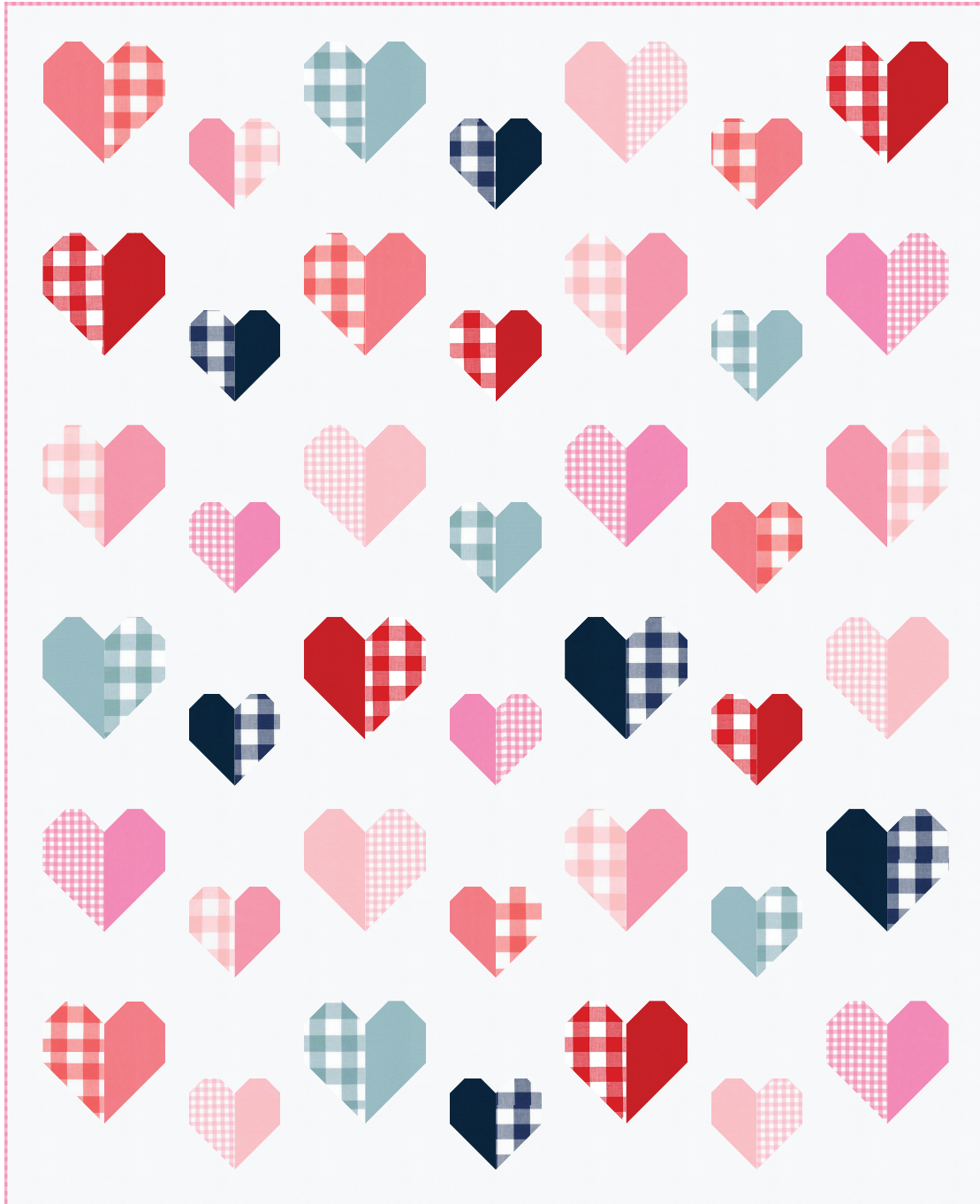

Finished quilt measures: 64" x 78-1/2"















Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

5 yards for backing

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

three 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eighteen 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for the small heart blocks

six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

forty-eight 4-1/2" squares for the large hearts. Mark a diagonal on the wrong side of each square.

