Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From **Fabric A**, cut: one 8-1/4" square

From **Fabric B**, cut: four from Template 2.

Using a washable fabric marker, transfer marked dots on the template onto the wrong sides of the fabric pieces.

From **Fabric C**, cut: four 3-1/8" squares

From **Fabric D**, cut:

eight triangles from Template 1

Using a washable fabric marker, transfer marked dots on the template onto the wrong sides of the fabric pieces.

From **Fabric E**, cut:

eight 3-1/8" squares

four from Template 2

Using a washable fabric marker, transfer marked dots on the template onto the wrong sides of the fabric pieces.

From **Fabric F**, cut:

four 3-1/8" squares

From the **backing fabric**, cut:


two 18-1/4" x 14" rectangles


Make the Pillow Front

Assemble the four 4-patch units by sewing a Fabric E and C square together and a Fabric E and F square together. Press away from Fabric E, then sew the units together to form the 4-patch. Press the seam open. Repeat to make all four units.

Assemble the side units by sewing a Fabric D triangle to each end of a Fabric B template piece. Start and stop the stitches on the marked dots. Sew the remaining Fabric E template piece in place, starting and stopping the stitches on the marked dots.

Arrange the pillow pieces, referring to the Assembly Diagram for placement.






Assemble the pillow in three rows of three units. Press the block seams away from the side units and press the row seams open.

Optional: Fuse one 18-1/4" square of fusible fleece to the back of the pillow

Make the Pillow Back

Fold one long edge of a pillow backing piece 1/4" to the wrong side. Press. Repeat and press again. Top stitch at the fold along the piece.


Repeat for remaining back piece.




Assemble the Pillow

Place pillow top right side up on work surface.

Place pillow backing pieces right sides together with the top, alining raw edges along the top and sides. Envelope backing will overlap through the center of the pillow.



Pin and sew around entire pillow, using a 1/4" seam. Clip the corners and turn right side out. Stuff your pillow with a pillow form to complete!
