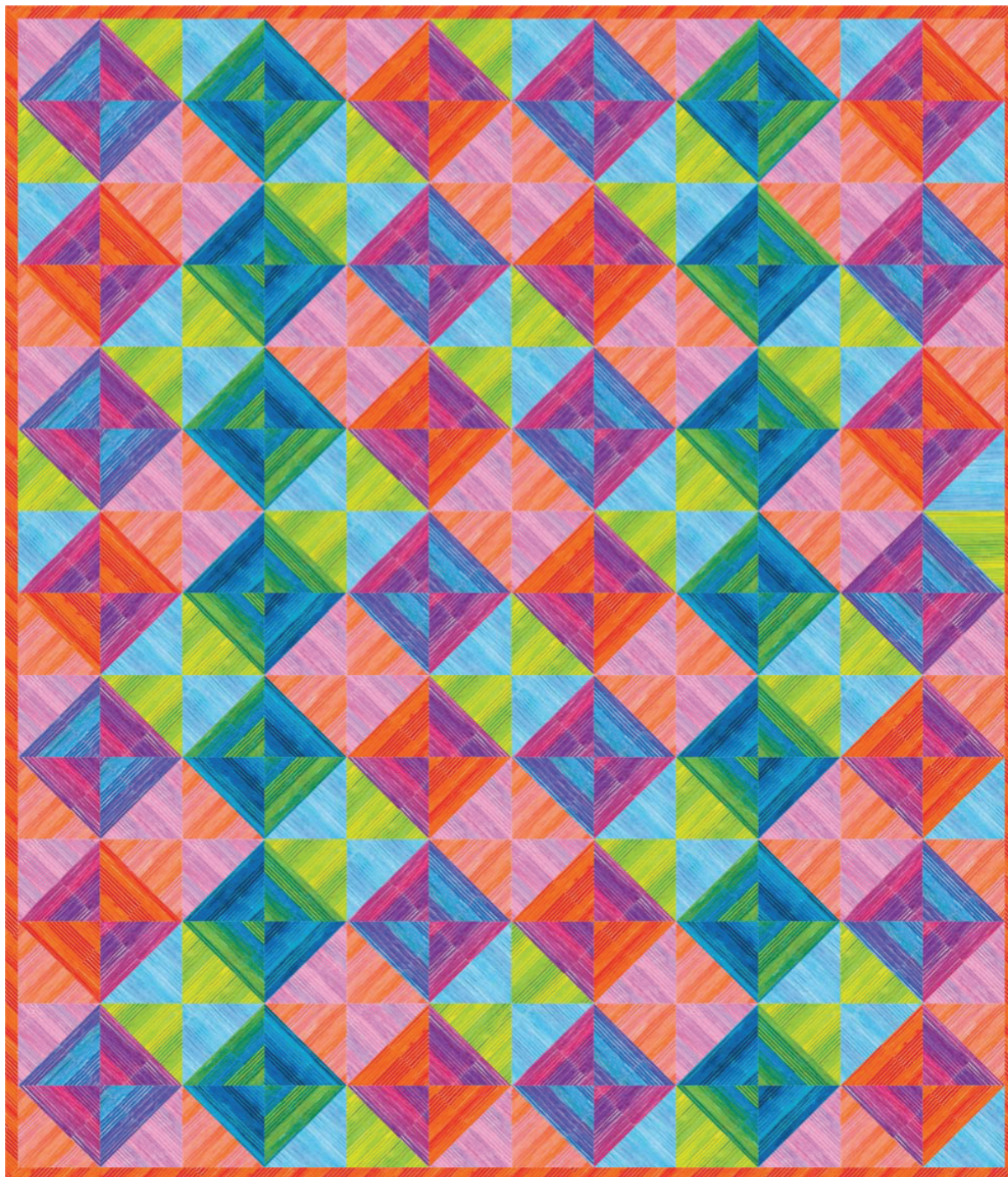



Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 40" wide.

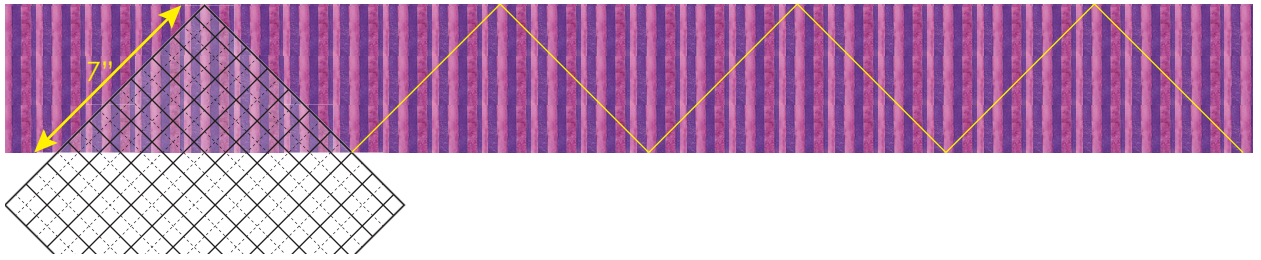
Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From **Fabric A**, cut:

- Eight 5" x **length of fabric** strips. Using a 9-12" square ruler, subcut forty-eight isosceles triangles, each 7" on two sides.



