Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

sixteen 2-1/2" squares

four 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixty-four 2" squares for the HSTs

From Fabric B, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

one 4-1/2" x 8" rectangle for Row 1

one 4-1/2" x 44" rectangle for Row 1

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

four 2" squares for the HSTs

four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric C, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

one 4-1/2" x 28-1/2" rectangle for Row 2

one 4-1/2" x 23-1/2" rectangle for Row 2

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

four 2" squares for the HSTs

four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric D, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

one 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle for Row 3

one 4-1/2" x 45-1/2" rectangle for Row 3

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

four 2" squares for the HSTs

four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric E, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

one 4-1/2" x 17-1/2" rectangle for Row 4

one 4-1/2" x 34-1/2" rectangle for Row 4

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

four 2" squares for the HSTs

four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric F, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

one 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle for Row 5

one 4-1/2" x 47-1/2" rectangle for Row 5

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

four 2" squares for the HSTs

four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric G, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

one 4-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangle for Row 6

one 4-1/2" x 35-1/2" rectangle for Row 6

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

four 2" squares for the HSTs

four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric H, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

one 4-1/2" x 22-1/2" rectangle for Row 7

one 4-1/2" x 29-1/2" rectangle for Row 7

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

four 2" squares for the HSTs

four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric I, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

one 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle for Row 8

one 4-1/2" x 46-1/2" rectangle for Row 8

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

four 2" squares for the HSTs

four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric J, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

one 4-1/2" x 13-1/2" rectangle for Row 9

one 4-1/2" x 38-1/2" rectangle for Row 9

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

four 2" squares for the HSTs

four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric K, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

one 4-1/2" x 29-1/2" rectangle for Row 10

one 4-1/2" x 22-1/2" rectangle for Row 10

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

four 2" squares for the HSTs

four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric L, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

- one 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle for Row 11
- one 4-1/2" x 47-1/2" rectangle for Row 11

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

- four 2" squares for the HSTs
- four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric M, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

- one 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle for Row 12
- one 4-1/2" x 39-1/2" rectangle for Row 12

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

- four 2" squares for the HSTs
- four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric N, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

- one 4-1/2" x 21-1/2" rectangle for Row 13
- one 4-1/2" x 30-1/2" rectangle for Row 13

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

- four 2" squares for the HSTs
- four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric O, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

- one 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle for Row 14
- one 4-1/2" x 45-1/2" rectangle for Row 14

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

- four 2" squares for the HSTs
- four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric P, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

- one 4-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangle for Row 15
- one 4-1/2" x 42-1/2" rectangle for Row 15

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

- four 2" squares for the HSTs
- four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric Q, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

- one 4-1/2" x 22-1/2" rectangle for Row 16
- one 4-1/2" x 29-1/2" rectangle for Row 16

From the remainder of the strip, subcut:

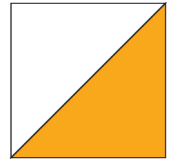
- four 2" squares for the HSTs
- four 1-1/2" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

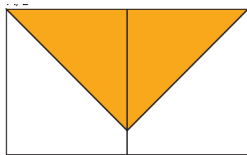
Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 2" Fabric A square with a 2" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make eight A/B HSTs.

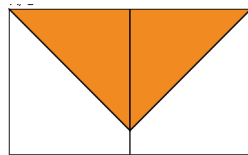


Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make eight HSTs from each of Fabrics C-Q, each paired with Fabric A.

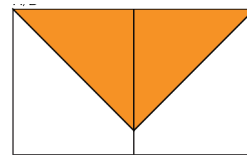
Step 3: Sew two matching HSTs together, as shown. Press. Repeat with all HSTs to make four pairs from each of Fabrics B-Q.



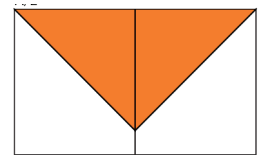

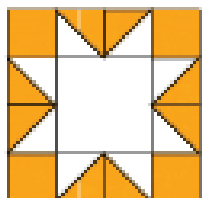
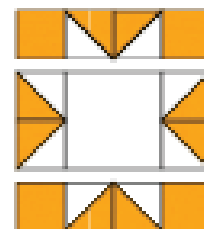
Assemble the Star Blocks



Step 4: Gather:
four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B squares
four Fabric B HST pairs
one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square

Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 5: Sew the units together to form the rows. Press the seams away from the HST pairs.



Step 6: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the Star Block.

The Star Block should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat Steps 4-6 to make one Star Block from each of Fabrics C-Q.

Assemble the Rows and Quilt

Step 1: Arrange the Star Blocks and 4-1/2" wide strips to form sixteen rows. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 2: Sew the Star Blocks between each set of 4-1/2" wide rectangles as indicated to form rows. Press.

Step 3: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
