Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

six 10" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: six 3" x 10" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: five 3" x 10" rectangles

From Fabric D, cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: six 3" x 10" rectangles

From Fabric E, cut:

fifteen 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-two 1-3/4" x 12-1/2" rectangles twelve 1-3/4" x 10" rectangles forty-eight 1-3/4" x 3" rectangles for the flying geese four 1-3/4" squares

From each of Fabrics F, H and J, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 3" squares

From each of Fabrics G, I and K, cut:

two 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut: thirty-two 1-3/4" squares

From Fabric L, cut:


five 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 4-1/2" x 49" side outer borders two 4-1/2" x 42-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:


six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Flying Geese

Step 1: Place a 1-3/4" Fabric I square RST at one end of a 1-3/4" x 3" Fabric E rectangle. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the square, as shown. Sew on the marked line and trim away the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press toward the triangle.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 at the remaining end of the rectangle. The resulting flying geese block should measure 1-3/4" x 3".




Step 3: Repeat with all remaining 1-3/4" x 3" Fabric E rectangles to make:



sixteen I/E flying geese



sixteen G/E flying geese



sixteen K/E flying geese

Assemble the Block Rows

Step 4: Gather: two Fabric A squares

four 1-3/4" x 10" Fabric E strips

one Fabric B rectangle one Fabric C rectangle one Fabric D rectangle



Arrange as shown and sew together to form Block Row 1. Press the seams toward the B, C and D rectangles.

Step 5: Repeat Step 4 to make Block Row 2 and Block Row 3, referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement.

Assemble the Sashing Rows

Step 6: Gather:

four 1-3/4" x 12-1/2" Fabric E strips

one Fabric H square

one Fabric F square

one Fabric J square

three I/E flying geese

four G/E flying geese

three K/E flying geese

one Fabric B rectangle

one Fabric D rectangle

Arrange as shown and sew together to form Sashing Row 1. Press the seams toward the Fabric E strips and the Fabric H/F and J squares.



Step 7: Repeat Step 6 to make Sashing Row 2, Sashing Row 3 and Sashing Row 4, referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement. Note: in each row, the flying geese counts of each fabric may differ from Row 1.

Assemble the Quilt



Step 8: Sew together the Block Rows and Sashing Rows, following the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press.

Step 9: Gather the remaining flying geese, 12-1/2" Fabric E strips and Fabric E squares to form the left and right inner borders. Sew together, then sew to the left and right edges of the quilt center, noting the fabric placement in the diagram.

Step 10: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