From **Fabric B**, cut:

- Eight 5" x **length of fabric** strips. Cut a total of forty-three triangles.

From **Fabric C**, cut:

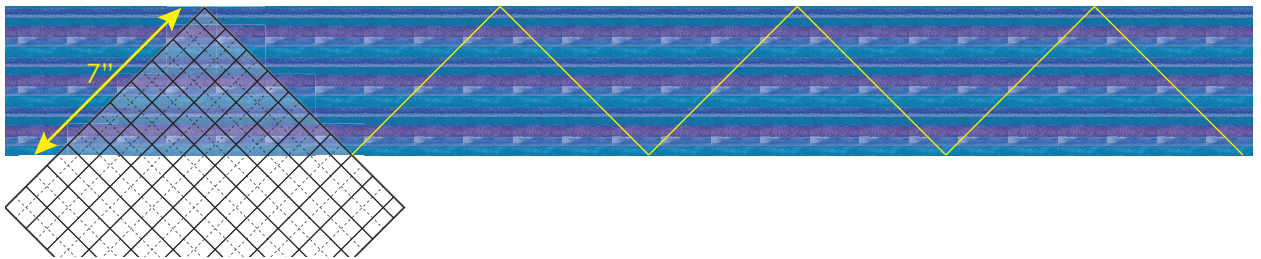
- Seven 5" x **length of fabric** strips. Cut a total of thirty-seven triangles.

From **Fabric D**, cut:

- Seven 5" x **length of fabric** strips. Cut a total of forty-one triangles.

From **Fabric E**, cut:

- Four 5" x width of fabric strips. Using a 9-12" square ruler, subcut twenty-eight isosceles triangles, each 7" on two sides.



- Nine 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding.

From **Fabric F**, cut:

- Eight 5" x width of fabric strips. Cut a total of fifty-six triangles.

From **Fabric G**, cut:

- Four 5" x width of fabric strips. Cut a total of twenty-eight triangles.

From **Fabric H**, cut:

- Four 5" x width of fabric strips. Cut a total of twenty-eight triangles.

From **Fabric I**, cut:

- Four 5" x width of fabric strips. Cut a total of twenty-eight triangles.

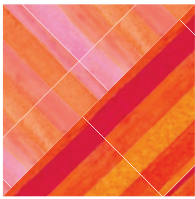
Create the Blocks

Tip: A variety of fabric combinations are used in this quilt. Organize your fabrics for sewing by stacking the appropriate number of each color in labeled block piles first, then sew.

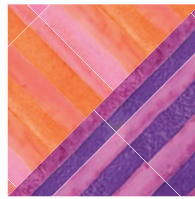
To create the block, sew two triangles together along a long side, creating a half-square triangle (HST). Press seams open.



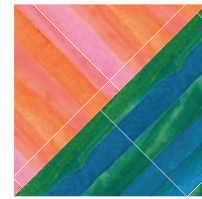
Sew the following HST block quantities:



Fabrics A/E:
Make ten HST blocks



Fabrics A/F:
Make six HST blocks



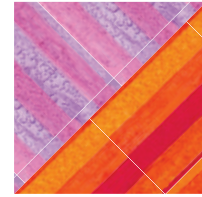
Fabrics A/G:
Make two HST blocks



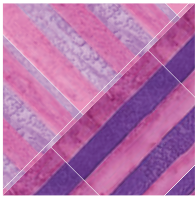
Fabrics A/H:
Make thirteen blocks



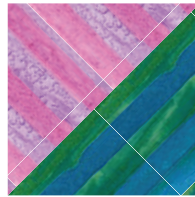
Fabrics A/I:
Make sixteen HST blocks



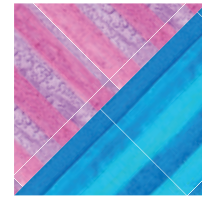
Fabrics B/E:
Make fourteen HST blocks



Fabrics B/F:
Make seven HST blocks



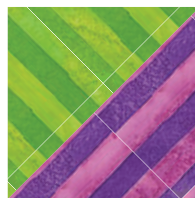
Fabrics B/G:
Make two HST blocks



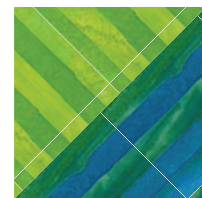
Fabrics B/H:
Make twelve HST blocks



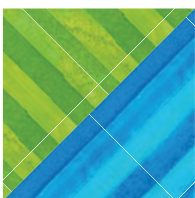
Fabrics B/I:
Make eight HST blocks



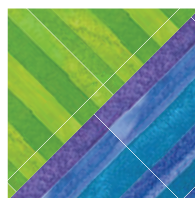
Fabrics C/F:
Make twenty HST blocks



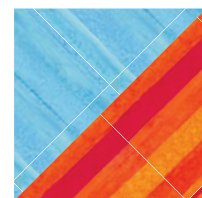
Fabrics C/G:
Make twelve HST blocks



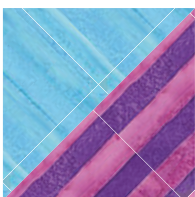
Fabrics C/H:
Make one block



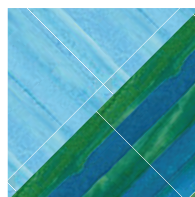
Fabrics C/I:

