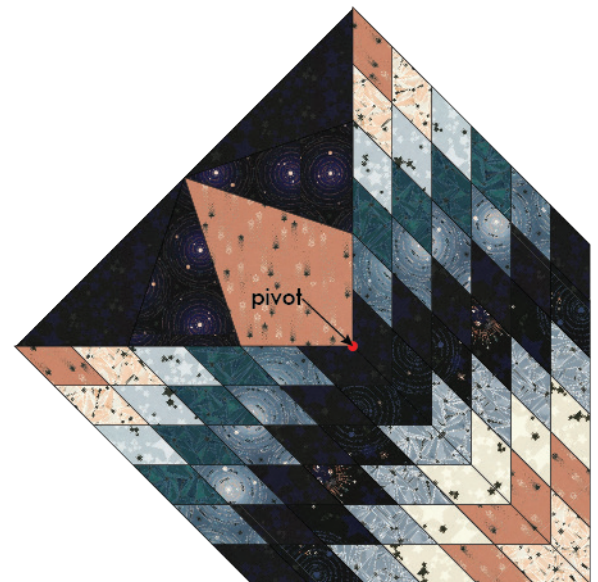


Assemble the Quilt Center

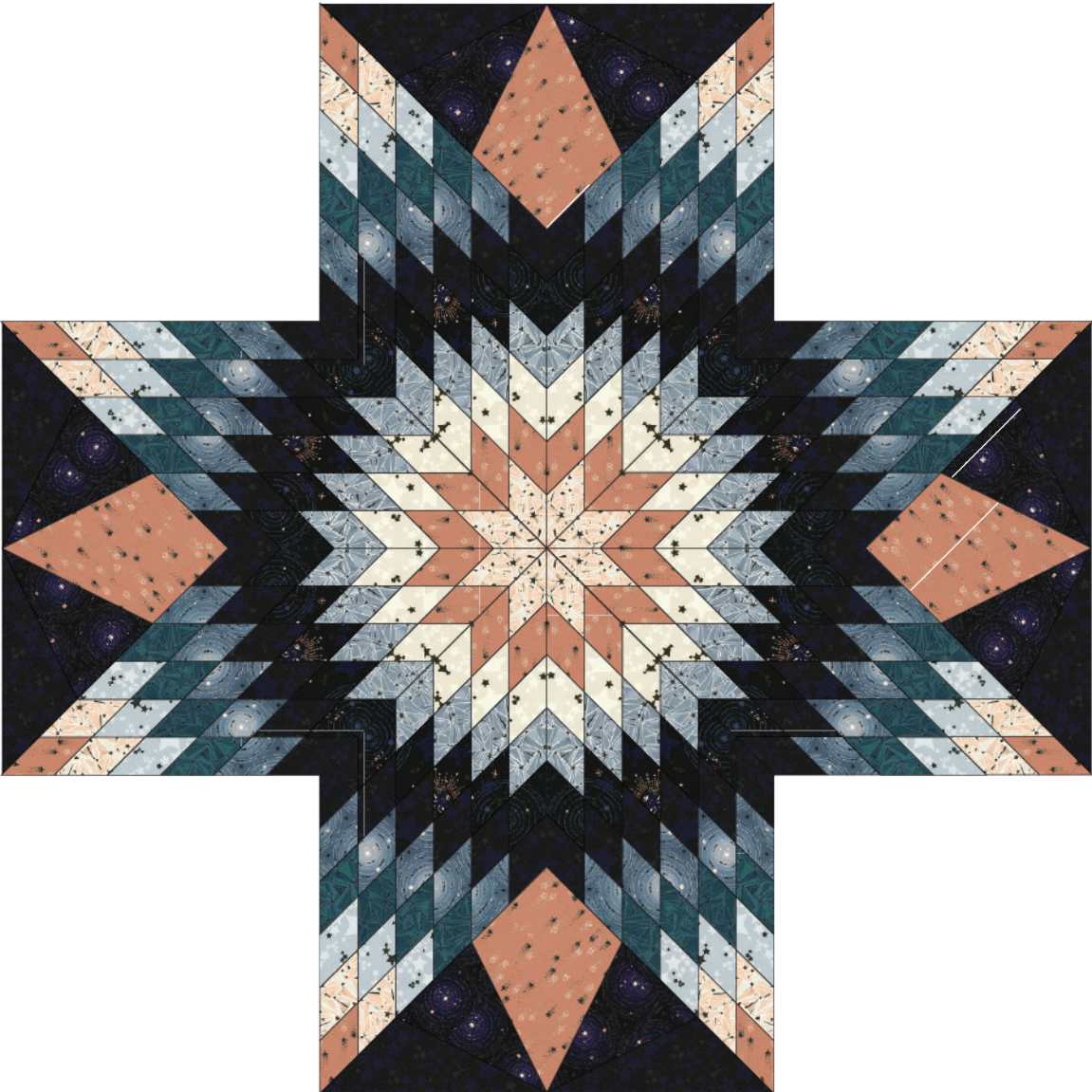
Step 10: Sew two Diamond Units together to form a pair, starting at the marked point and sewing to the raw edge of the endpoint. Press. Repeat to make four pairs like this.



