

Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Press all seam allowances open after each seam is sewn, unless otherwise noted.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

Fabric A

- Cut eight squares 9" x 9", then cut on the diagonal to make HSTs.

Fabric B

- Cut nine squares 9" x 9", then cut on the diagonal to make HSTs.

Fabric C

- Cut ten squares 9" x 9", then cut on the diagonal to make HSTs.

Fabric D, E, G and I

- Cut two strips 5" x WOF, then subcut twelve squares 5" x 5".

Fabric F

- Cut two strips 5" x WOF, then subcut fourteen squares 5" x 5".

Fabric H

- Cut two strips 5" x WOF, then subcut thirteen squares 5" x 5".

Fabric J

- Cut four strips 5" x WOF, then:
 - subcut ten squares 5" x 5".
 - subcut twenty squares 5" x 5", then cut on the diagonal to make HSTs.
- Cut four strips 4-1/2" x WOF, then subcut thirty-two squares 4-1/2" x 4-1/2".

Fabric K

- Cut three strips 5" x WOF, then:
 - subcut eight squares 5" x 5"
 - subcut sixteen squares 5" x 5", then cut on the diagonal to make HSTs
- Cut four strips 4-1/2" x WOF, then subcut thirty-two squares 4-1/2" x 4-1/2".

Fabric L


- Cut four strips 5" x WOF, then:
 - subut nine squares 5" x 5"
 - subcut sixteen squares 5" x 5", then cut on the diagonal to make HSTs.
- Cut six strips 4-1/2" x WOF, then subcut forty-eight squares 4-1/2" x 4-1/2"

Fabric M

- Cut six strips 5" x WOF, then subcut into forty-eight squares 5" x 5"
- Cut nineteen strips 4-1/2" x WOF, then subcut ten strips into sashing strips 4-1/2" x 16-1/2".


Assembly Instructions


Step 1: Make Half Square Triangles (HSTs)



- Place a Fabric D 5" square and a Fabric K 5" square with right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner and sew a scant 1/4" from each side of the line.

- Cut along the drawn line and press seam allowances open. Trimto 4-1/2" x 4-1/2".





You will now have two HSTs. Repeat to make one hundred fifty HSTs based on the chart below:


Step 2: Assemble Blocks








- Sew two Fabric K triangles to the print sides of a Fabric G/K HST. Press seam allowance toward the triangles.







- Sew a Fabric A triangle to the G/K triangle unit.

 Press seam allowance toward Fabric A.
- The block should measure 8-1/2" x 8-1/2".
- Repeat to make a second block.


- Sew block together as pictured. You will first make two 4-patch blocks using two Fabric K 4-1/2" squares and two G/M HSTs per block. Next, sew the 4-patch blocks to the triangle blocks to complete the block.
- Block should measure 16-1/2" x 16-1/2".










- Repeat Step 2 to make blocks according to the diagrams below:

















- Assemble half and quarter blocks the same way as the whole blocks. Refer to the diagrams below:









Step 3: Assemble Quilt

- Refer to the assembly diagram and sew blocks into diagonal rows with Fabric M 4-1/2" x 16-1/2" sashing between each block. Press seam allowance toward sashing.
- Sew rows together diagonally with Fabric M
 4-1/2" sashing in between.
 You will need to piece the sashing for the longer rows.
 Press seam allowance toward sashing.





- Trim edges to true up the sides.