Make four HST blocks

Make twenty-three HST

Make two HST blocks

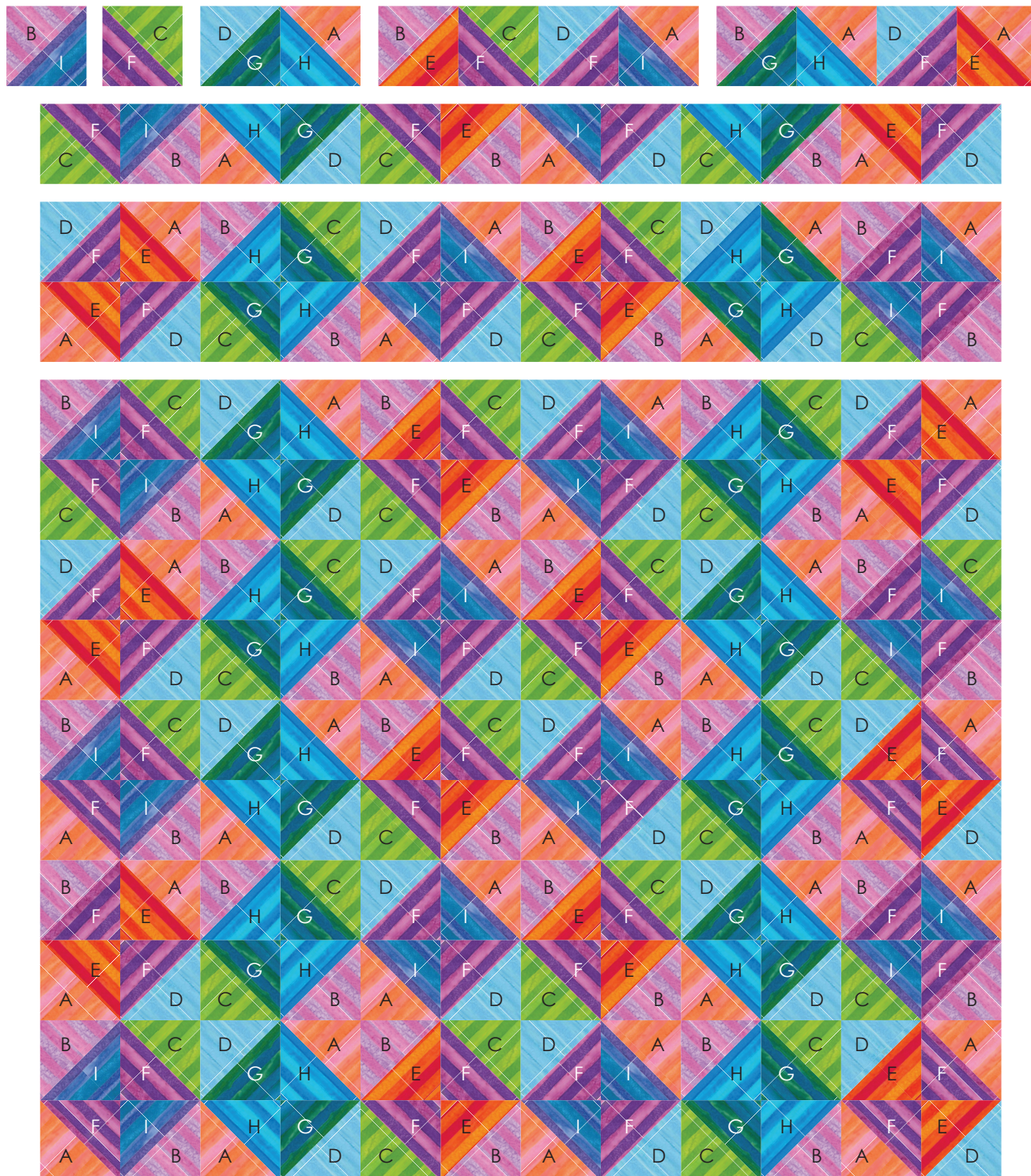
Square blocks to 6-1/4", if necessary.

Assemble the Quilt

Lay out the quilt, following the fabric placement shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Sew together in to fourteen rows of twelve blocks each. Alternate pressing block seams to the left and right for every other row so that row seams will nest.

Sew rows together, pressing seams open.



Quilt Assembly Diagram










Your quilt is now complete. Baste, bind, quilt and enjoy!