Step 11: Place and sew a Triangle Unit to a Diamond Unit pair as shown, stopping to pivot where the marked points meet at the "V". Press. Repeat to make four units like this.



Step 12: Sew the completed Step 11 units together in pairs before finally sewing together to form the full Star. Start and stop at the marked points as before. Press.



Step 13: Place and sew a Corner Unit to each corner of the Star as shown, stopping to pivot where the marked points meet at the Fabric B corner. Press. Repeat to with four Corner Units like this.



The Quilt Center should measure 60-1/2" square at this point.

Step 14: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 15: Sew the side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 16: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

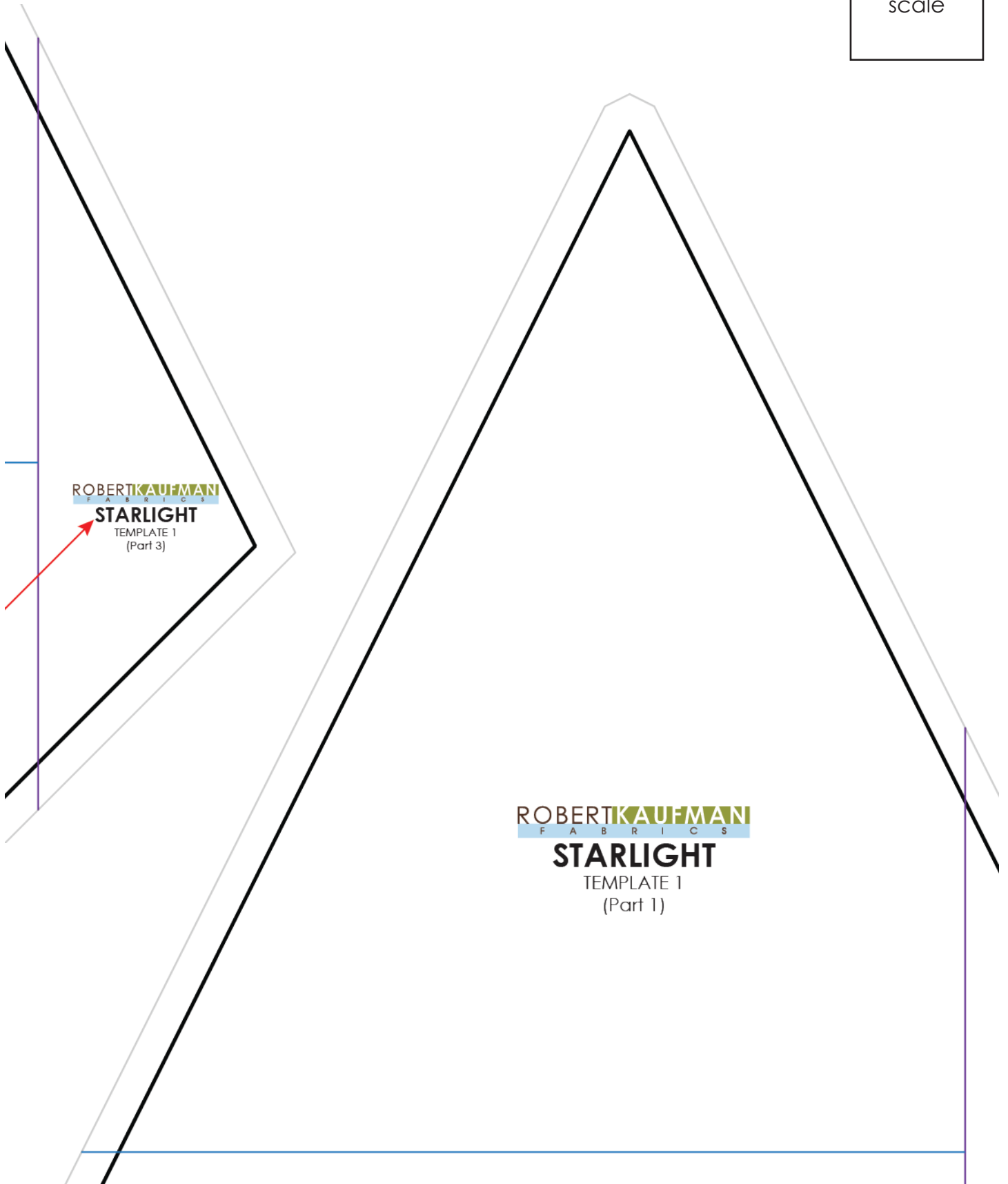
Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