nine 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles for the large heart blocks

thirty-six 3-1/2" squares for the small hearts

seven 3" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 3" x 74" side outer borders

two 3" x 64-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

twenty-four 2" x WOF strips. Sew eight strips together, end-to-end, then trim:

five 2" x 59-1/2" row sashing strips

Subcut the remaining strips into:

thirty-six 2" x 11-1/2" block sashing strips

ninety-six 2" squares for the large hearts. Mark a diagonal on the wrong side of each square.

three 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

seventy-two 1-1/2" squares for the large hearts

From each of Fabrics B-E, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

three 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles for the large hearts

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

three 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for the small hearts

From each of Fabrics F-K, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles for the large hearts

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for the small hearts

From each of Fabrics L and M, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles for the large hearts

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for the small hearts

From each of Fabrics N and O, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles for the large hearts

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for the small hearts

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Large Heart Blocks

Step 1: Gather:

one 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B rectangle

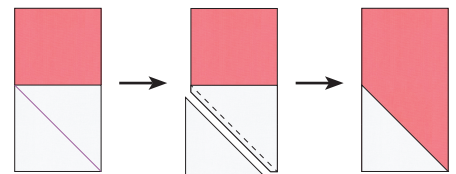
one 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric C rectangle

two 4-1/2" Fabric A squares

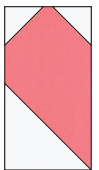
four 2" Fabric A squares

one 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle

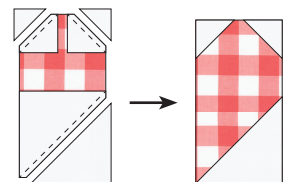
Step 2: Place a 4-1/2" Fabric A square at the bottom of the Fabric B rectangle, as shown, ensuring that the marked diagonal is positioned correctly. Sew on the marked diagonal. Trim away the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press.



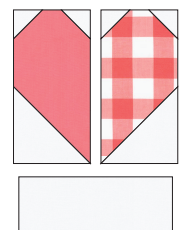
Step 3: Using the same stitch and flip method, sew 2" Fabric A squares at the top left and top right corners of the Fabric B rectangle, as shown, ensuring that the marked diagonals are positioned correctly. Press.



Step 4: Using the same stitch and flip method, repeat Steps 2 and 3 with the Fabric C rectangle, noting that in order to create a heart, this block will be a mirror image. The 4-1/2" Fabric A square will be sewn with the diagonal placed in the opposite direction, as shown here.



Step 5: Sew the completed Step 3 and Step 4 units together. Press. Sew the 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the bottom edge. Press. The final Large Heart Block should measure 8-1/2" x 11-1/2".



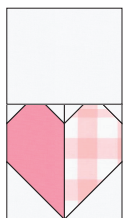
Step 6: Repeat Steps 1-5 to complete a total of twenty-four Large Heart Blocks.

You will make:

- three B/C blocks
- three D/E blocks
- four F/G blocks
- four H/I blocks
- four J/K blocks
- two L/M blocks
- four N/O blocks

Note: To add interest, in some blocks, the gingham fabric will be on the left and in others it will be on the right. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement, or decide the gingham position to your liking.

Assemble the Small Heart Blocks



Step 7: Gather:

