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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

six 10-1/2" squares for the A Block centers

From each of Fabrics B-D, cut:

three 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: four 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" side inner borders four 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

From each of Fabrics E-G, cut:

four 2-1/2" x length of the fabric strips. Subcut to make:
four 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" side outer borders
from the remaining width of fabric, cut:
four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
four 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From each of Fabrics H-K, cut:

three 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty-eight 2" squares for the HSTs
two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty-eight 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric L, cut:

six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: forty-eight 4-1/2" squares

From each of Fabrics M & N, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: twelve 2-1/2" squares three 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: forty-eight 2" squares for the HSTs

From Fabric O, cut:

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-four 2-1/2" squares five 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: ninety-six 2" squares for the HSTs

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the A Blocks



Step 1: Gather:

one Fabric A square

two Fabric B side inner borders

two Fabric B top/bottom inner borders

two Fabric E side outer borders

two Fabric E top/bottom outer borders

Arrange the units as shown. Note the fabric placement orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 2: Sew side inner borders to the left and right edges of the Fabric A Block Center. Press. Sew top/bottom inner borders to the top and bottom edges of the Fabric A Block Center. Press.

Step 3: Sew side outer borders to the left and right edges of the Block Center. Press. Sew top/bottom outer borders to the top and bottom edges of the Block Center. Press.

The resulting A Block will measure 16-1/2" square. Repeat Steps 1-3 to make a total of six A Blocks. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric pairings and placements.



Assemble the Half-Square Triangles

Step 4: Pair a 2" Fabric H square with a 2" Fabric M square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 1-1/2" square. Repeat to make ninety-six H/M HSTs.



Step 5: Repeat Step 4 to make:



ninety-six I/N HSTs



ninety-six J/O HSTs



ninety-six K/O HSTs

Step 6: Sew the HTSs into pairs as shown. Press. Make:










forty-eight H/M pairs

forty-eight I/N pairs

forty-eight J/O pairs

forty-eight K/O pairs

Assemble the B Blocks



Step 7: Gather: four Fabric H squares four H/M HST pairs one 2-1/2" Fabric M square

Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 8: Sew the units together to form the rows. Press the seams away from the HST pairs.

Step 9: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the Star Block. Each Star Block unit will measure 4-1/2" square.

Step 10: Repeat Steps 7-9 to make:







twelve H/M Star Blocks




twelve I/N Blocks

twelve K/O Blocks




Step 11: Gather: eight Fabric L squares two H/M Star Blocks two I/N Blocks two J/O Blocks two K/O Blocks

Arrange the units into four rows of four. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 12: Sew the squares together to form the rows. Press the seams toward the Fabric L squares.

Step 13: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The B Block will measure 16-1/2" square. Repeat Steps 11-13 to make a total of six B Blocks.



Assemble the Quilt



Step 14: Arrange the blocks into four rows of three blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 15: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 16: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