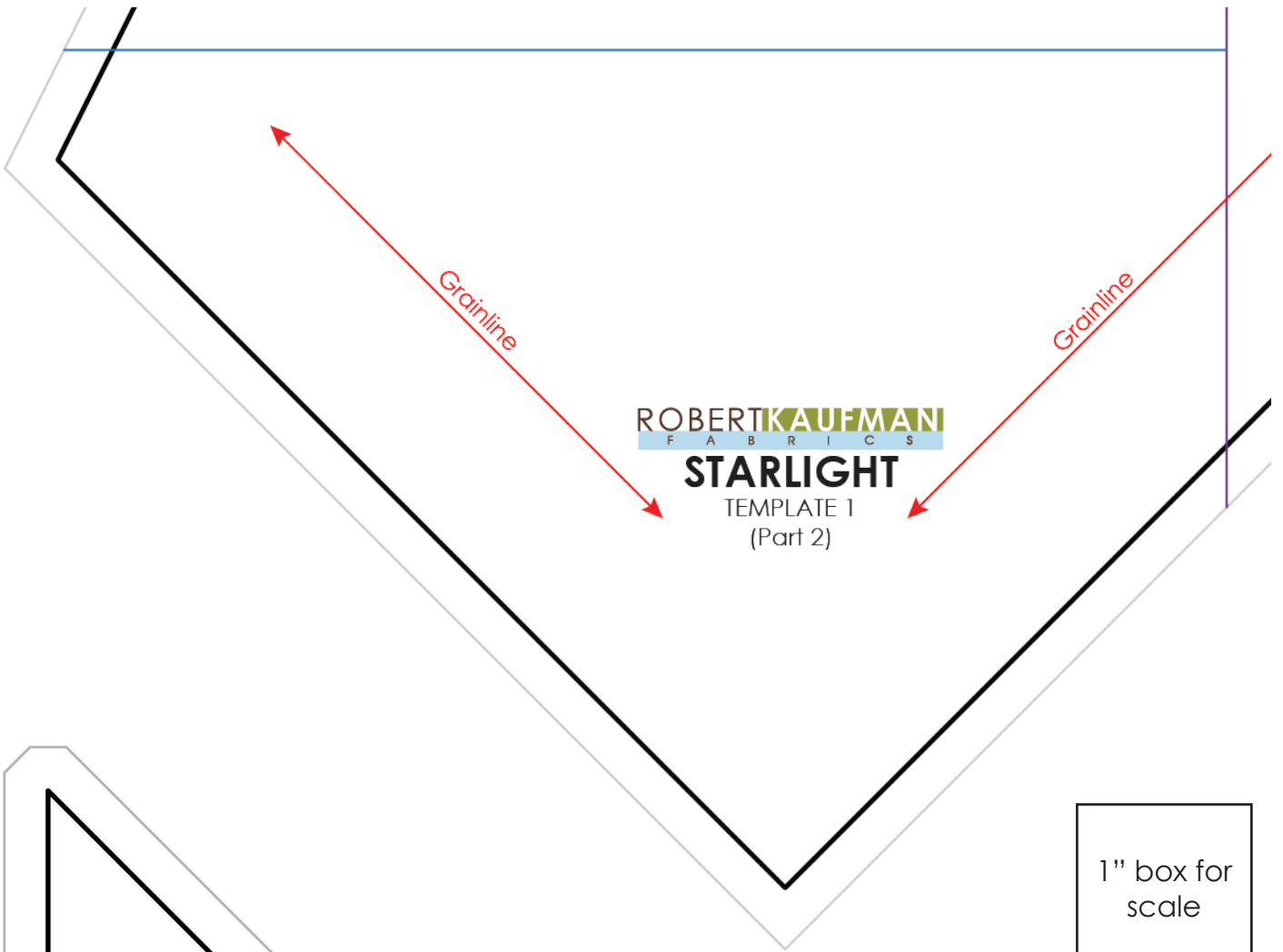
Templates

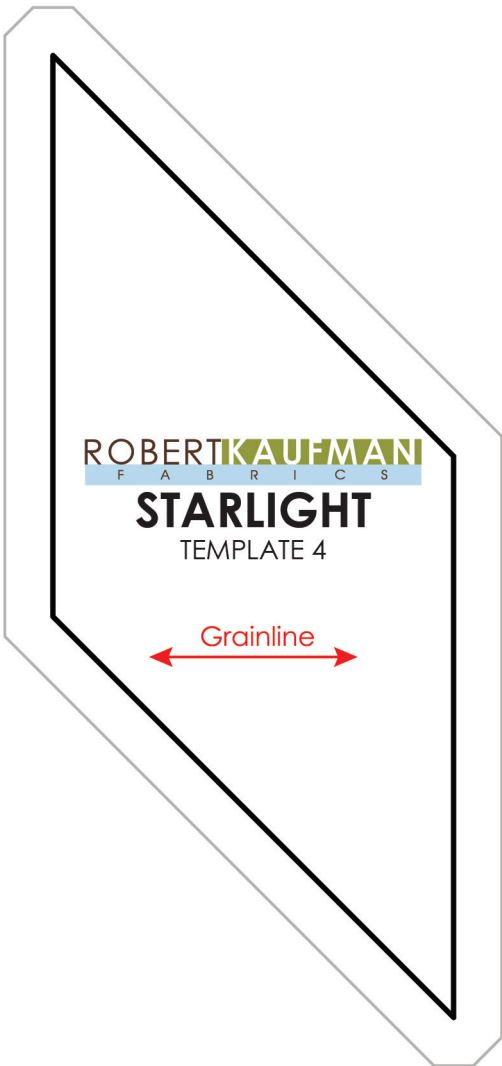


