

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

six 10" squares for the A Block Centers

From Fabric B, cut:

sixteen 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- twelve 2" x 9" B Block side borders
- twelve 2" x 12" B Block top/bottom borders
- ninety-six 2" squares for the Star Unit HSTs
- Sew the remainder of the last strip together with the remaining four full strips, end-to-end, then trim:
 - □ two 2" x 46-1/2" side inner borders
 - □ two 2" x 38" top/bottom inner borders

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

• ninety-six 1-1/2" squares for the Star Units

four 1" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- six 1" x 9" strips for the B Block sashing
- twelve 1" x 4-1/2" strips for the B Block sashing

From each of Fabrics C-E, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

• six 2-1/2" squares for the Star Units

two 2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twenty-four 2" squares for the Star Unit HSTs

two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- two 1-1/2" x 10" A Block side borders
- two 1-1/2" x 12" A Block top/bottom borders

From Fabric F, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

• six 2-1/2" squares for the Star Units

two 2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twenty-four 2" squares for the Star Unit HSTs

From each of Fabric G and H, cut:

two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- two 1-1/2" x 10" A Block side borders
- two 1-1/2" x 12" A Block top/bottom borders

From Fabric I, cut:

five 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

- two 3-1/2" x 49-1/2" side outer borders
- two 3-1/2" x 44" top/bottom outer borders

two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- two 1-1/2" x 10" A Block side borders
- two 1-1/2" x 12" A Block top/bottom borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the A Blocks



Step 1: Sew a Fabric E side border to the left and right edges of a Fabric A square (note the specific square from Fabric A in the diagram). Press. Sew a Fabric E top/bottom border to the remaining edges of the Fabric A square. Press.

The resulting A Block should measure 12" square. Repeat to make six A Blocks, noting the border and block center pairings in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 2: Pair a 2" Fabric B square with a 2" Fabric C square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 1-1/2" square. Repeat to make forty-eight B/C HSTs.



Step 3: Repeat Step 2 to make:



forty-eight B/D HSTs





forty-eight B/E HSTs





forty-eight B/F HSTs

Step 4: Sew a matching pair of HSTs together, as shown. Press. Repeat with all C, D, E and F HSTs.









Assemble the Star Units



Step 5: Gather: four 1-1/2" Fabric B squares four Fabric C HST pairs one 2-1/2" Fabric C square


Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 6: Sew the units together to form the rows. Press the seams away from the HST pairs.

Step 7: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the Star Unit. The unit should measure 4-1/2" square.

Repeat to make six Star Units in each of Fabrics C-F.

Assemble the B Blocks



Step 8: Gather: one Star Unit in each of Fabrics C-F two 1" x 4-1/2" Fabric B strips one 1" x 9" Fabric B strip two 2" x 9" Fabric B strips

two 2" x 12" Fabric B strips

Arrange the units as shown. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 9: Sew a 1" x 4-1/2" Fabric B strip between the Fabric F and Fabric E Star Units. Press. Sew a 1" x 4-1/2" Fabric B strip between the Fabric C and Fabric D Star Units. Press. Sew the units together, with a 1" x 9" Fabric B strip in between. Press.

Step 10: Sew the side block borders to the left and right edges of the Block. Press. Sew the top/bottom block borders to the remaining edges of the Block. Press.

The B Block should measure 12" square. Repeat Steps 9-10 to make six B Blocks.



Step 11: Arrange the A and B Blocks into four rows of three blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

- **Step 12:** Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.
- **Step 13:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.
- **Step 14:** Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.
- **Step 15:** Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
