## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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You will also need:  
3-1/2 yards for backing

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From Fabric A, fussy cut:**

ten 7" x 11" block centers

### **From Fabric B, cut:**

one 3-3/4" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
two 3-3/4" x 13" rectangles

### **From Fabric C, cut:**

one 7" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
one 7" x 11" rectangle

### **From Fabric D, cut:**

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
two 4-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips

### **From Fabric E, cut:**

five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:  
two 1-1/2" x 44-1/2" top/bottom middle borders  
two 1-1/2" x 60" top/bottom middle borders

### **From each of Fabrics F, and H-J, cut:**

two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
four 1-1/2" x 9" rectangles for the top/bottom block borders  
four 1-1/2" x 11" rectangles for the side block borders  
Tip: Cut two of each length from each WOF strip in order to maximize yardage.

### **From Fabric G, cut:**

three 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
six 1-1/2" x 9" rectangles for the top/bottom block borders  
six 1-1/2" x 11" rectangles for the side block borders  
Tip: Cut two of each length from each WOF strip in order to maximize yardage.

### **From Fabric K, cut:**

thirteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
ten 2-1/2" x 13" block sashing strips  
six 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" row sashing strips  
Sew the remaining three strips together, end-to-end, then subcut:  
two 2-1/2" x 58" side inner borders

### From Fabric L, cut:


- six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
  - two 4-1/2" x 46-1/2" top/bottom outer borders
  - two 4-1/2" x 68" top/bottom outer borders

### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

- seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips


## Assemble the Blocks

**Step 1:** Sew a 1-1/2" x 11" Fabric F strip to the left and right edges of a Fabric A block center. Press toward the strips. Sew a 1-1/2" x 9" Fabric F strip to the top and bottom edges of a the block. Press toward the strips. The resulting block should measure 9" x 13".



**Step 2:** Repeat Step 1 with all remaining Fabric A rectangles and the Fabric C rectangle to make eleven Blocks. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric pairings, or create pairings of your own from the Fabric F-J strips.

## Assemble the Quilt



**Step 3:** Sew four Blocks and three block sashing strips together to form Block Row 1. Press the seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make Block Row 3.

**Step 4:** Sew three Blocks, two Fabric B rectangles and four block sashing strips together to form Block Row 2. Press the seams toward the sashing.

**Step 5:** Sew a row sashing strip to the top and bottom edges of each Fabric D strip. Press.

**Step 6:** Sew Rows 1-3 together, sewing a row sashing strip between each one. Press toward the sashing. Sew a completed Step 5 unit to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press. Sew a Fabric K side inner border to the quilt center. Press.

**Step 7:** Sew the top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 8:** Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