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TEMPLATE 1

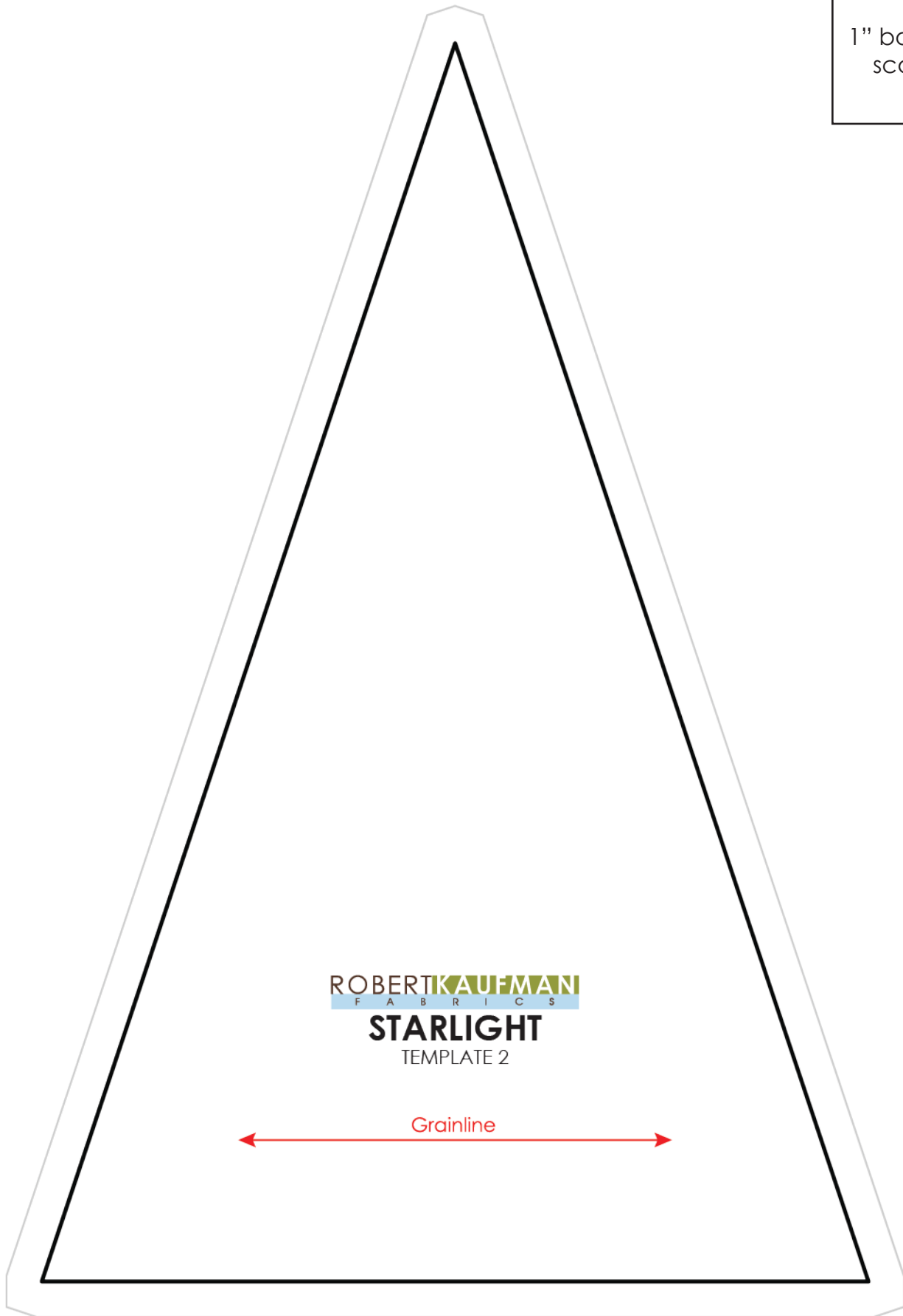
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TEMPLATE 4