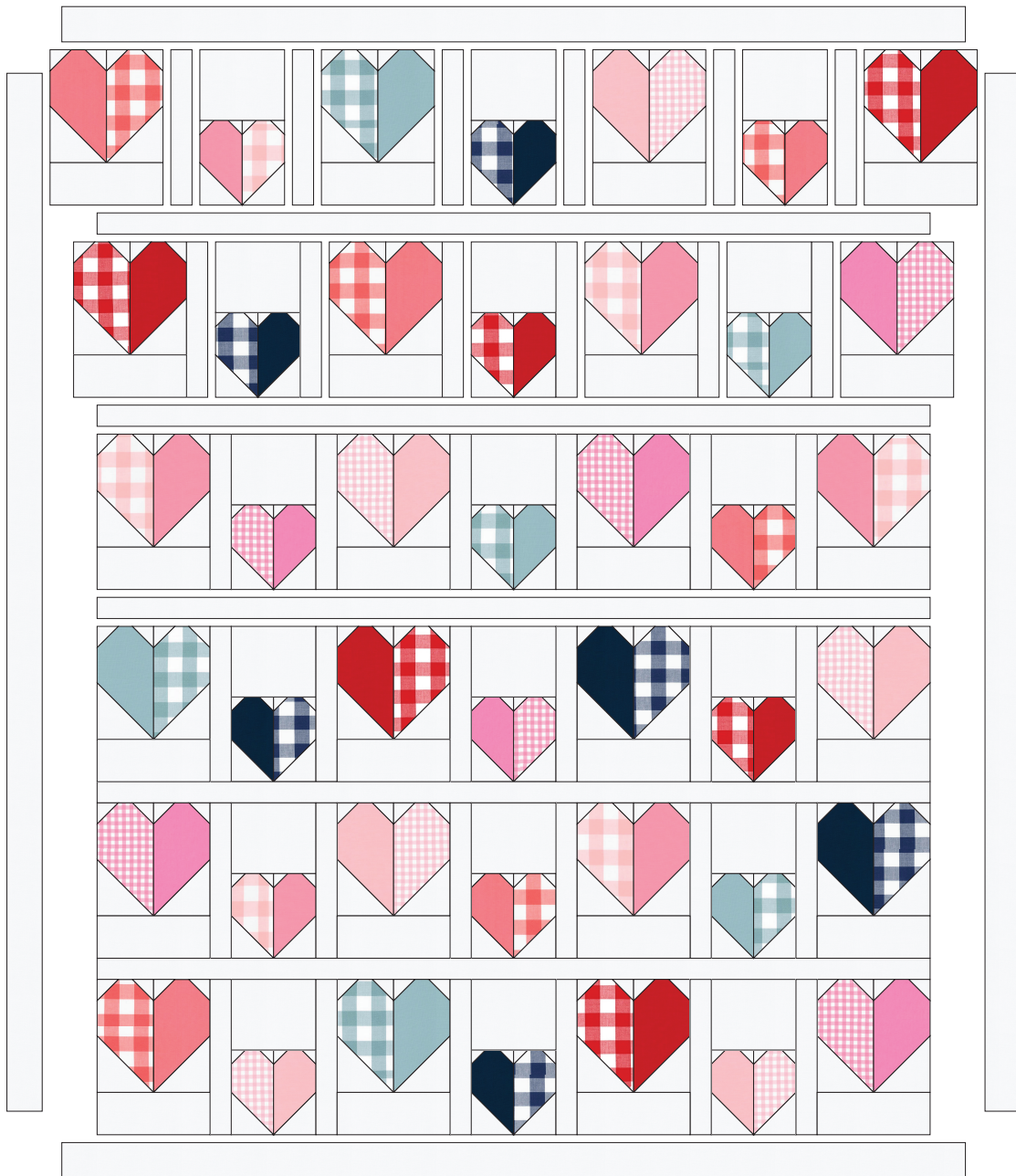
- one 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric J rectangle
- one 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric K rectangle
- two 3-1/2" Fabric A squares
- four 1-1/2" Fabric A squares
- one 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle

Step 8: Repeat the process in Steps 1-5, this time sewing a 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the top of each heart, to complete a total of eighteen Small Heart Blocks. Each will measure 6-1/2" x 11-1/2". You will make:

- three B/C blocks
- three D/E blocks
- two F/G blocks
- two H/I blocks
- two J/K blocks
- four L/M blocks
- two N/O blocks

Again, in some blocks, the gingham fabric will be on the left and in others it will be on the right. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement, or decide the gingham position to your liking.

Assemble the Quilt



Step 9: Arrange the Large and Small Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using 2" x 11-1/2" Fabric A block sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make six block rows.

Step 10: Sew the row sashing and block rows together. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 11: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
